## **REFRESHMENT AREA: PUBLIC GARDENS IN VIALE GARIBALDI**



This green area, which can be easily reached by using the ACTV water transport, is made up of a big tree-lined avenue, perfect for refreshment stops during the hot summer months.

The avenue is 180 metres long and connects Via Garibaldi to the Napoleonic (Partigiana) Gardens that lead to the Biennale Gardens, area for the International Exhibition of Art and Architecture.

In the northern sector of Viale Garibaldi, you can find the monumental fountain with the same name; along the road and in an area where the road widens, there is one of the two drinkable water fountains, numerous benches, rubbish bins, and Veritas no. 9 rest-rooms at approx. 50 metres.
