Shengyi Chao, a Venice-based artist, possesses a diverse artistic journey, previously studied traditional Chinese painting before attending Venice Fine Art Academy. After graduation, she assisted at Atelier 16 and was involved in Venice Biennale's research training, later being recognized by the Bevilacqua La Masa Foundation.

Her art portrays a fairy-tale realm for adults, using delicate colors to evoke dreamy visuals inspired by innocence. Chao's works offer a retreat from reality, merging dreams with everyday life.

She researches color relationships and art therapy, skillfully crafting peaceful dreamscapes. Believing in the narrative strength of transparent materials, she captures powerful emotions with gentle hues.

This work showcasing a slice of my studio, the play on transparency, with my daily sketches, creating a dual world between the atelier (reality) and the artwork (ideal).

"Double & Duality" elucidates the coexistence of diverse elements in our world, offering a meticulous exploration of the delicate interplay between the abstract and the realistic, the conventional and the innovative, the raw and the refined.

Drawing inspiration from Tao Yuanming's fable "The Peach Blossom Land", the artworks present ethereal miniatures of idealistic serenity. The artist recreates a fragment of her studio within the exhibition, merging oriental painting traditions with color therapy. The pieces immerse viewers in tranquil realms, exploring the balance between personal autonomy and external influences.

The Peach Blossom Land was a fable written by Tao Yuanming, a Chinese poet, in 421 AD about a chance discovery of an ethereal utopia where people lead an ideal existence in harmony with nature, unaware of the outside world for centuries. The phrase can be used to describe an idealistic place of beauty and repose, although it is sometimes used to refer to an unrealistic dream.

Driven by a passion to evoke affectionate emotions in people, my artistic endeavors revolve around the creation of miniature worlds within frames. This original concept behind my works aims to foster a shared emotional experience for all. It is influenced, in part, by the rich tradition of oriental painting, which seeks spiritual resonance through aesthetics.

My artistic research centers around the interplay between color and art therapy. I consistently employ light, pure, and gentle hues to transport individuals into a small, peaceful realm of dreams. By utilizing a smaller scale for my works, I intend to captivate viewers' attention gradually, enticing them to approach closer and explore the intricate details.

The motivation driving my artistic pursuit lies in the recognition of our contemporary need for tranquil spaces. In an era characterized by relentless development and an overwhelming influx of information, our connection with the world, with others, with time, and even with our immediate surroundings has undergone profound changes—changes that often go unnoticed.





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


You Can't Take It with You


Two water tanks, shaped like arcades, which are connected by two pipes, and five ducklings of different colors float in the water. Each duckling represents one of the five continents of our world, symbolizing the diversity of nations, much like the colors of the Olympic rings.

The water inside the tanks flows up and down through a special hydraulic device or system. When the water levels in the two tanks are equal, the ducklings can freely flow back and forth through the upper pipe, which mirrors how people holding passports of equal value can move freely between countries, symbolizing the idea of open borders.

However, when there is a significant difference in water levels between the tanks, the ducklings can only move back and forth through the lower pipe. In this scenario, a duckling in the tank with the lower water level will never be able to pass through the upper pipe. This contrast to the situation with equal water levels, prompts us to reflect on the relationship between our nationalities and our rights. It reminds us of the importance of considering the impact of unequal opportunities and restrictions placed upon people based on their nationality or background.
