Yearbook of Tourism data 2023

City of Venice

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Introduction

The Tourism Yearbook of the City of Venice has reached its thirteenth edition with 2023 data. The document offers a collection of data documenting in detail the most relevant tourism aspects of the area of Venice City and of the areas related or attributable to this, such as the use of the cultural offer or the services offered by the transport infrastructures.

As usual, 2023 data are compared both to the previous year and to the pre-pandemic year (2019) which is useful to compare and evaluate the recovery of the tourism sector following the global health crisis.

The Tourism Yearbook is **divided into five parts**, which respectively show:

- i. the data of the historical trend of tourism in the City of Venice, an **overview of tourism** in the lagoon area and in the Metropolitan City of Venice, the tourist demand in the five-year period 2019-2023 which reports the comparison between tourists arrivals (number of guests welcomed by the hospitality sector in the timeframes indicated) and tourists overnight stays (number of nights spent by guests in the facilities), with reference both to their origin (foreigners, Italians) and to the type of accommodation chosen for the stay (hotel, other accommodation facilities¹);
- ii. **the analysis of the tourist offer** which reports data from hotels and other accommodation facilities including tourist rentals;
- iii. the illustration, referring to the 2019- 2023 five-year period, of the **passenger flows** of the Venice port, the Venice and Treviso airports, the local public transport, the issue of the limited traffic area bus passes of the city of Venice, as well as the transits recorded in Piazzale Roma (City Parking Garage and Sant'Andrea car park);
- iv. overview of the trend of accesses and sales of **VeneziaUnica, the official tourist website**;
- v. both aggregate and detailed data referring to **visitors to Venetian museums and cultural institutions** and users of the main cultural initiatives in Venice.

Methodological note

Tourist flow: the demand To ensure a correct understanding of the data collected, it is important to refer to ISTAT's definition of the "Movement of Guests among Tourist Facilities". This states: *"monthly statistics on the movement of guests among tourist facilities have been collected by ISTAT regularly since 1957. These are the primary source of information on internal tourism in Italy. The data is collected in compliance with EU Regulation n. 692/2011 issued by the European Parliament and applied by the Ministry on 6 July 2011, regulating the European Statistics on Tourism. The data collected includes: the arrival of guests in tourist facilities; their stay within such facilities; their place of origin (regional for Italians; national for foreigners). The data also traces the daily movement of guests as communicated by the facilities' administrators through the ISTAT form C/59 (split in two sections: a monthly one (Mod_C59_M) and a daily one (Mod_C59_G)) or through tables A1 and A2 (in printed or electronic versions, compiled locally by transcribing verbatim the information requested in the ISTAT forms). This data is collected and summarized on a monthly basis by the Municipality, using a file corresponding to the MOV/C used by Tourist operators (in use since 2007). The operators communicate the data by using the certified and protected site <https://indata.istat.it/mtur>.*

The most significant information emerging from the collection of data is related to the movement of guests (arrivals and stays). The data is classified thus: kind and category of hosting facility; hosting capacity of specific territories (region; province; tourist precinct); month of collection; guests' place of residence (foreign or regional) location; facility's occupational capacity; and facility's ability to track guest movements. The most interesting aspect of the data collection is the possibility to track all possible combination of guest movements and thus obtain a cross-referenced analysis of the numbers. ISTAT uses the statistics collected by the facilities to calculate the region's tourist capacity. This is computed by measuring the number of registered guests against the number of available beds. The 'net' capacity refers to the number of beds taking into account seasonal closures, while the 'gross' capacity includes all potentially available facilities, without taking closures into account. The movements of guests (arrivals/overnight stays), for the purposes of statistical surveys, are provided by the Statistical Office of the Veneto Region, which collects the data directly from the operators of the accommodation facilities through the Regional tourist information system, in accordance with the provisions issued by the National Institute of Statistics (ISTAT) and by the regional statistical structure itself, pursuant to Art. 13, paragraph 5, of the current Regional Law no. 11/2013.

The data of the tourist flow of the territory of the Municipality of Venice are analysed, as well as in its unity, even in the three urban areas:

- Venice historic City;
- Lido;
- Mainland.

Those of the smaller islands (Murano, Burano, Torcello, etc.) are included in the statistics of the historic city area. The data of Malamocco, Alberoni and Pellestrina are included in the statistics of the Lido area.

The tourist flow of the territory of the Metropolitan City of Venice is analysed, in addition to its overall territorial extension, also in the following three areas:

- Seaside resort;
- Cities of art;

- Metropolitan Hinterland.

The seaside area of the Metropolitan City includes Caorle, Cavallino Treporti, Chioggia, Eraclea, Jesolo, San Michele al Tagliamento-Bibione and the Venice Lido area.

The Cities of Art area includes the City of Venice, with the exception of the Lido area, and Dolo, Fiesse d'Artico, Mira, Mirano, Stra and Vigonovo (Riviera del Brenta).

The metropolitan hinterland area includes Annone Veneto, Campagna Lupia, Campolongo Maggiore, Camponogara, Cavarzere, Ceggia, Cinto Caomaggiore, Cona, Concordia Sagittaria, Fossalta di Piave, Fossalta di Portogruaro, Fossò, Gruaro, Marcon, Martellago, Meolo, Musile di Piave, Noale, Noventa di Piave, Pianiga, Portogruaro, Pramaggiore, Quarto d'Altino, Salzano, San Donà di Piave, San Stino di Livenza, Santa Maria di Sala, Scorzè, Spinea, Teglio Veneto, Torre di Mosto.

Tourist facilities' capacity: Tourist offer The ISTAT definition of the "tourist facilities' capacity" is useful to note when considering the data. It states: *The annual collection of data tracing the tourist facilities' capacity measures the specific structural elements of said facilities. The data is collected in compliance with the EU Regulation n. 692/2011 on European Statistics regarding Tourism, applied by the Ministry on 6 July 2011. The data tracks the number of facilities, beds, rooms, and bathrooms used in each individual hotel within the municipality. It also tracks the number of beds available in other types of facilities. The data is collected through a form – CTT/4— which is compiled once a year by each Province or Region (depending on local regulations) and sent directly to ISTAT. Data is collected from the following facilities: hotels (classified in 5 categories, depending upon the number of stars allocated); tourist residences; facilities other than hotels (including: camping sites; tourist villages; mixed structures; bed-and-breakfasts; agri-tourisms; youth hostels; vacation rentals; mountain lodges; and other N.A.C facilities; and private rentals).*

Data regarding camping sites, tourist villages, and mixed forms is grouped under the name, "Camping sites and tourist villages", while data collected for other private locations is not published. The hotels' capacity has been measured in terms of their size (intended as number of rooms) since 2008. The capacity has been intended as the gross yearly capacity (meaning that facilities are included irrespective of seasonal closures) since 2007. Facilities that remain closed for an entire year are not included. Questionnaires have been collected using the certified secure site Indata (<https://indata.istat.it/ctur/>) since 2007. The accommodation facilities in the Veneto Region are divided into the following types: hotels, outdoor and other accommodation facilities.

The other accommodation facilities, identified by the art. 27 of the Regional Law N°11 of 14th June 2013, are the following (previously the Regional Law identified thirteen accommodation facilities in the non-hotel type):

- *tourist accommodations*, composed of one to six rooms, each one with a maximum of four beds;
- *holiday houses*, composed of a living room and a dining room both in common use and rooms which for more than half have two or more beds;
- *furnished residential units for tourist use*, composed of one or more rooms, each one with one or more beds, as well as independent toilets and kitchen;
- *bed & breakfast*, composed of one to three rooms for tourists, each one with a maximum of four beds; the owner must live in the real estate unit where the bed & breakfast is located

and must stay there, in a room reserved for him, during the opening period of the facility. The breakfast service is served to customers directly by the owner or his family.

Furthermore, the Regional Law n° 45 of 30th december 2014 introduced the art. 27 bis to the Regional Law N° 11 of 14th June 2013, which regulates the rooms given exclusively for tourist purposes without classification and brought back to the so-called tourist rental.

The data relating to the total number of beds does not include the additional beds as referred to in the art. 25 par. 7 and 8 of the Regional Law. 11/2013, except for tourist rentals.

Regional registry doesn't collect the tax purpose information about tourist rentals managed as businesses.

Moreover, for what concerns the offer, when the distinction between the Historic centre of Venice, the Lido and the Mainland is not indicated by the facility owner, the data collected by the regional registry is always considered "historic centre" for statistical purposes.

Visitors to ecclesiastical museums and churches The Venetian churches are usually open during worship time. The cultural and tourist use is also guaranteed at other times, through free or paid admission. The places here presented are equipped with an access tracking. Venice residents have free admission, as anyone who comes in to pray.

The 18th International Architecture Exhibition of La Biennale di Venezia, entitled "The Laboratory of the Future", took place from 20th May to 26th November 2023 and counted 64 national participations and 9 collateral events.

Part I

The demand

Tourist movements¹ are defined as the “arrival and stay of guests (both Italian and foreign) categorized according to the facility hosting them or their original place of residence”.

During 2023, Venice recorded a total of **5,664,611 arrivals which correspond to 12,628,079 overnight stays**: July recorded, as it happened in 2022, the highest number of arrivals equal to 645,232 which correspond to 1,357. 337 stays. The 2023 data compared with those of 2019 shows +2.56% of arrivals against -2.47% of overnight stays. Compared to the year 2022, however, the changes in arrivals and stays are both positive: +21.92% arrivals and +15.36% overnight stays.

The 2023 data relating to **Italian tourist** arrivals returned a positive sign compared to the year 2019: +5.5% but on the other hand a negative sign compared to 2022 (-9.4% Italian arrivals on 2022). This segment represents 13.91% of total arrivals: the segment of **foreign tourists**, with 4,876,463 arrivals, represents 86% of the total, growing compared to 2019 by +2.1% and +29.1 % compared to 2022.

The easing of restrictive measures has in fact led to the recovery of the foreign market, not only European but also international, and Italian tourists, on the other hand, report greater figures than 2019, but are starting to decline compared to 2022.

With reference to arrivals, in 2023 the top **12 foreign countries of origin** are: USA, France, Great Britain, Germany, Spain, Australia, Canada, South Korea, Mexico, Poland, Brazil and China. Seven countries out of twelve are non-Europeans, proof of the recovery of the international tourism market.

The hotel sector welcomes 61% of arrivals or 3,466,253 tourists, corresponding to 7,023,390 overnight stays. **The other accommodation facilities**, on the other hand, recorded 2,198,358 arrivals which correspond to 5,604,689 overnight stays.

The accommodation facilities in the historic center of Venice welcomed more than 3.8 million arrivals, which represents the 67% of the total and the figure corresponds to 72% of total overnight stays. In the historic centre the average stay is 2.4 days.

The city average stay is 2.2 days.

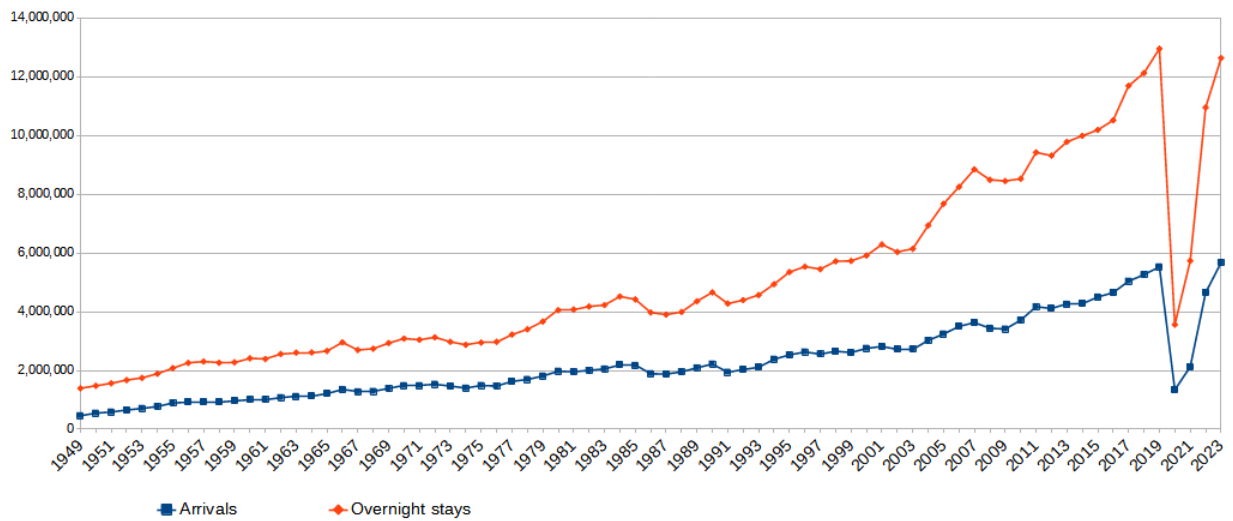


Figure 1.1: Venice, Arrivals and overnight stays historical series from 1949 to 2023.

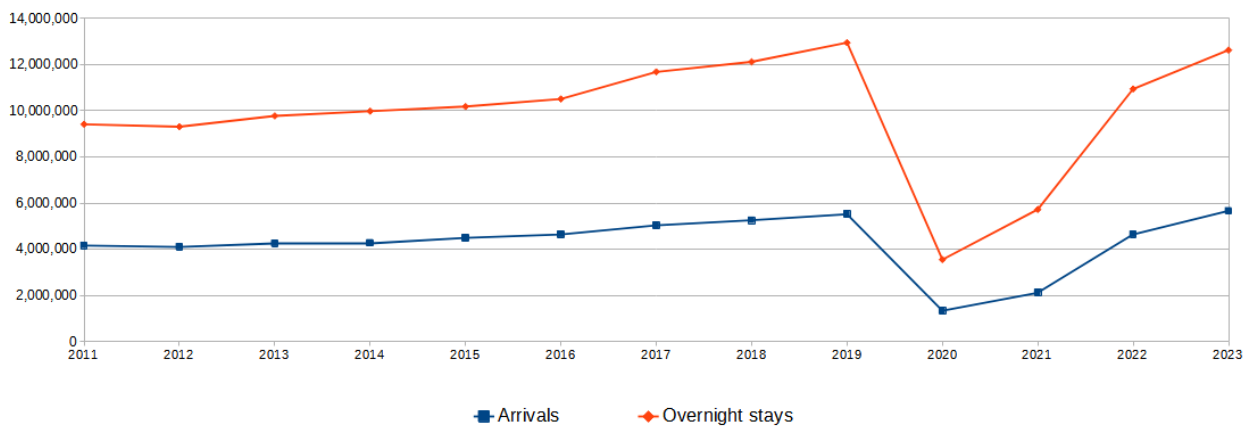


Figure 1.2: Venice, Arrivals and overnight stays historical series from 2011 to 2023.

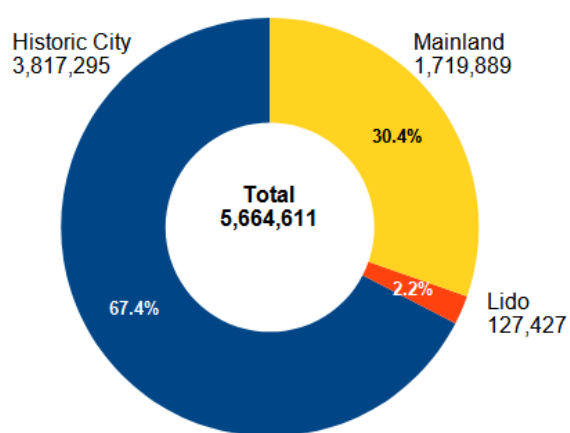


Figure 1.3: 2023 Arrivals by areas.

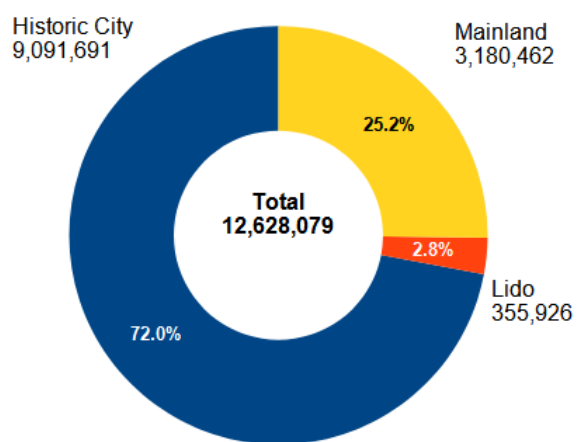


Figure 1.4: 2023 Overnight stays by areas.

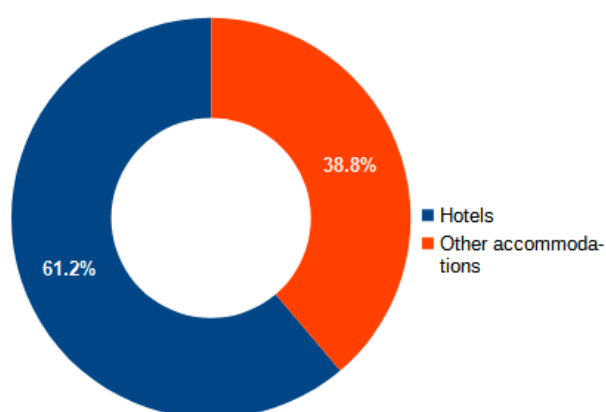


Figure 1.5: 2023 Arrivals by accommodation.

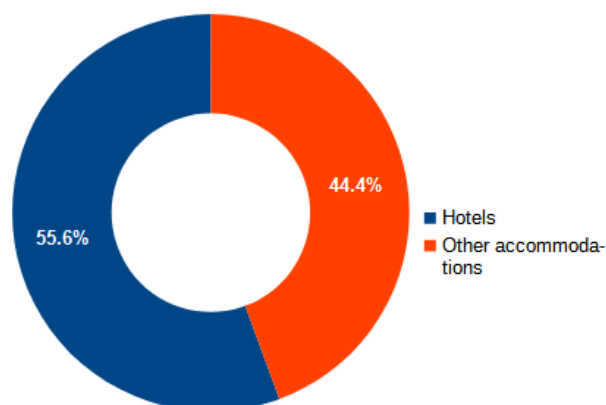


Figure 1.6: 2023 Nights by accommodation.

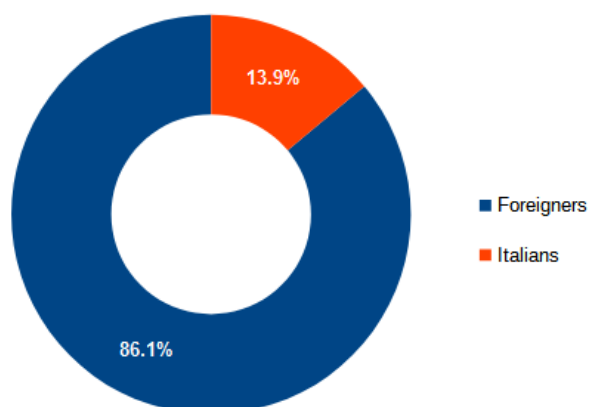


Figure 1.7: 2023 arrivals by origin.

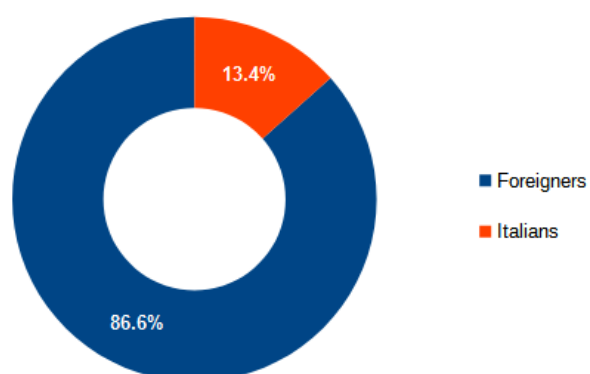


Figure 1.8: 2023 nights by origin.

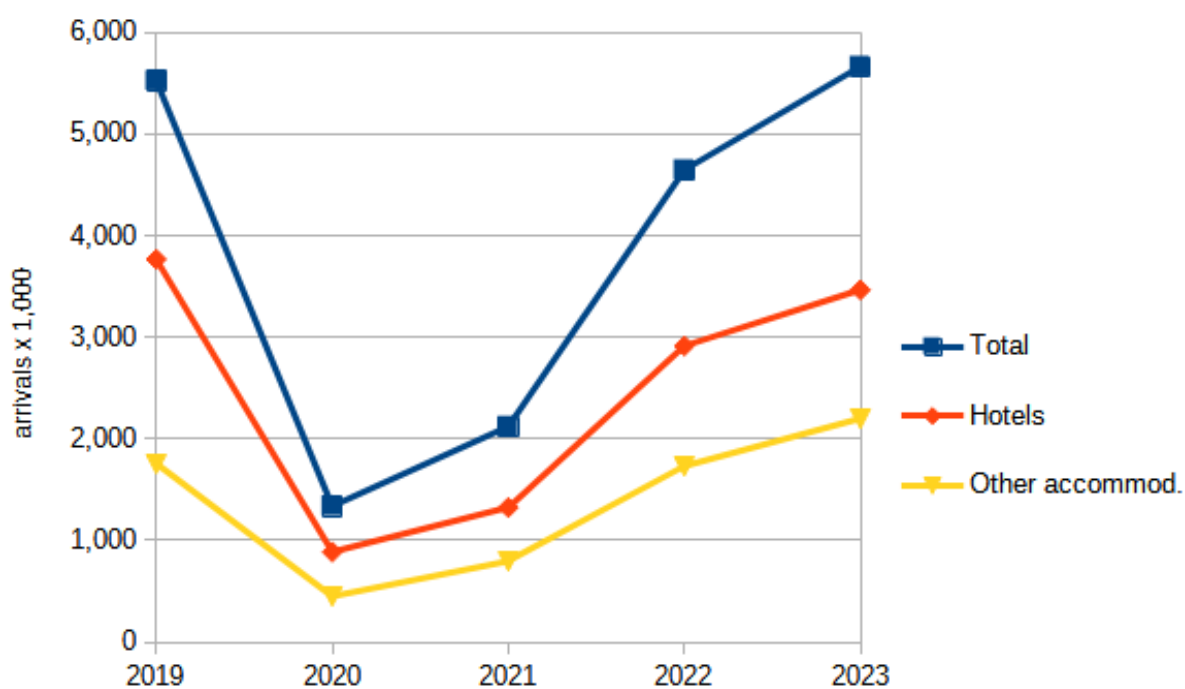


Figure 1.9: Arrivals: total and by accom. facility.

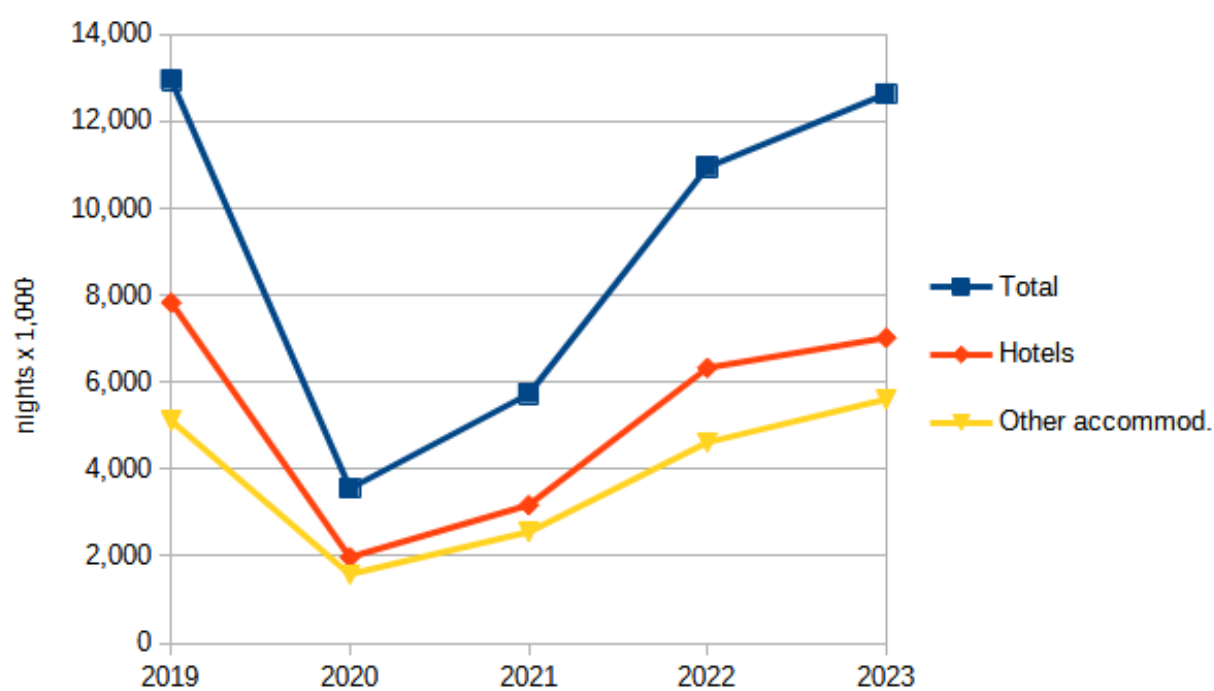


Figure 1.10: Overnight stays: total and by accom. facility.

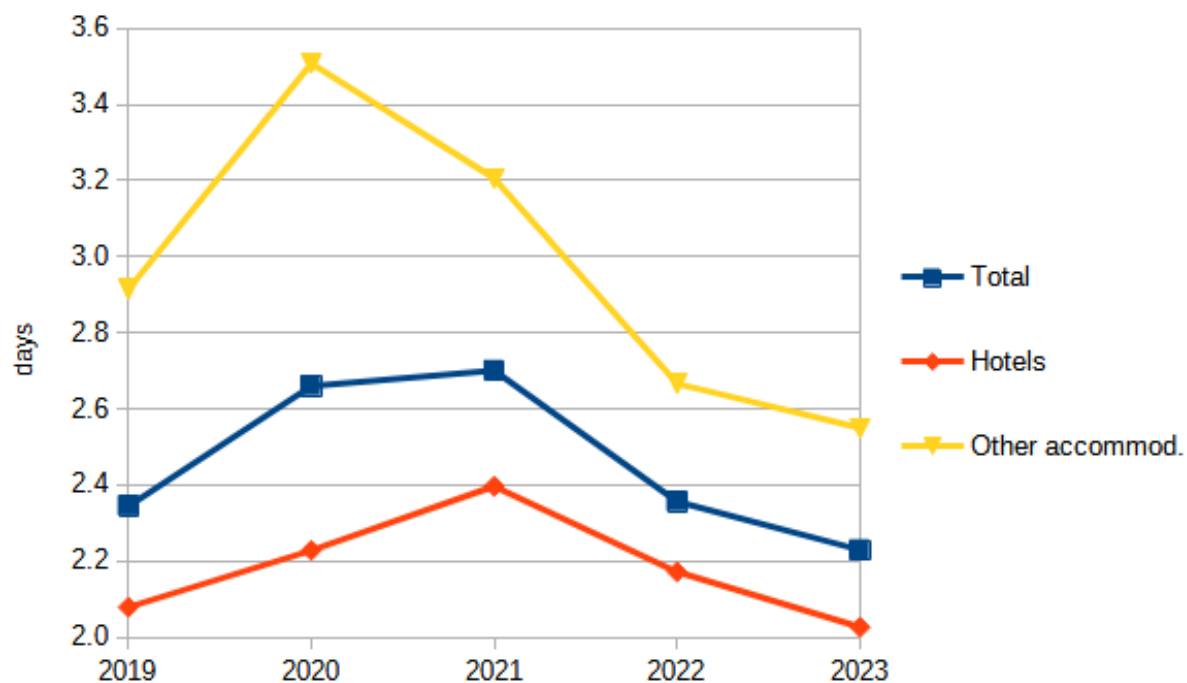


Figure 1.11: Average stay - total and by accom. facility.

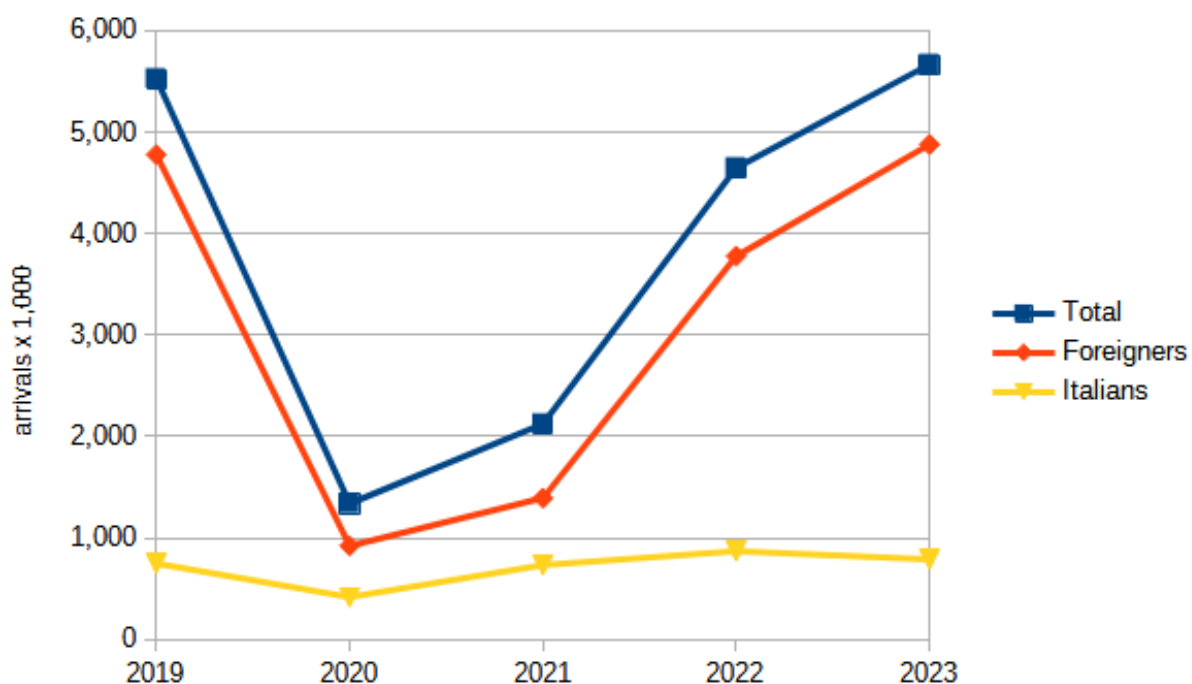


Figure 1.12: Arrivals - Total and by origin.

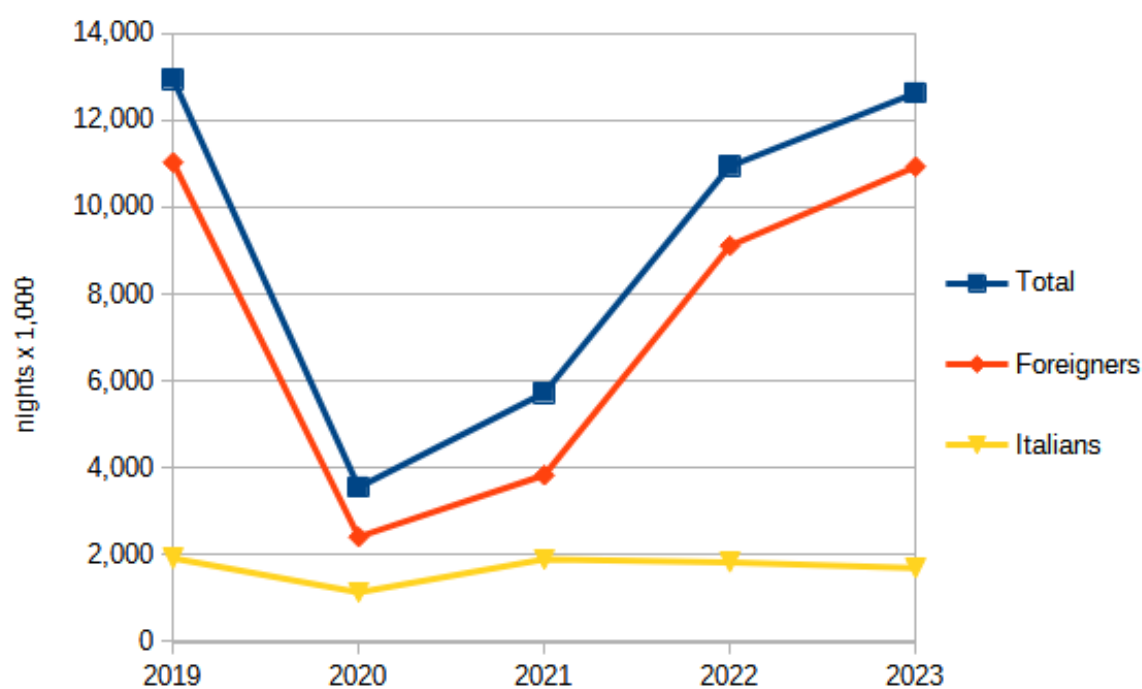


Figure 1.13: Nights - Total and by origin.

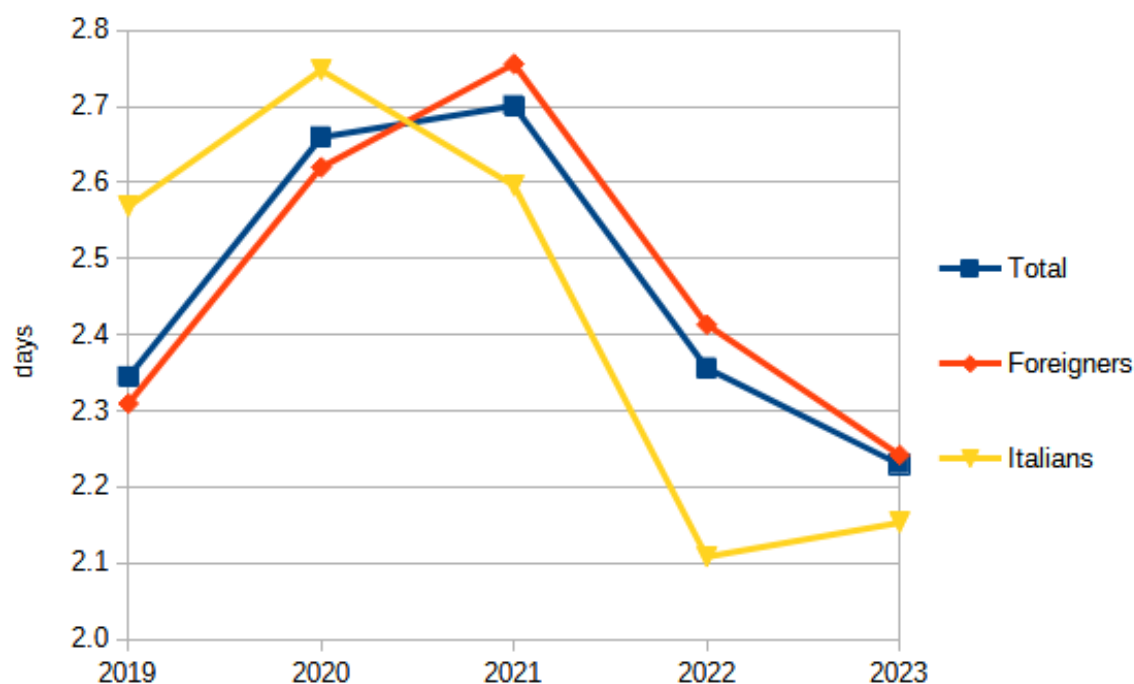


Figure 1.14: Average stay - Total and by origin.

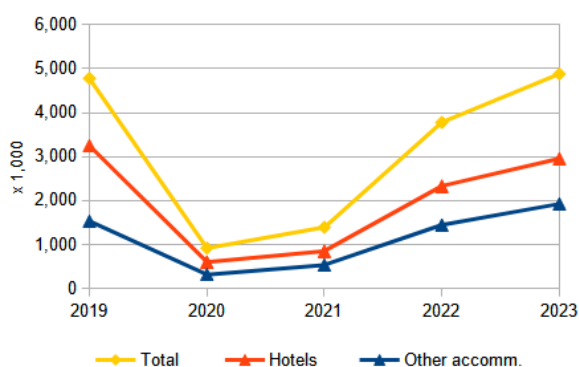


Figure 1.15: Foreign market: Arrivals - Total and by accomm. facility.

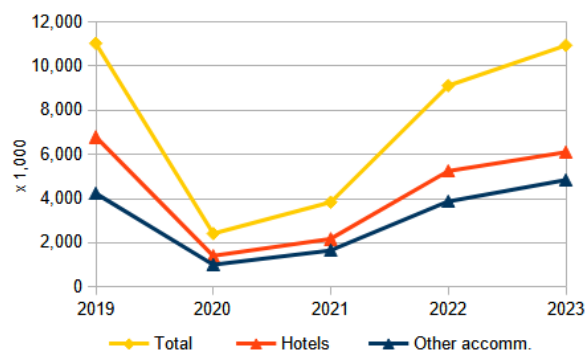


Figure 1.16: Foreign market: Overnight stays - Total and by accomm. facility.

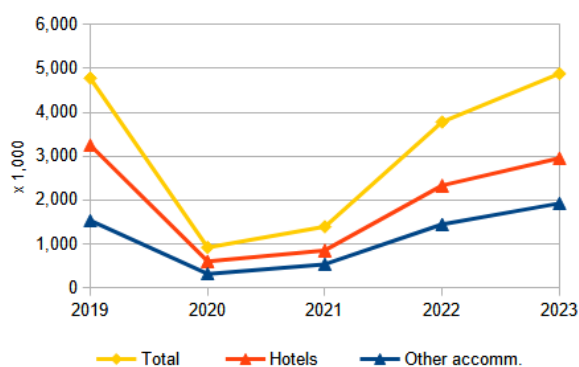


Figure 1.17: Italian market: Arrivals - Total and by accomm. facility.

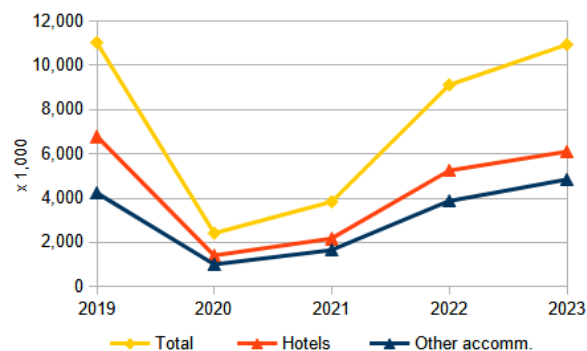


Figure 1.18: Italian market: Overnight stays - Total and by accomm. facility.

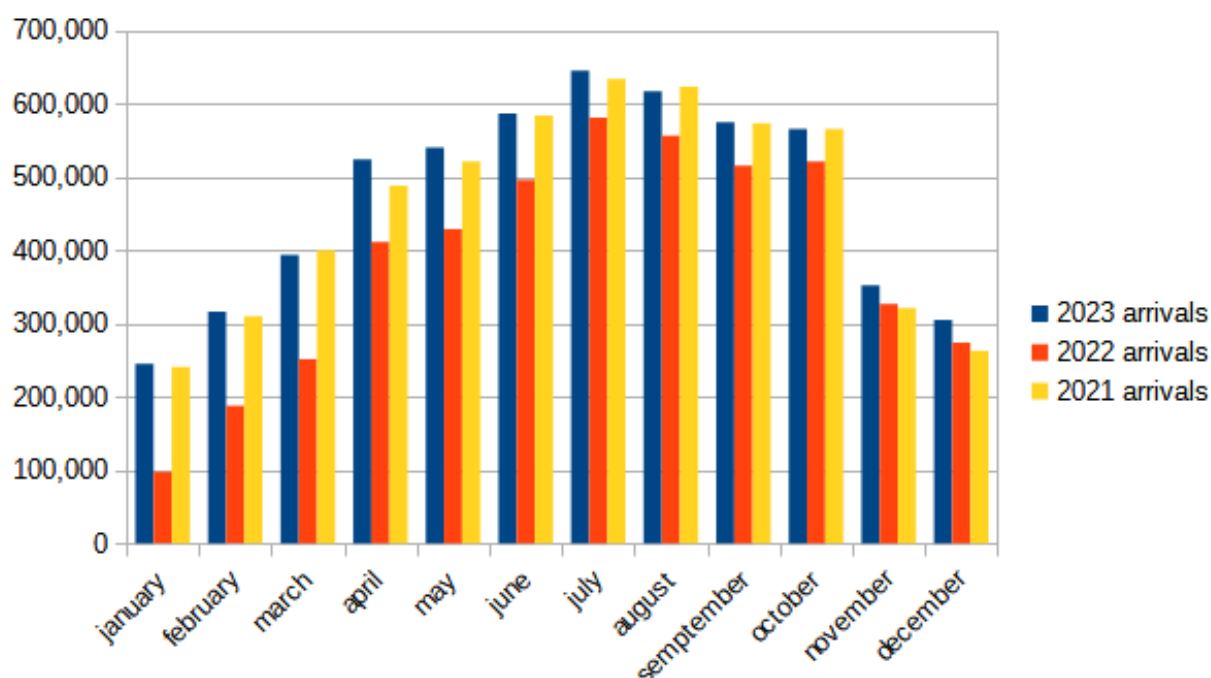


Figure 1.19: 2019-2021-2023 monthly total arrivals.

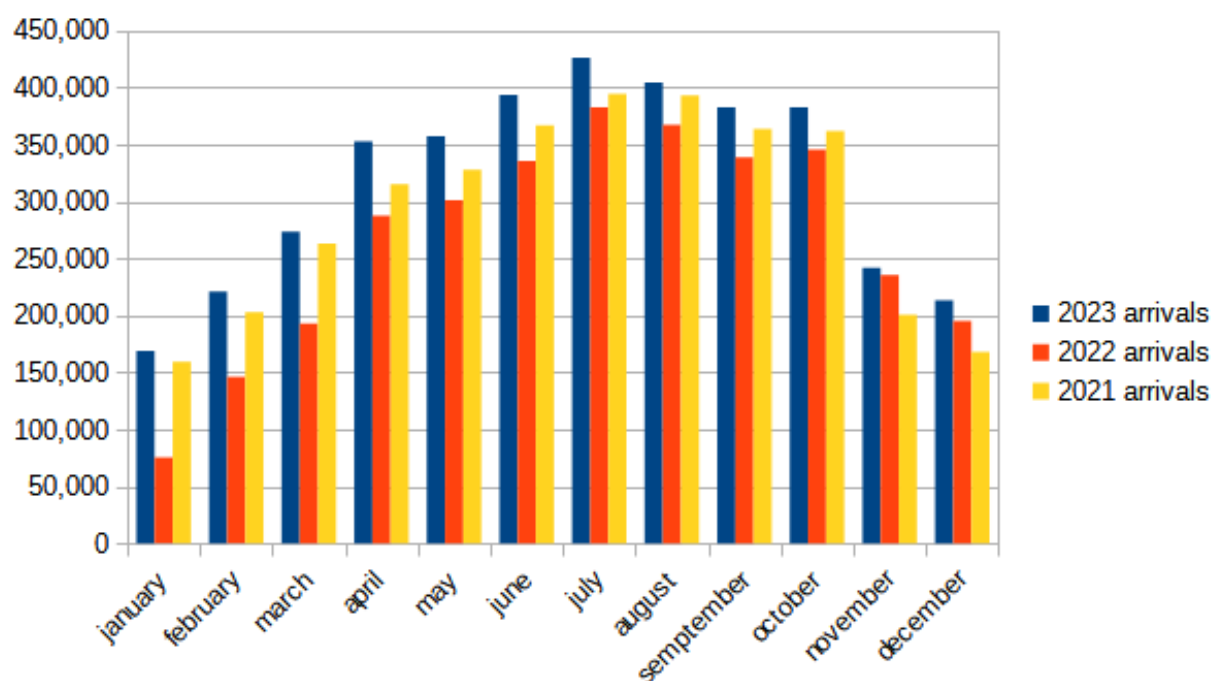


Figure 1.20: 2019-2021-2023 monthly total arrivals, Historic centre

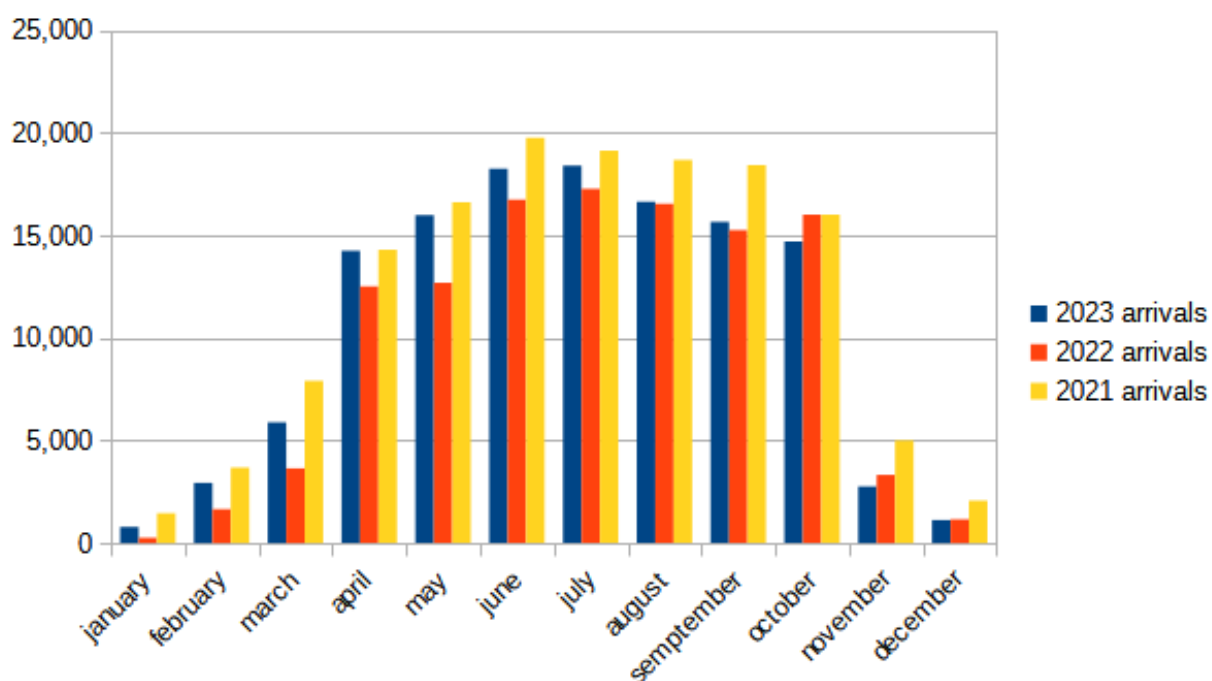


Figure 1.21: 2019-2021-2023 monthly total arrivals, Lido

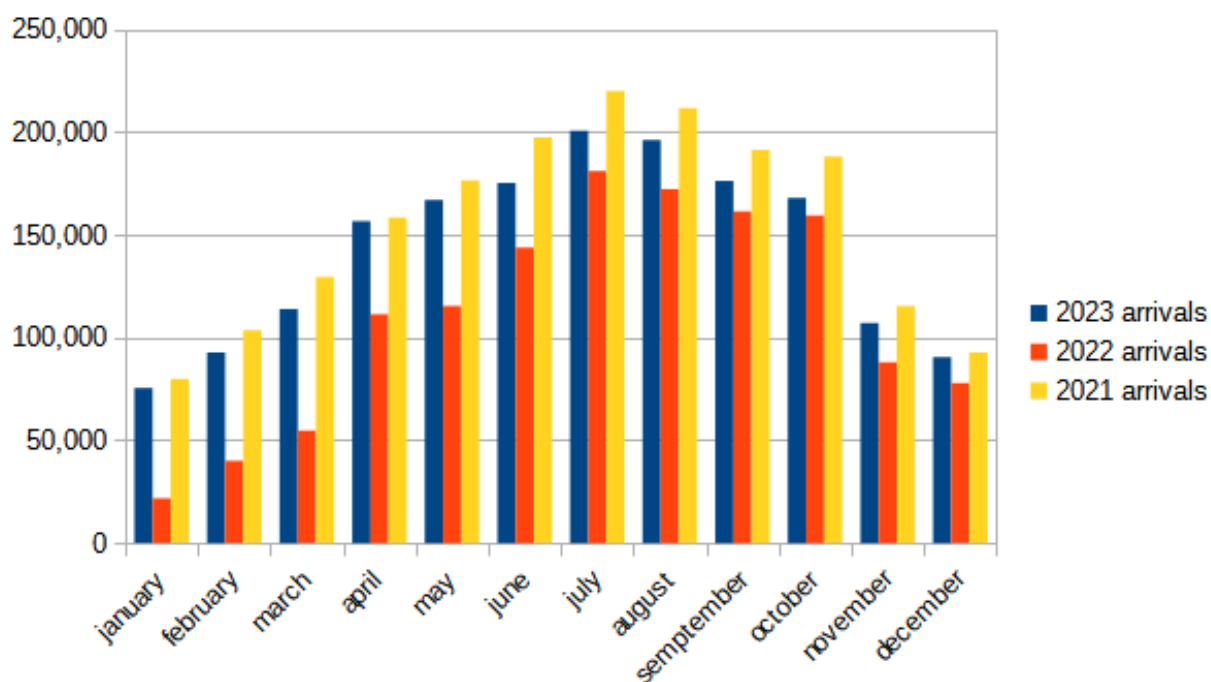


Figure 1.22: 2019-2021-2023 monthly total arrivals, Mainland

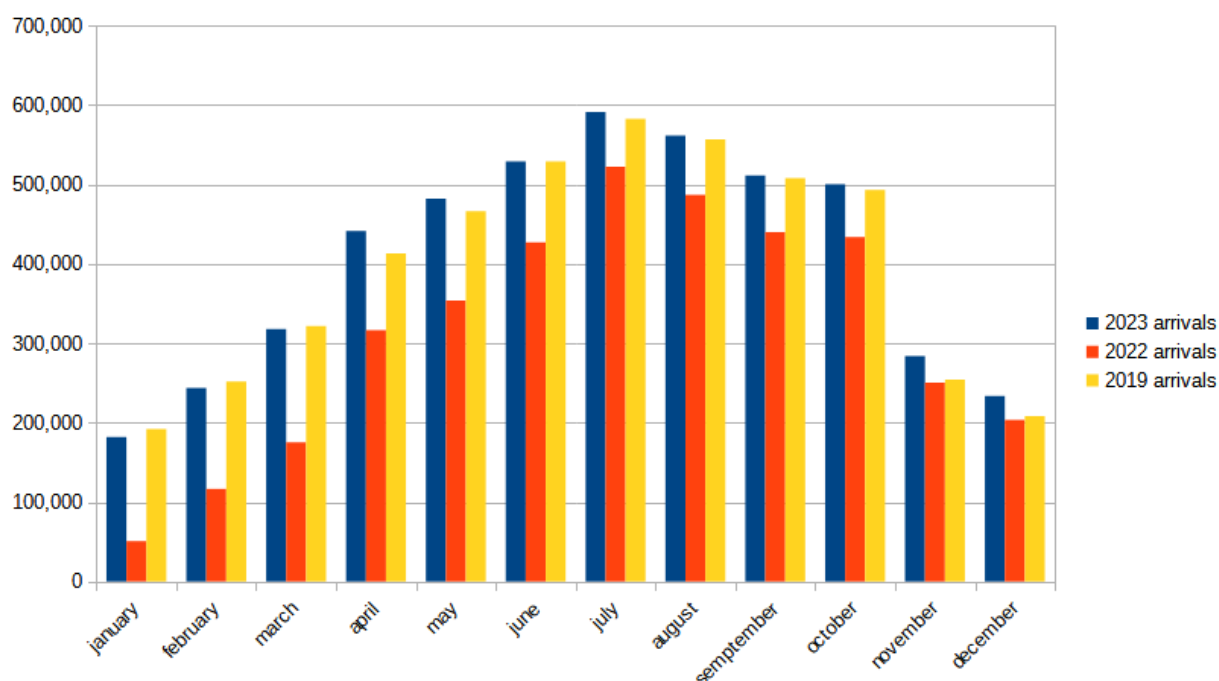


Figure 1.23: Foreign market: 2019-2021-2023 monthly arrivals.

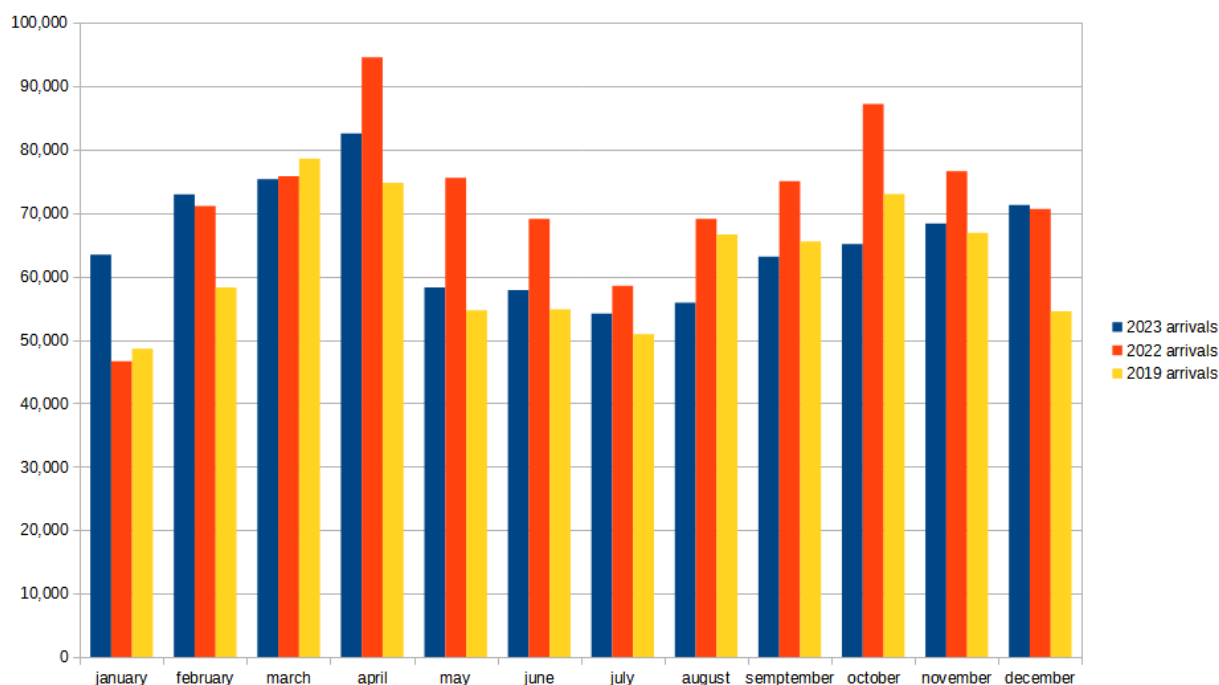


Figure 1.24: Italian market: 2019-2021-2023 monthly arrivals.

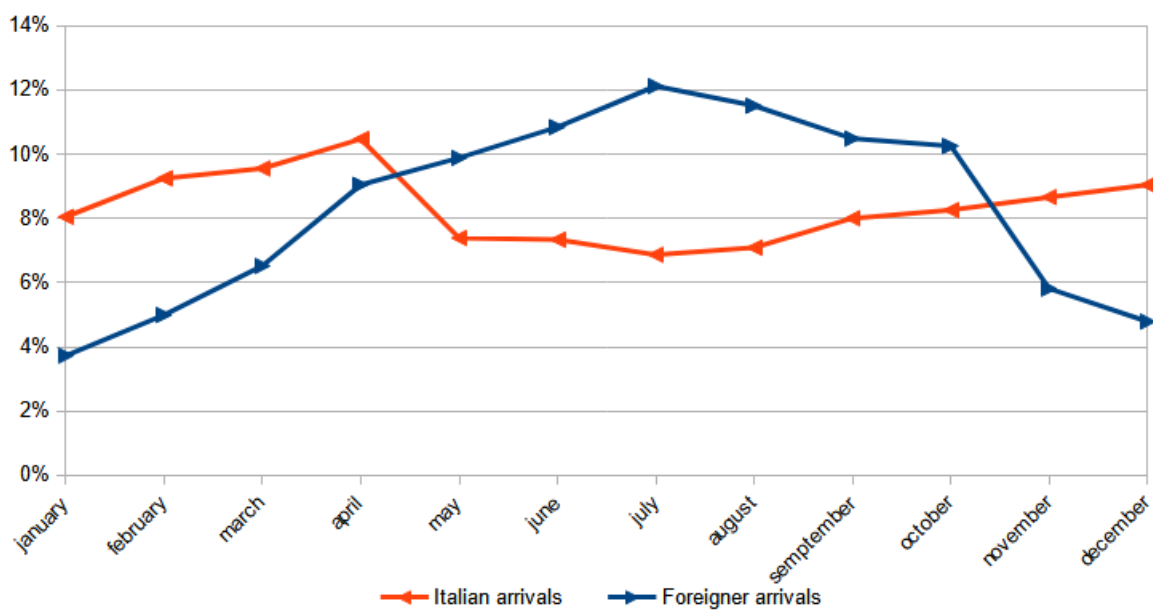


Figure 1.25: Percentage of arrivals by origin on the total annual amount.

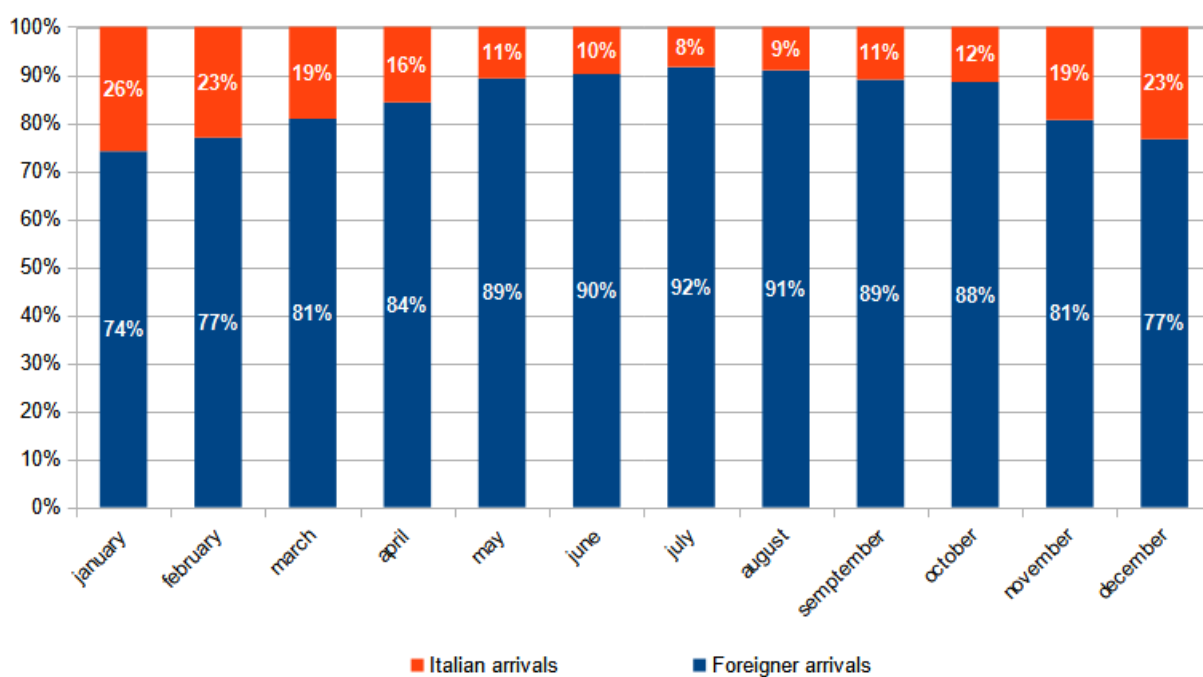


Figure 1.26: Composition of monthly arrivals by origin.

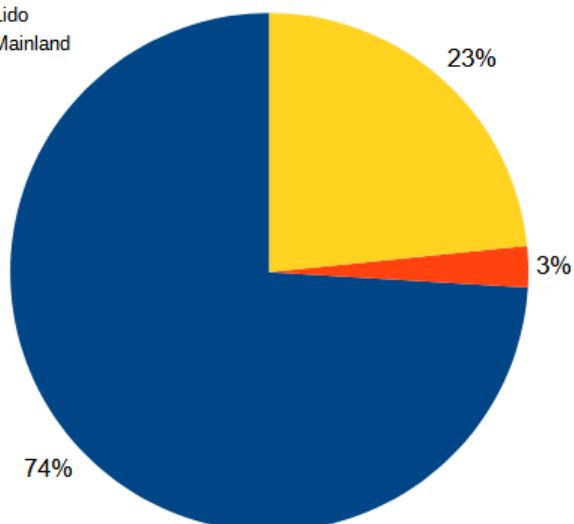


Figure 1.27: Overnight stays 2023: Foreigners % composition per area.

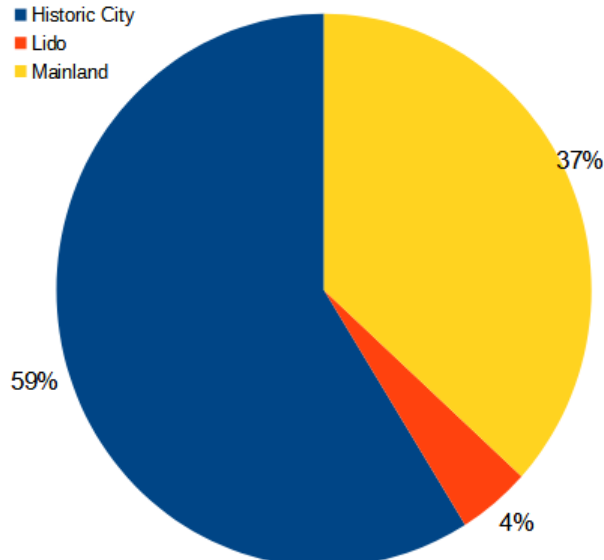


Figure 1.28: Overnight stays 2023: Italians % composition per area.

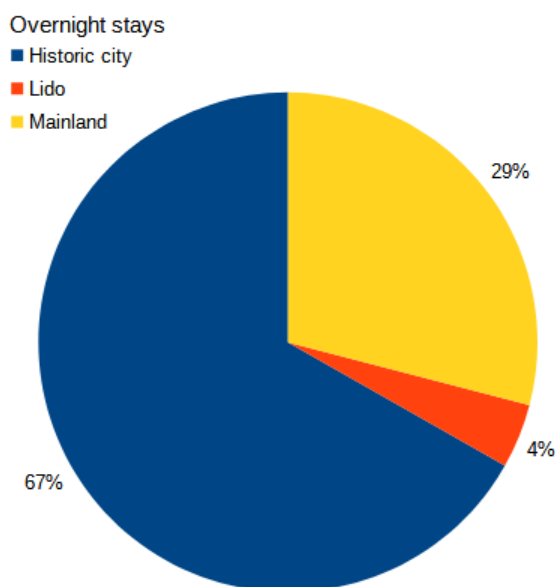


Figure 1.29: Hotel overnight stays 2023: % composition per area.

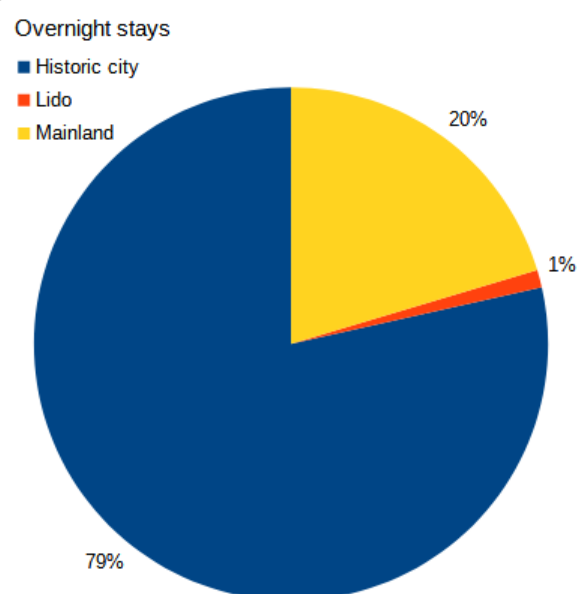


Figure 1.30: Other accommodations overnight stays 2023: % composition per area.

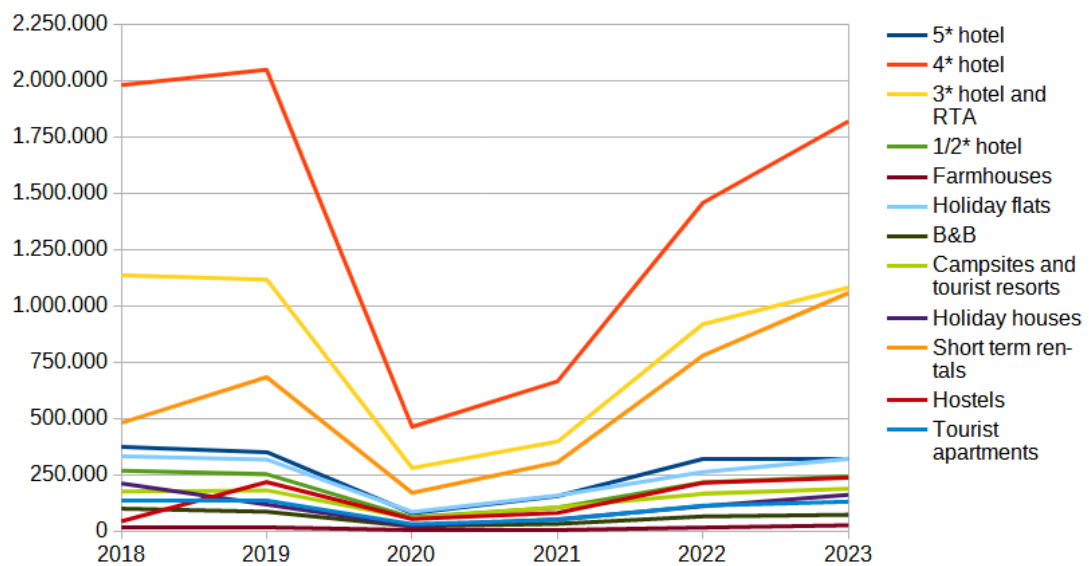


Figure 1.31: Arrivals trend for the years 2018-2023 by accommodation type, total City of Venice.

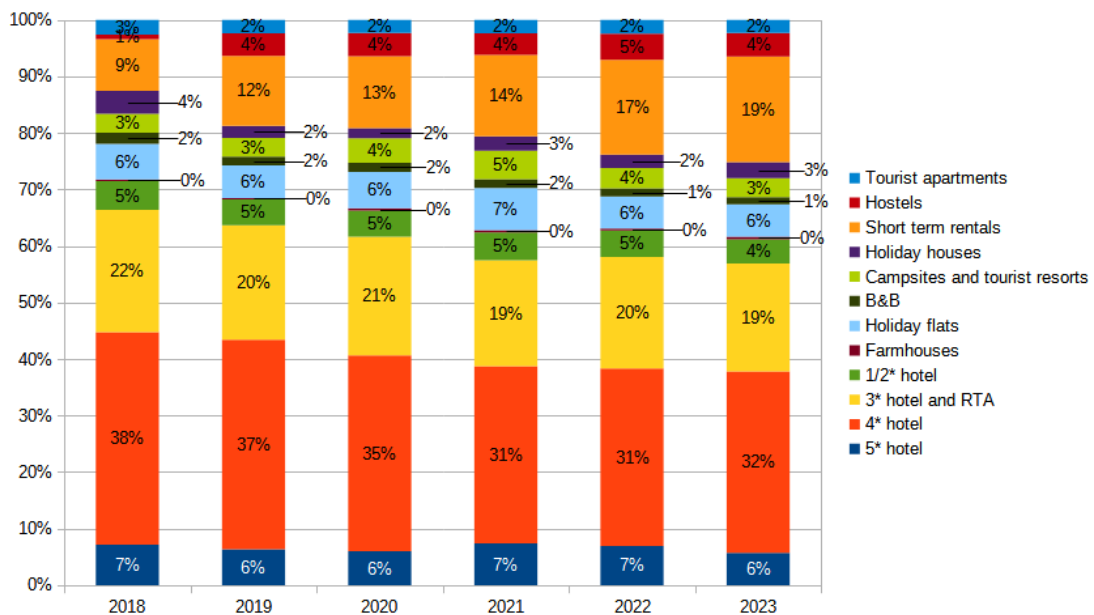


Figure 1.32: Arrivals composition for the years 2018-2023 by accommodation type, total City of Venice.

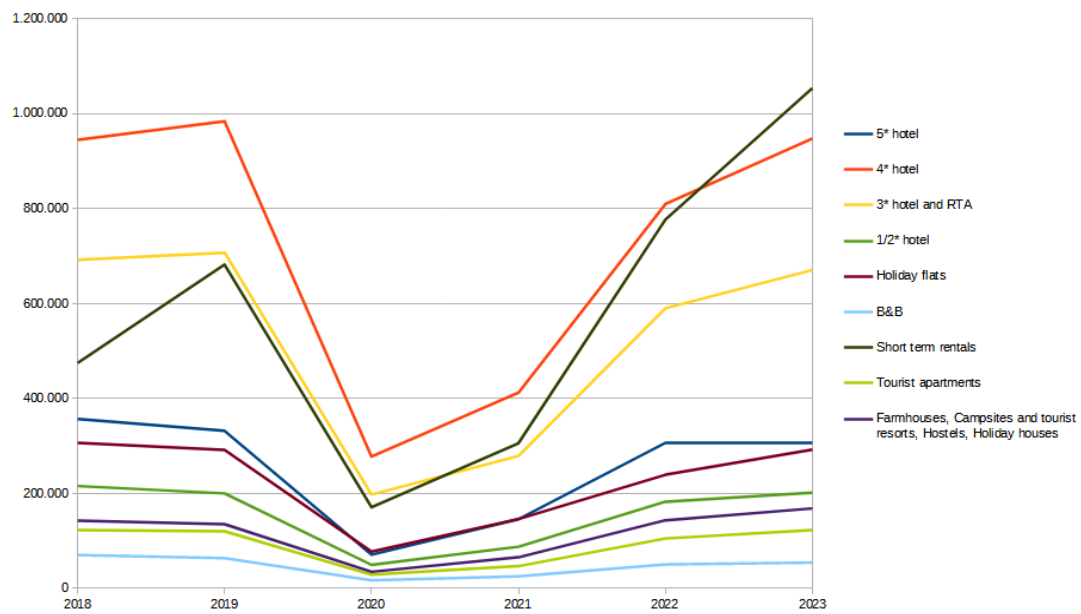


Figure 1.33: Arrivals trend for the years 2018-2023 by accommodation type, Historic Centre.

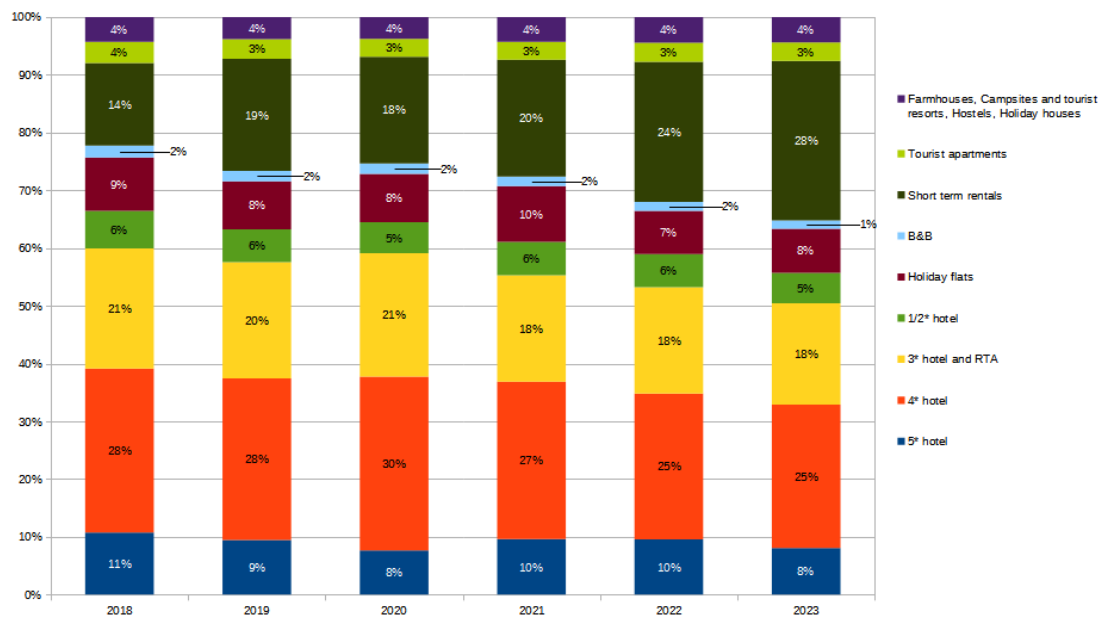


Figure 1.34: Arrivals composition for the years 2018-2023 by accommodation type, historic Centre.

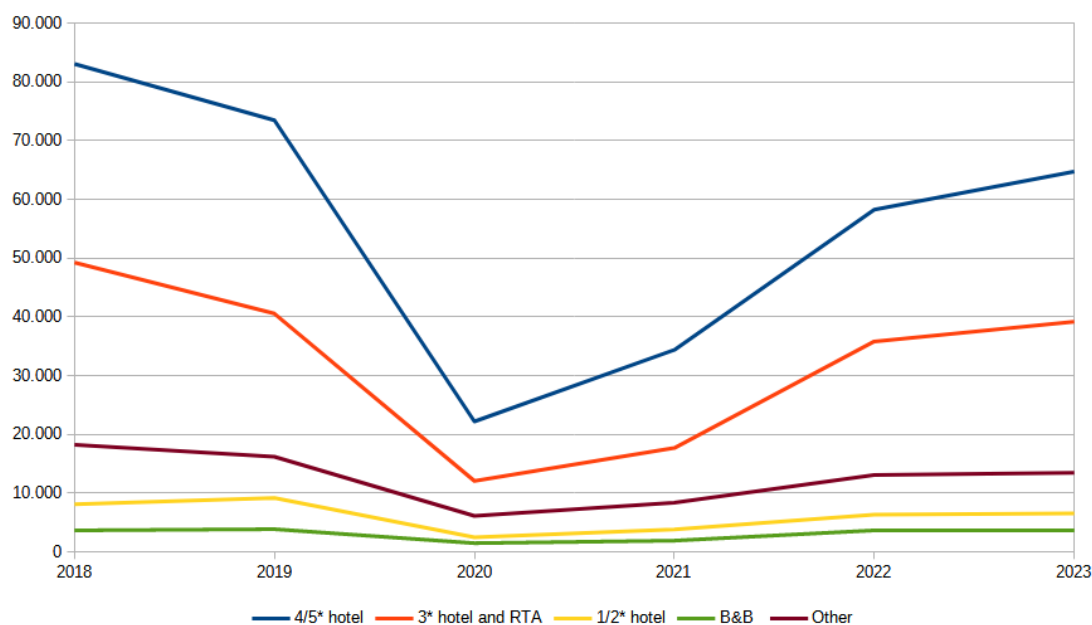


Figure 1.35: Arrivals trend for the years 2018-2023 by accommodation type, Lido.

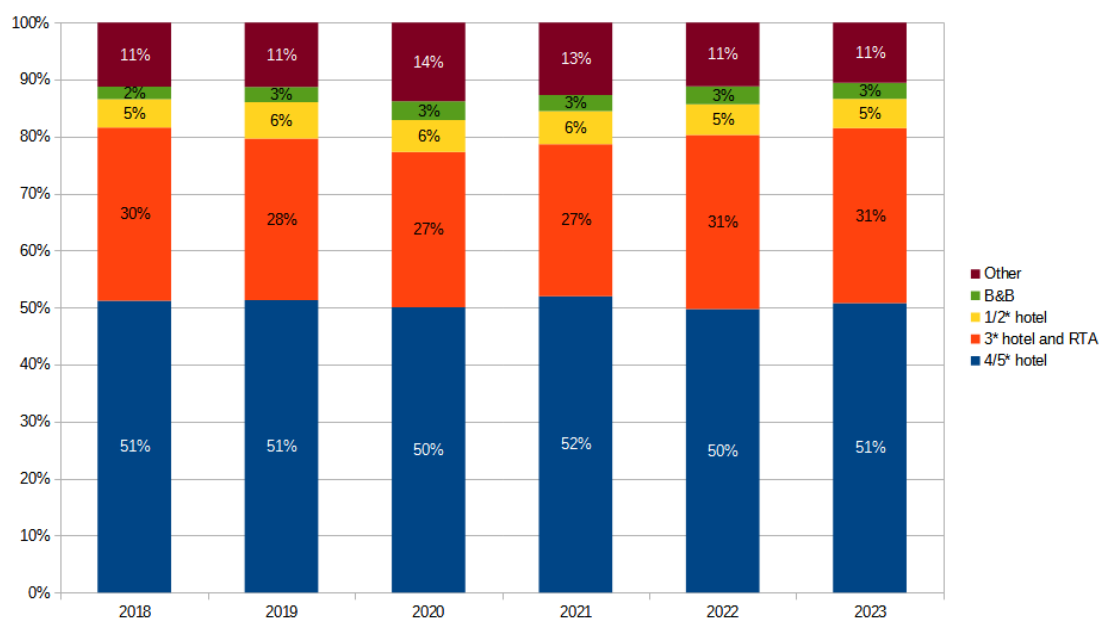


Figure 1.36: Arrivals composition for the years 2018-2023 by accommodation type, Lido.

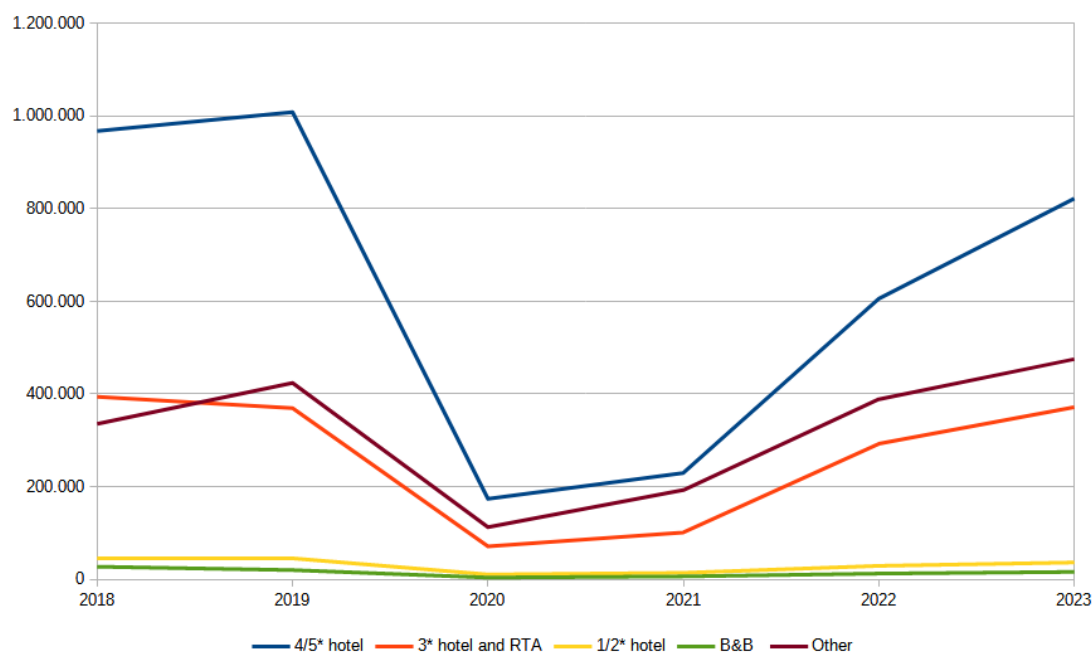


Figure 1.37: Arrivals trend for the years 2018-2023 by accommodation type, Mainland.

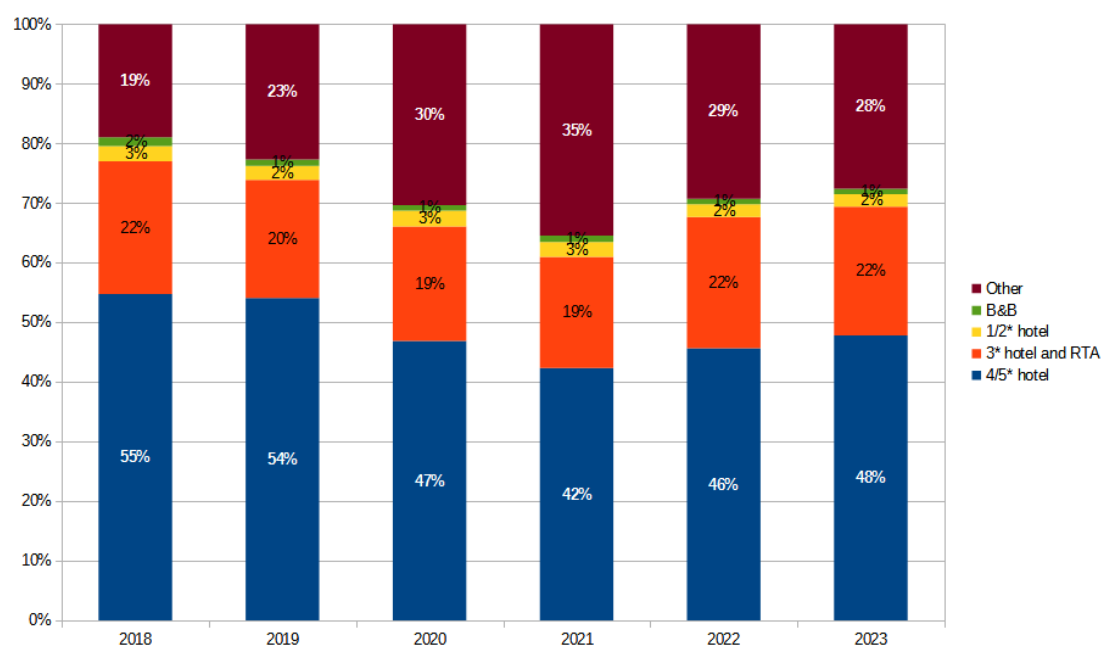


Figure 1.38: Arrivals composition for the years 2018-2023 by accommodation type, Mainland

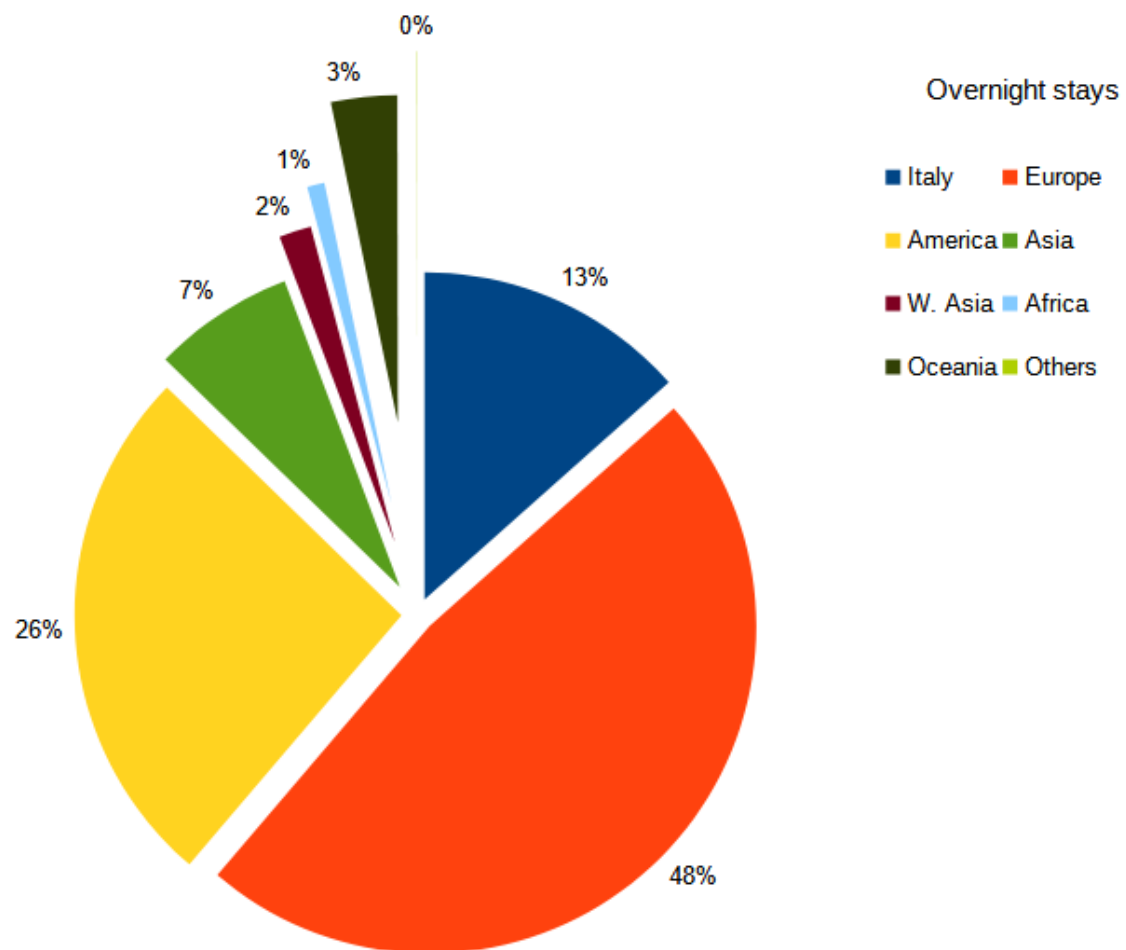


Figure 1.39: 2023 Overnight stays distribution by origin.

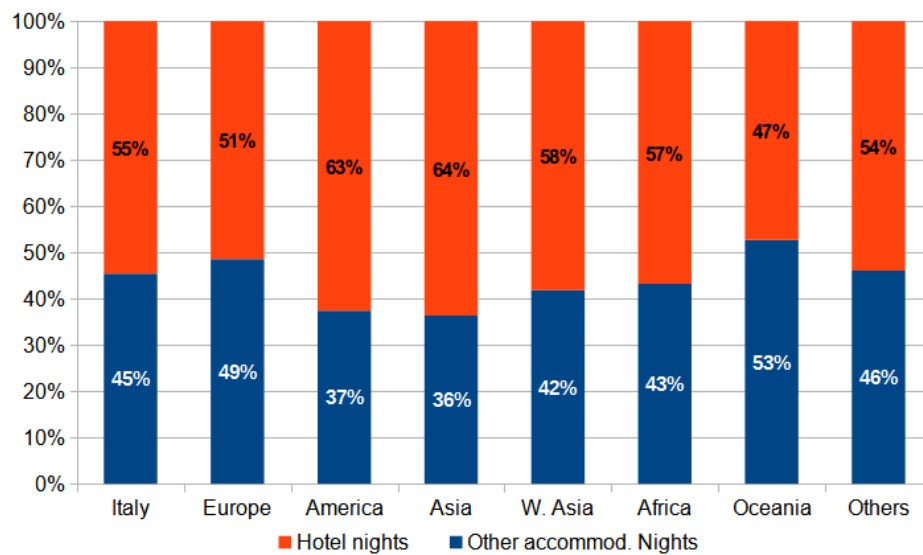


Figure 1.40: 2023 overnight stays composition by origin and acc. facilities.

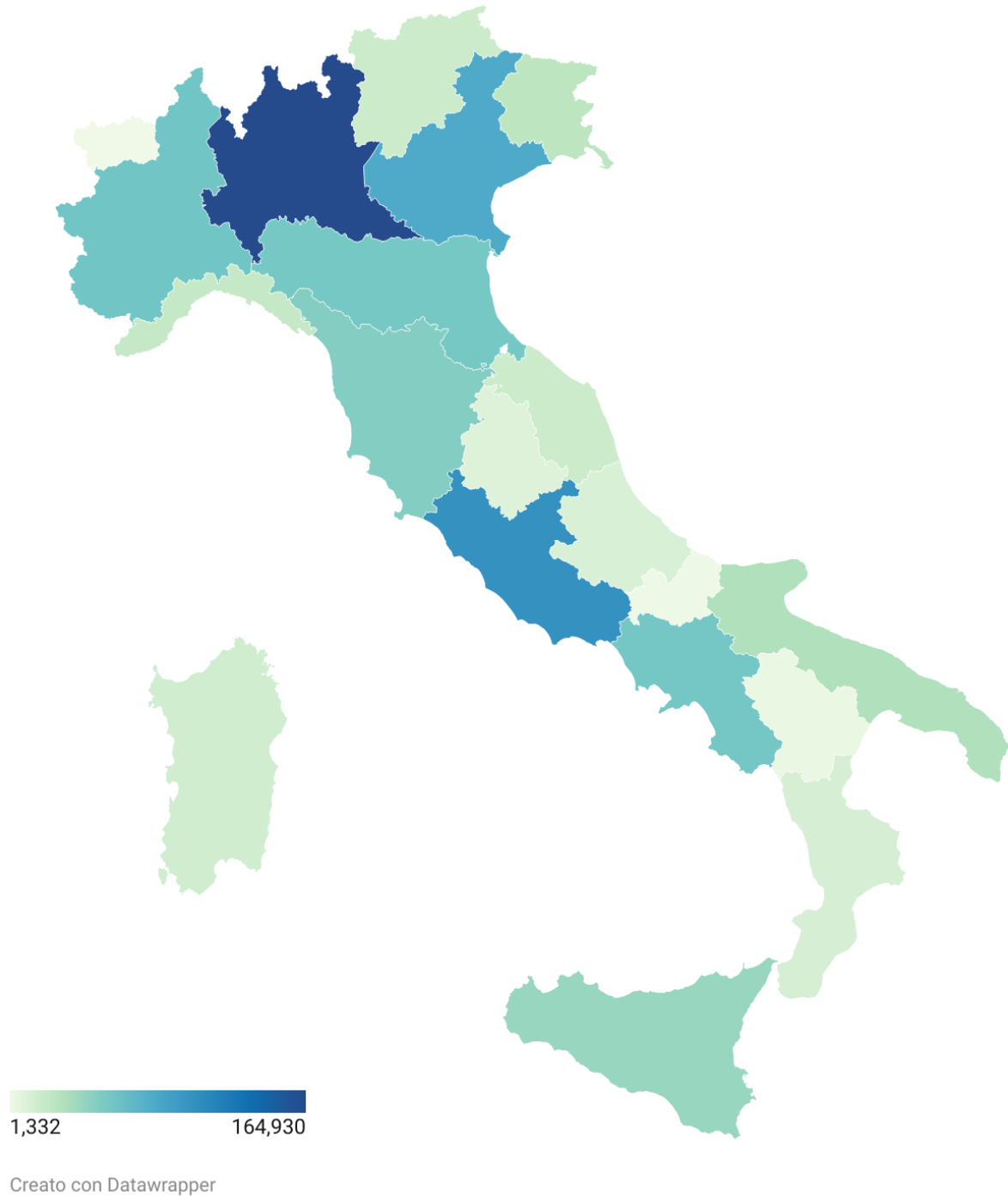


Figure 1.41: Arrivals by region of origin - Italy

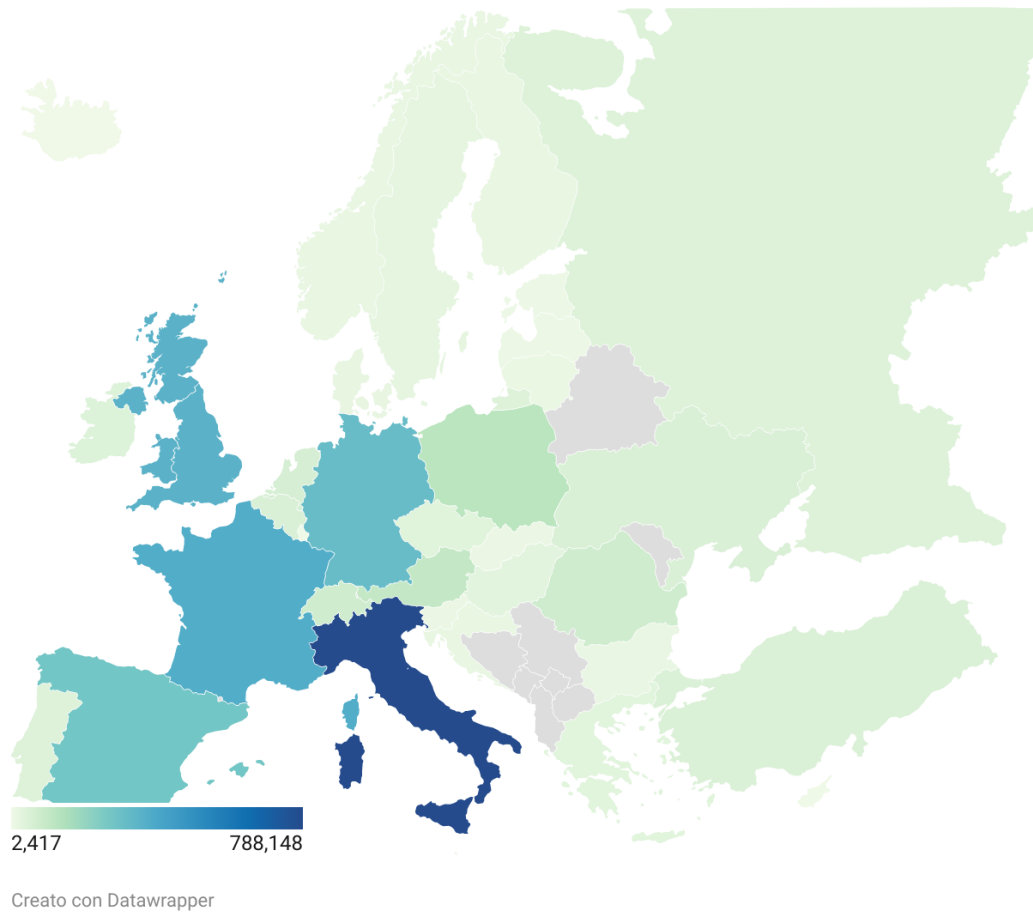


Figure 1.42: Arrivals by country of origin - Europe

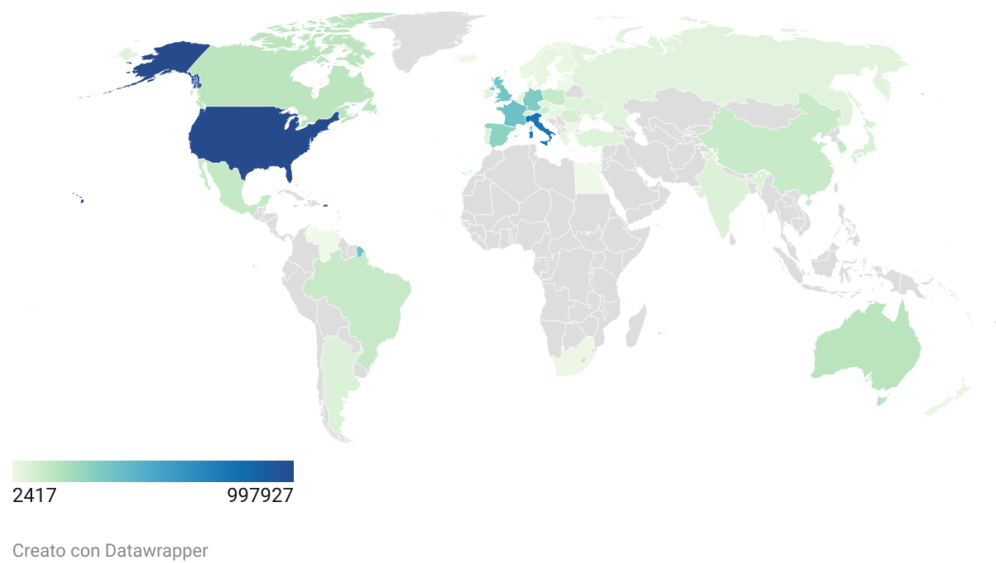


Figure 1.43: Arrivals by country of origin - World

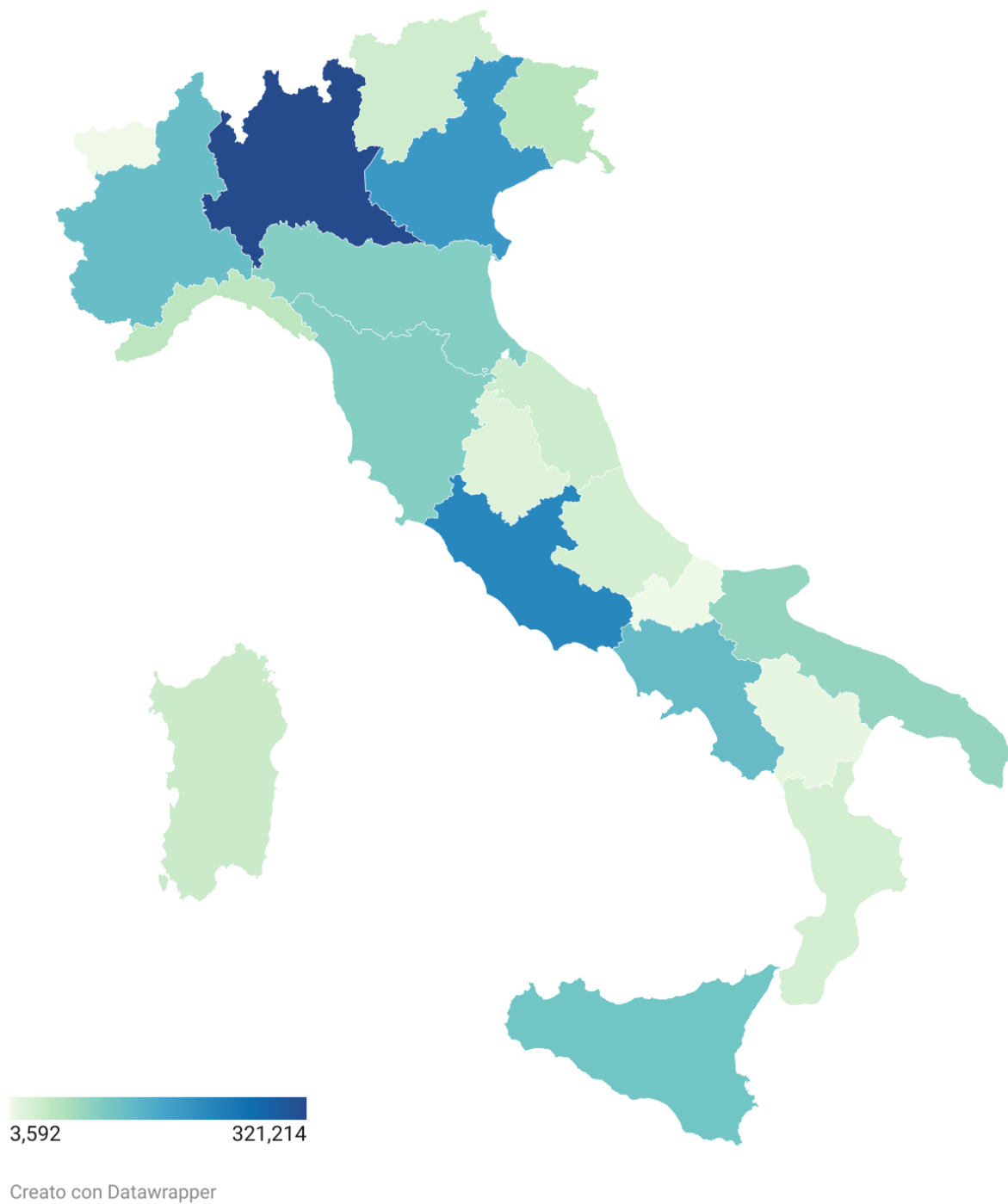


Figure 1.44: Overnight stays by region of origin - Italy

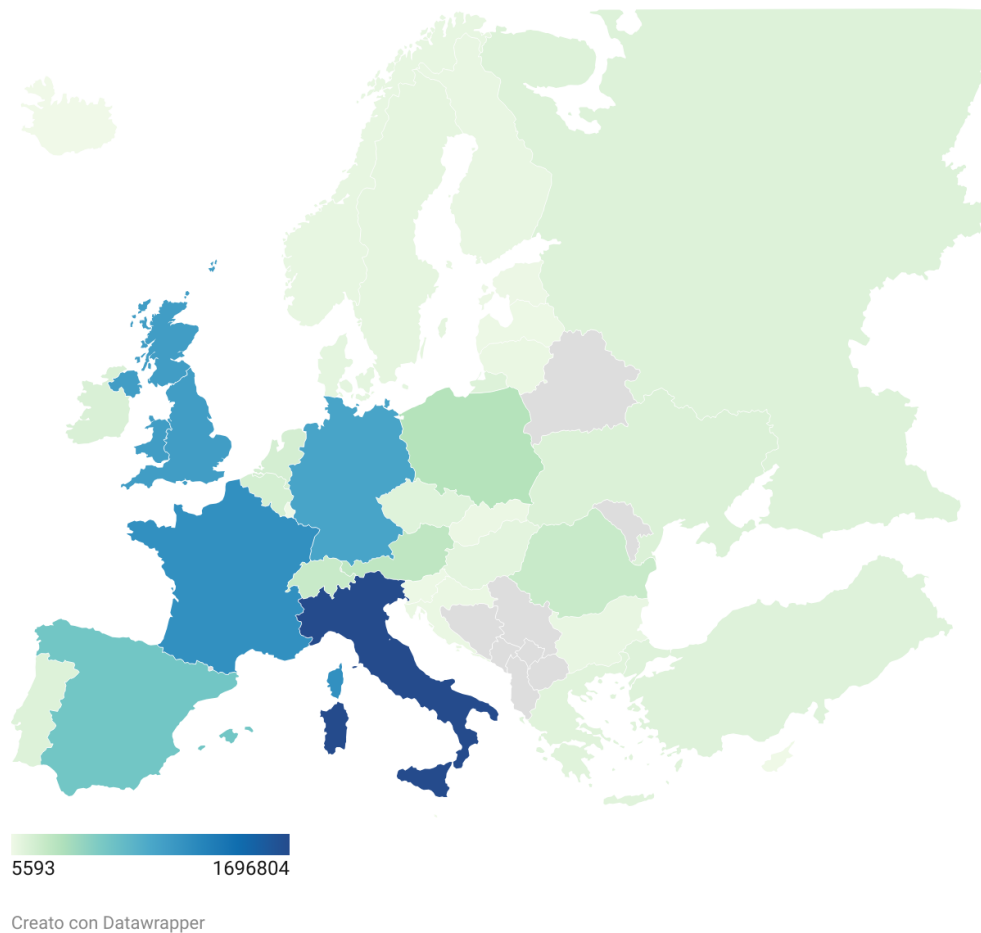


Figure 1.45: Overnight stays by country of origin - Europe

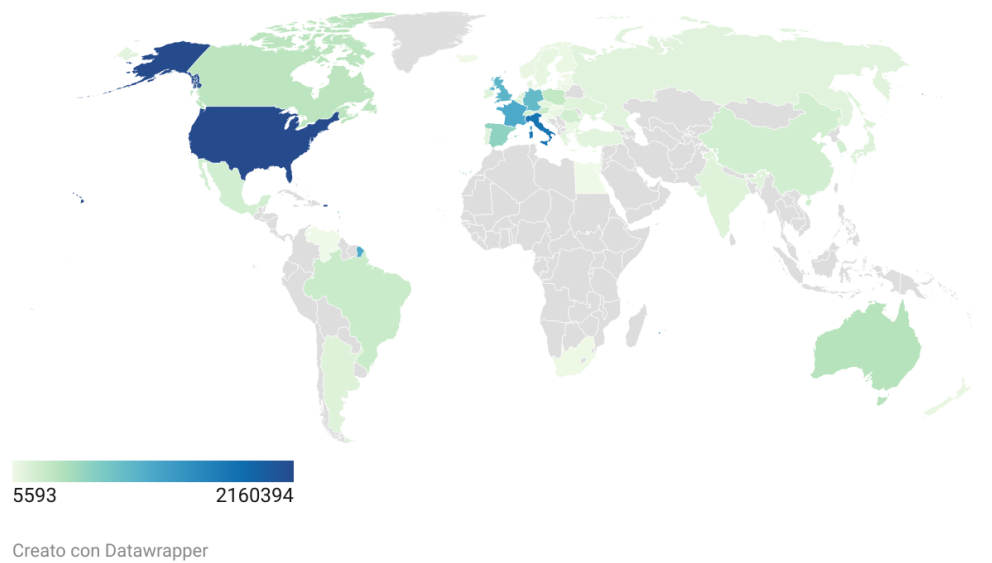


Figure 1.46: Overnight stays by country of origin - World

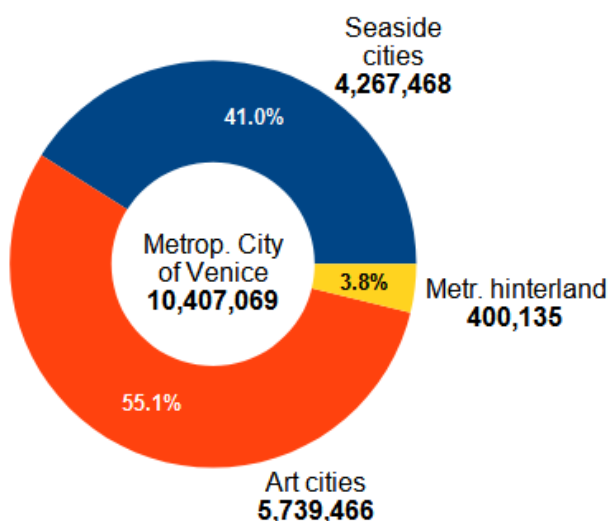


Figure 2.1: Metropolitan City of Venice: 2023 Arrivals by area.

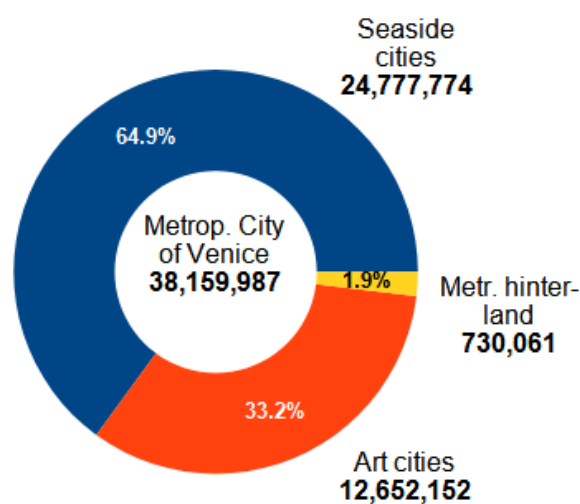


Figure 2.2: Metropolitan City of Venice: 2023 Nights by area

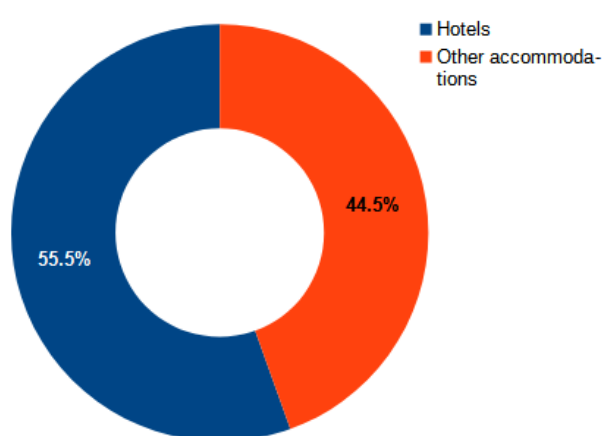


Figure 2.3: Metropolitan City of Venice: 2023 Arrivals by accommodation.

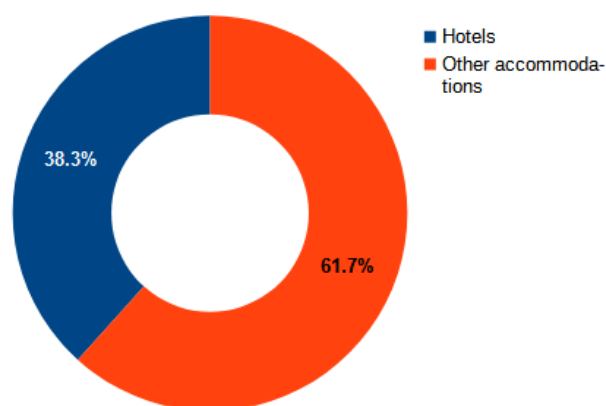


Figure 2.4: Metropolitan City of Venice: 2023 Nights by accommodation.

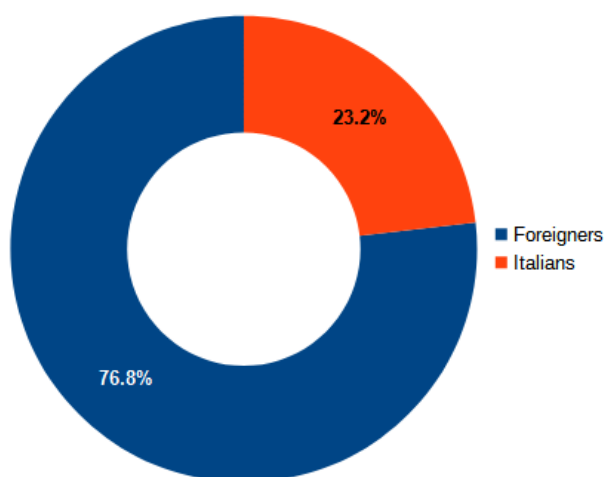


Figure 2.5: Metropolitan City of Venice: 2023 Arrivals by origin.

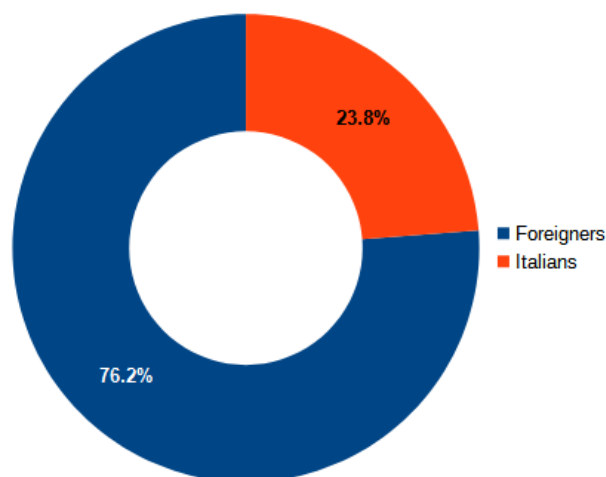


Figure 2.6: Metropolitan City of Venice: 2023 Nights by origin.

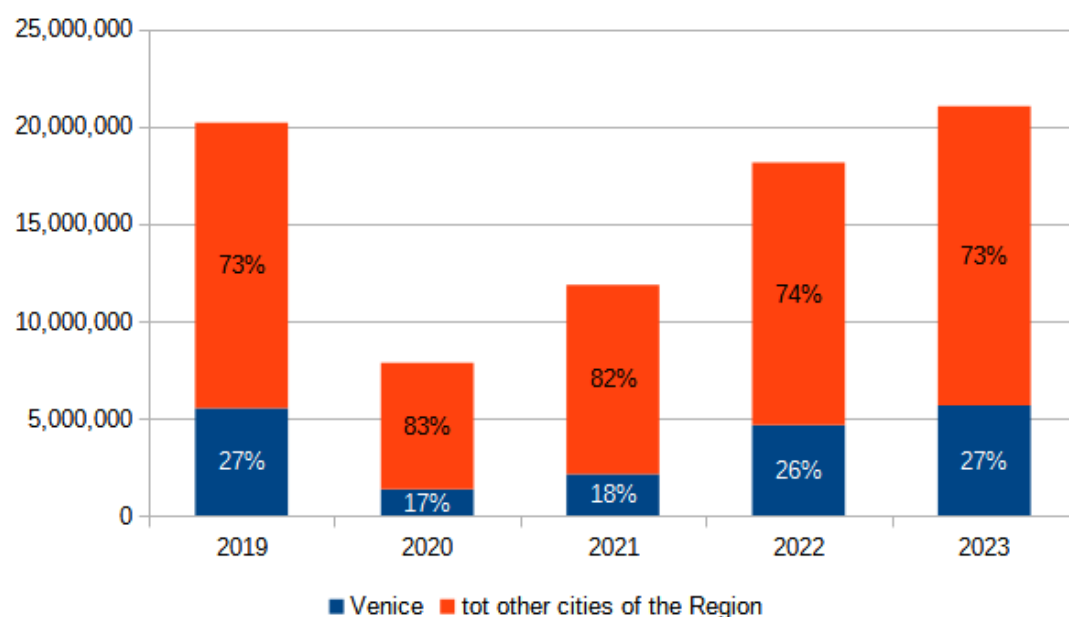


Figure 3.1: Incidence rate of Venice arrivals on Veneto Region total arrivals.

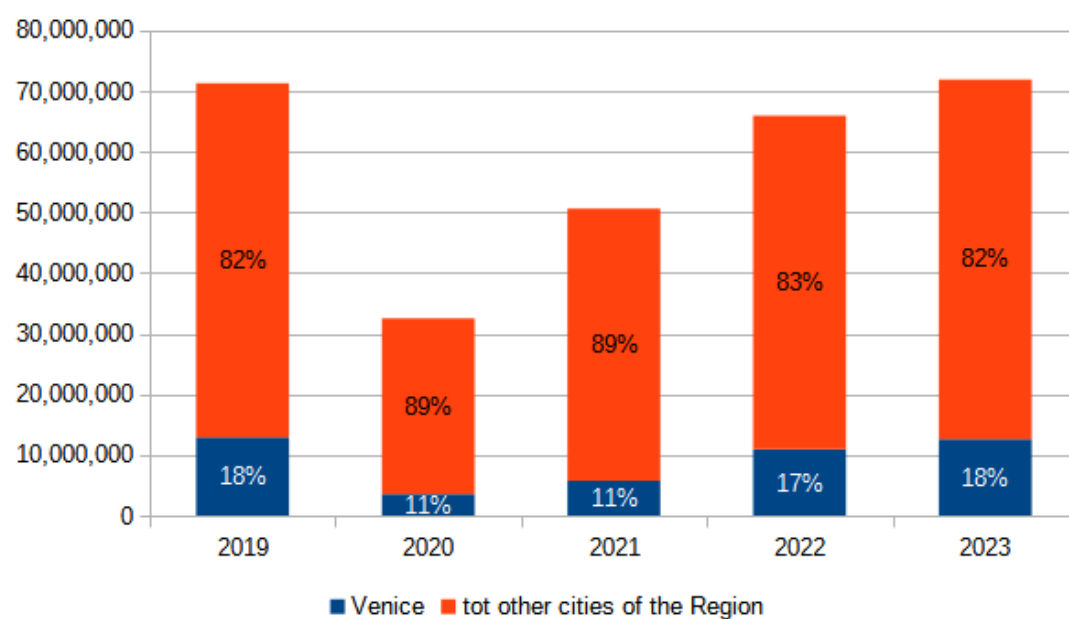


Figure 3.2: Incidence rate of Venice overnight stays on Veneto Region total overnight stays.

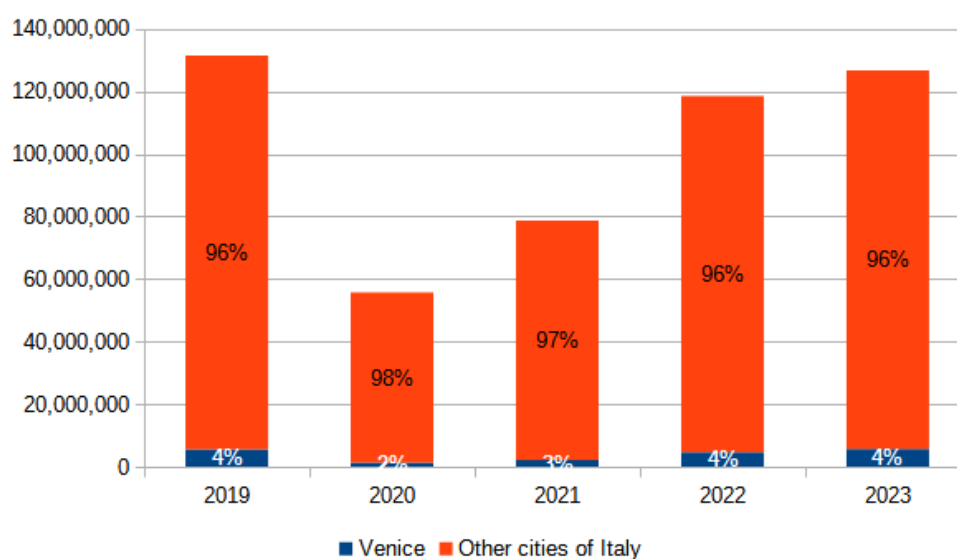


Figure 3.3: Incidence rate of Venice arrivals on Italy total arrivals.

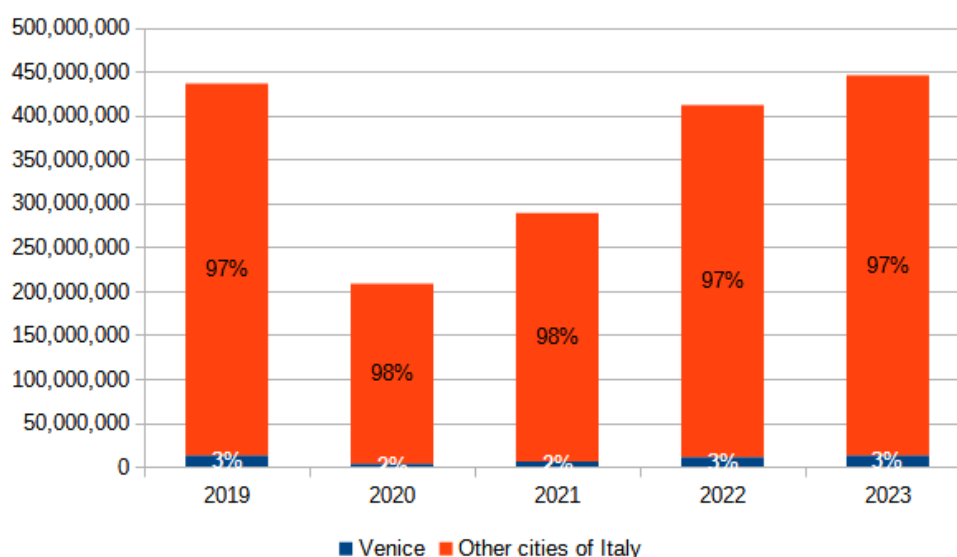


Figure 3.4: Incidence rate of Venice overnight stays on Italy total overnight stays.

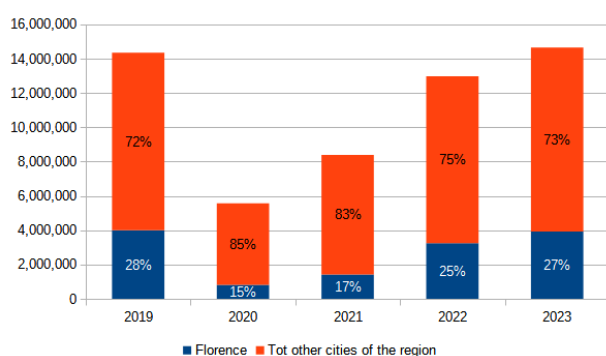


Figure 3.5: Incidence rate of Florence arrivals on Tuscany Region total arrivals.

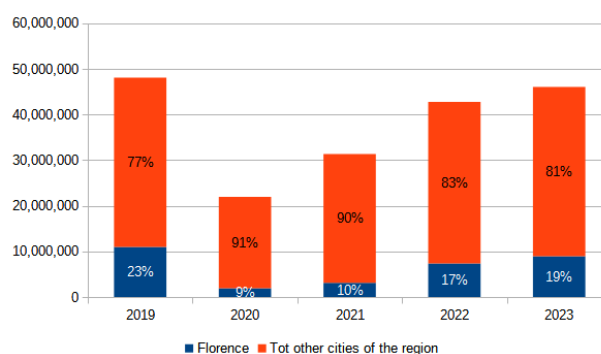


Figure 3.6: Incidence rate of Florence overnight stays on Tuscany Region total overnight stays.

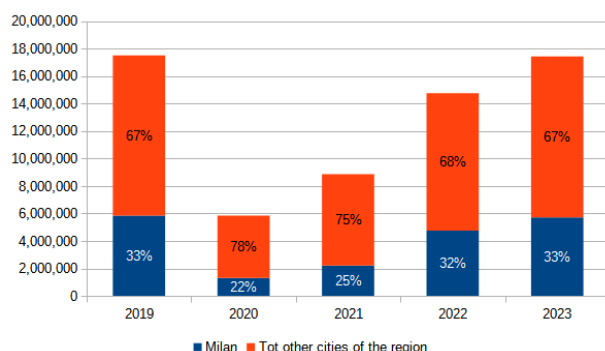


Figure 3.7: Incidence rate of Milan arrivals on Lombardy Region total arrivals.

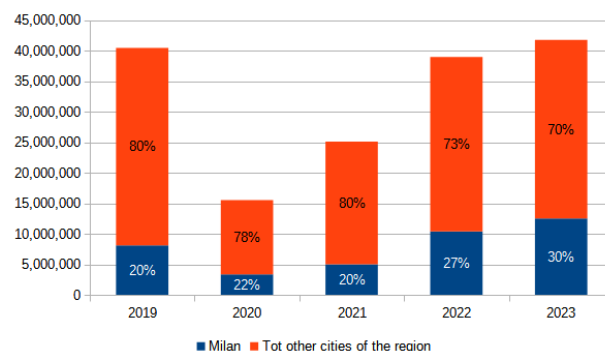


Figure 3.8: Incidence rate of Milan overnight stays on Lombardy Region total overnight stays.

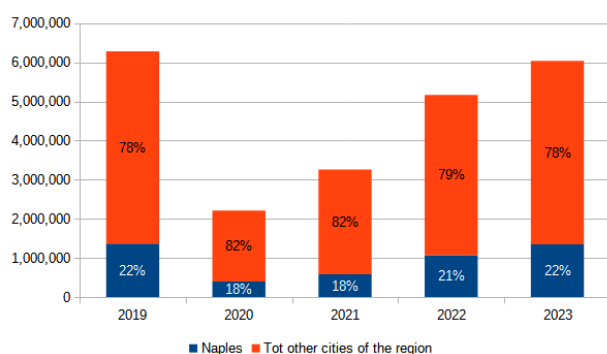


Figure 3.9: Incidence rate of Naples arrivals on Campania Region total arrivals.

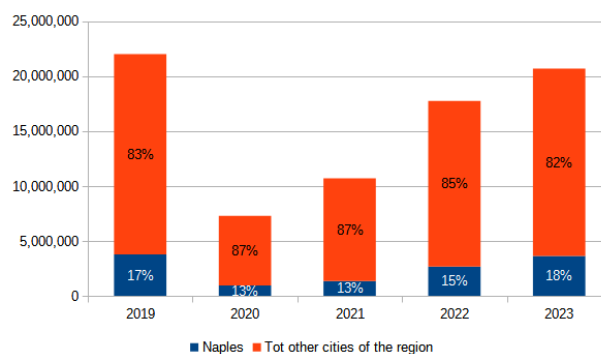


Figure 3.10: Incidence rate of Naples overnight stays on Campania Region total overnight stays.

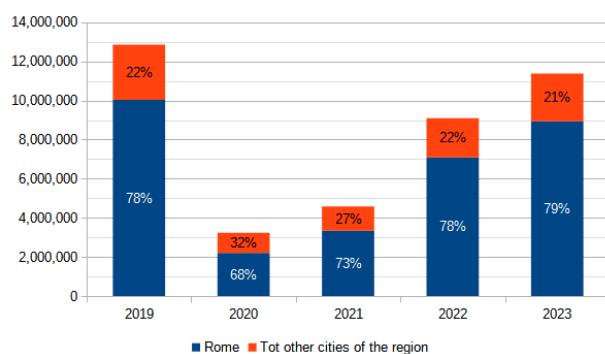


Figure 3.11: Incidence rate of Rome arrivals on Lazio Region total arrivals.

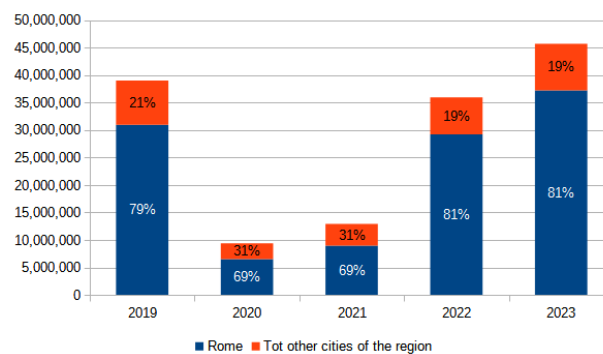


Figure 3.12: Incidence rate of Rome overnight stays on Lazio Region total overnight stays.

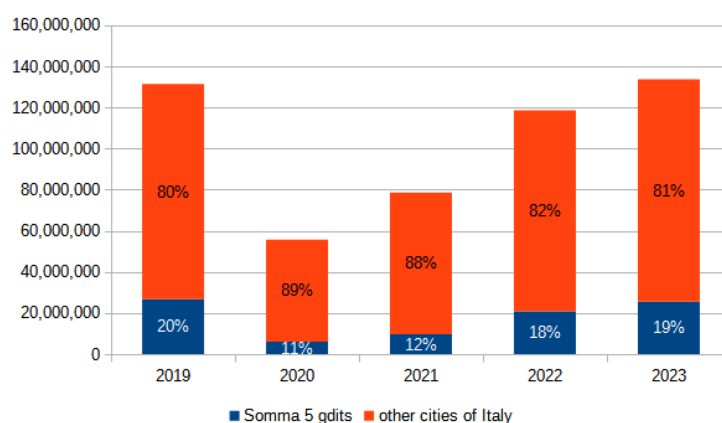


Figure 3.13: Incidence rate of 5 GDITS arrivals on Italy total arrivals.

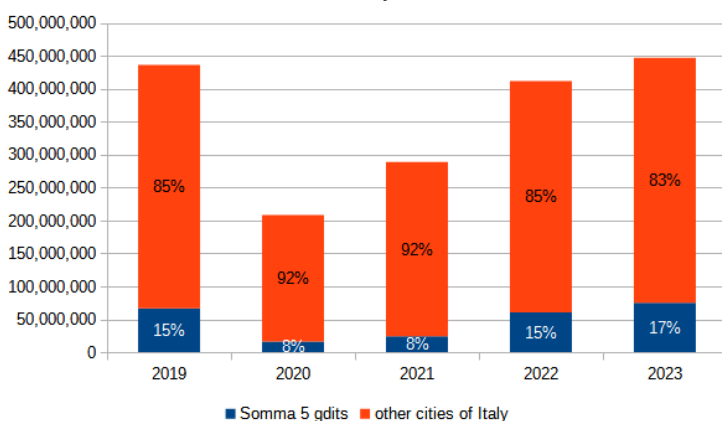


Figure 3.14: Incidence rate of 5 GDITS overnight stays on Italy total overnight stays.

Part II

The offer

The next section presents the **overall structure of the accommodation offer and its dynamics during the 2019-2023 five-year period**. The data refers to facilities that were open for at least one day (as defined by ISTAT¹) within the solar year: *“The facility’s ‘capacity’ refers to its ‘gross capacity’, meaning to facilities open over the course of the year without specifying for how long. The data therefore includes both facilities that are open year-round and seasonal facilities; conversely, facilities that were not open at all are not considered.”*

The overall number of beds in 2023 in **hotel facilities** located in the municipality of Venice is 31,714, decreasing by -2.9% compared to 2022; while the number of beds offered by **other accommodation facilities (including tourist rentals)** is 48,526, growing by +9.3% compared to the previous year.

The number of active hotel accommodation facilities in 2023 is 451, compared to 457 in 2022.

Overall, the city of Venice offers 80,240 beds. This figure does not include the additional beds as referred to in the art. 25 paragraphs 7 and 8 of the Regional Law. 11/2013, except for tourist rentals.

Compared to 2022, in 2023 the number of beds in hotels decreased by -1.3% in the Historic Centre, -6.2% on the mainland and -1.7% on the Lido. In 2023 the number of beds offered by other accommodation facilities increased by 11.4% in the Historic Centre, and decreased by -0.1% in the mainland and -2.8% on the Lido, compared to 2022.

At the city level, the supply of beds in other accommodation facilities represents 60% of the total where the historic center accounts for 84% of the total number of other accommodation facilities beds and 63% of the total number of hotel beds.

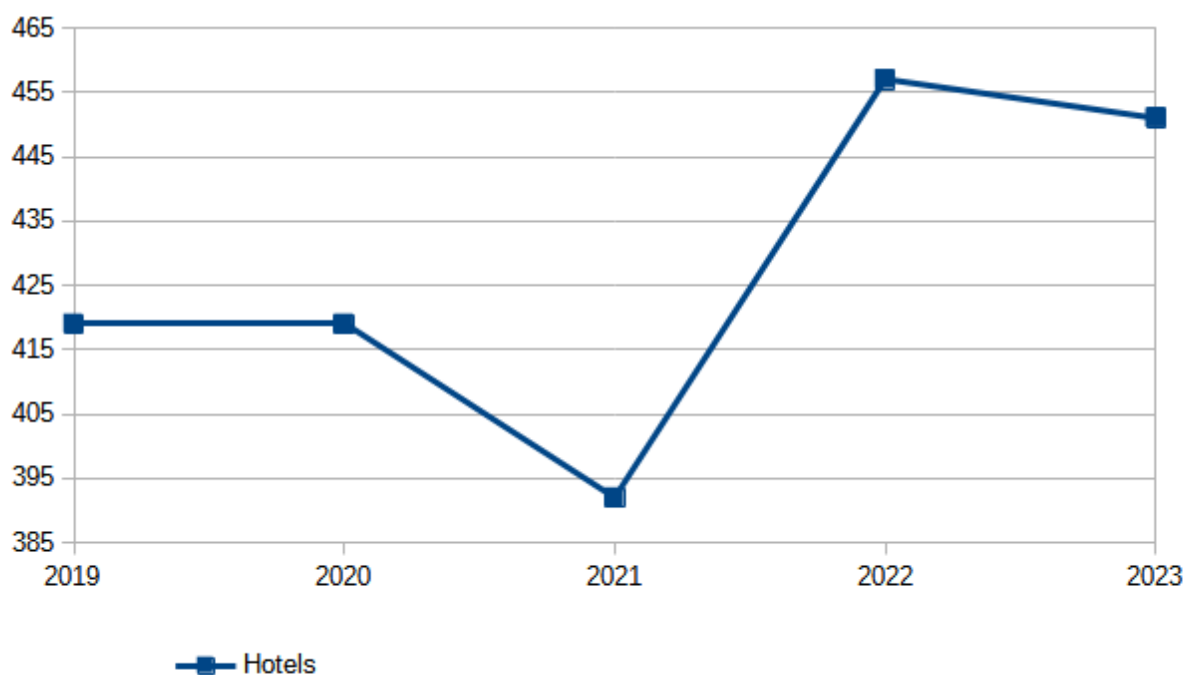


Figure 4.1: Hotel number.

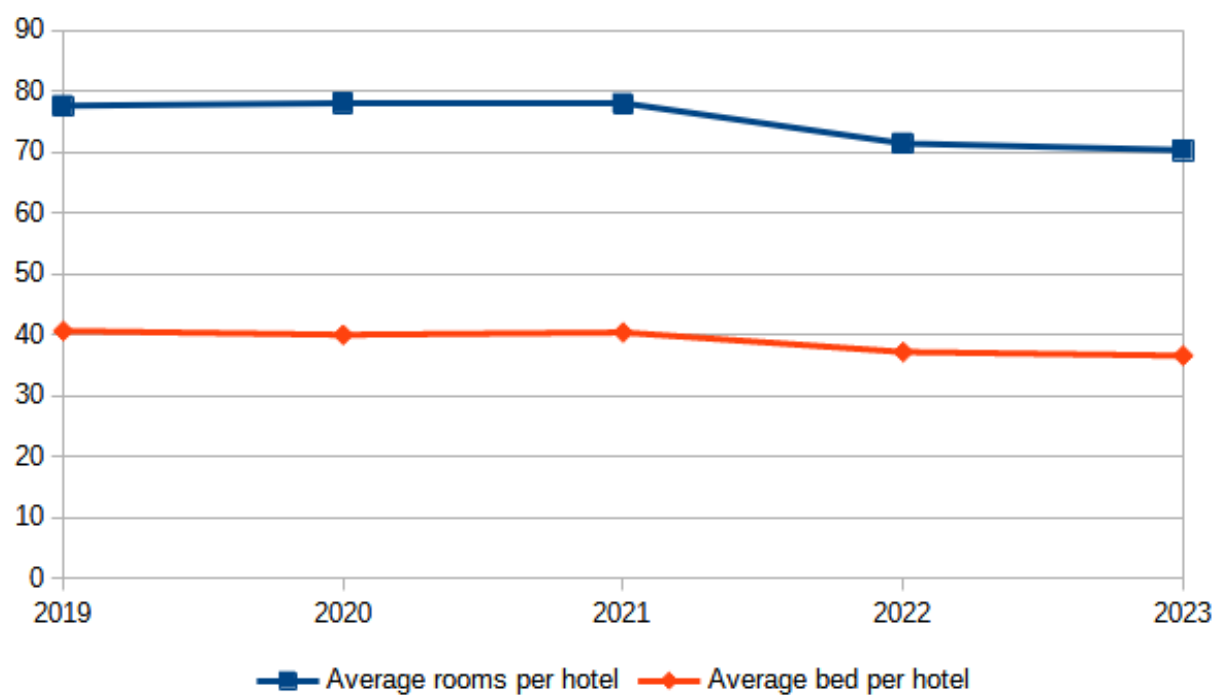


Figure 4.2: Hotels: average rooms and average beds.

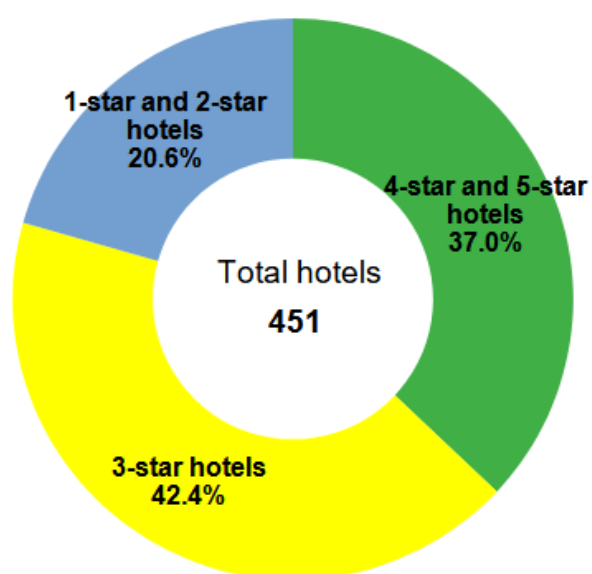


Figure 4.3: Hotel offer composition on hotel total

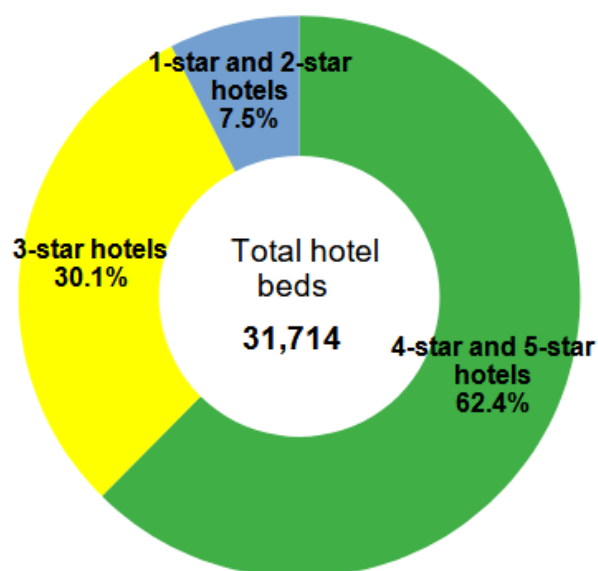


Figure 4.4: Hotel offer composition on the total number of hotel beds.

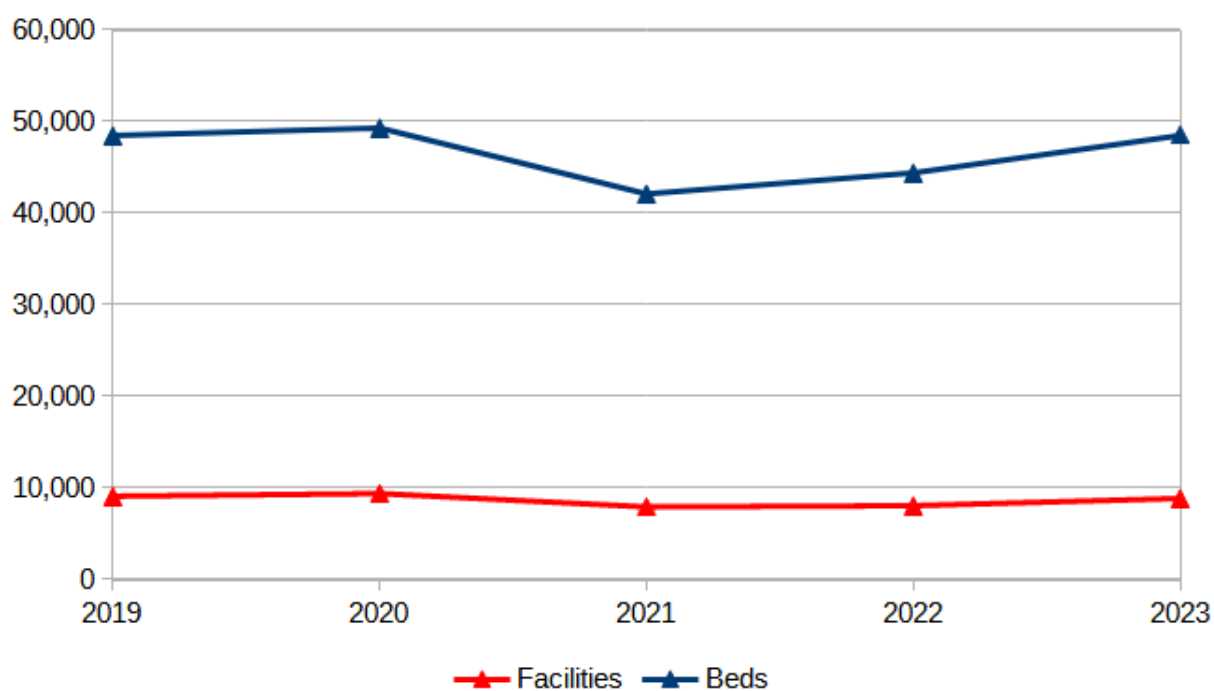


Figure 4.5: Other accommodation: facilities and number of beds.

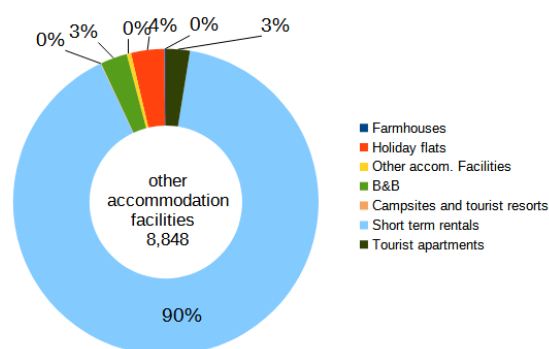


Figure 4.6: Composition of the offer on the total.

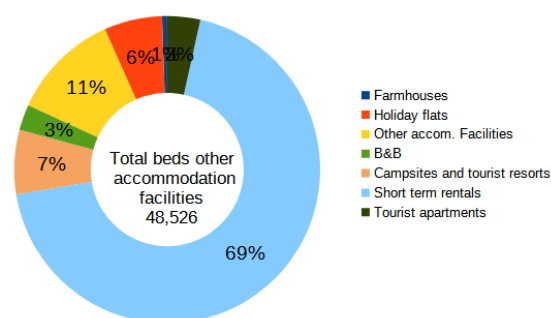


Figure 4.7: Composition of bed offer on the total

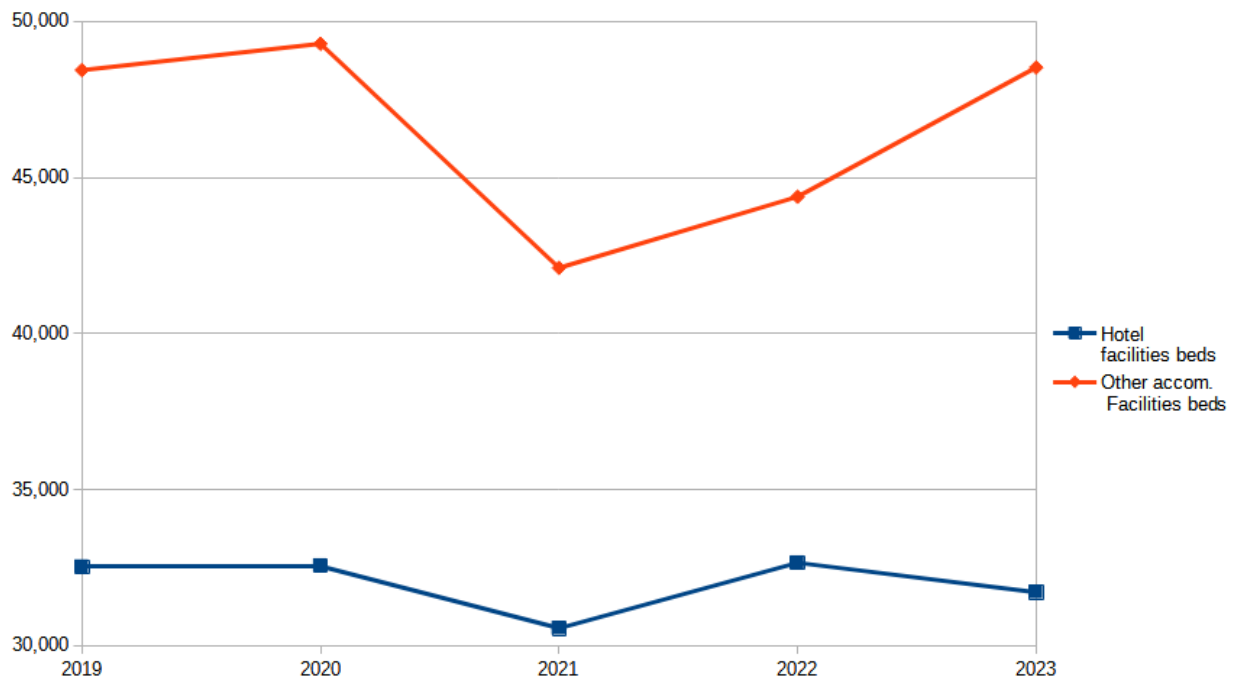


Figure 4.8: Number of beds by facility type.

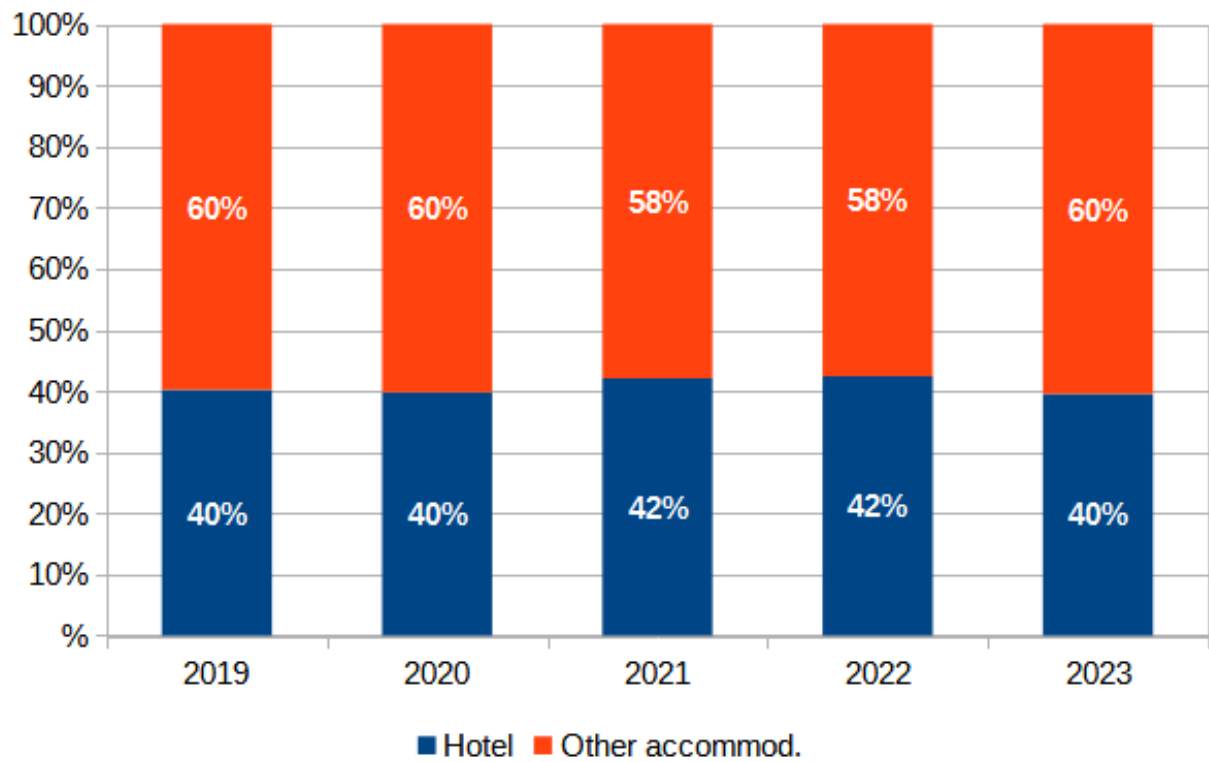


Figure 4.9: Number of bed composition by facility.

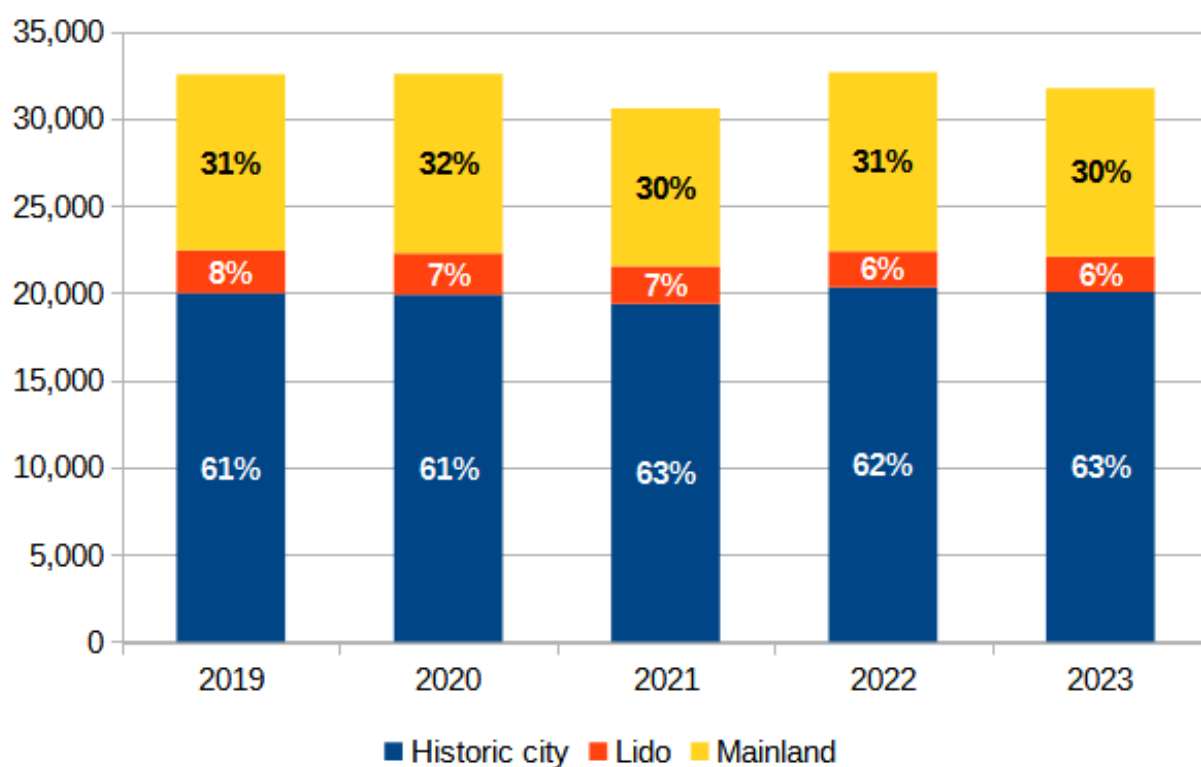


Figure 4.10: Hotel facilities: number of bed composition divided by the three areas.

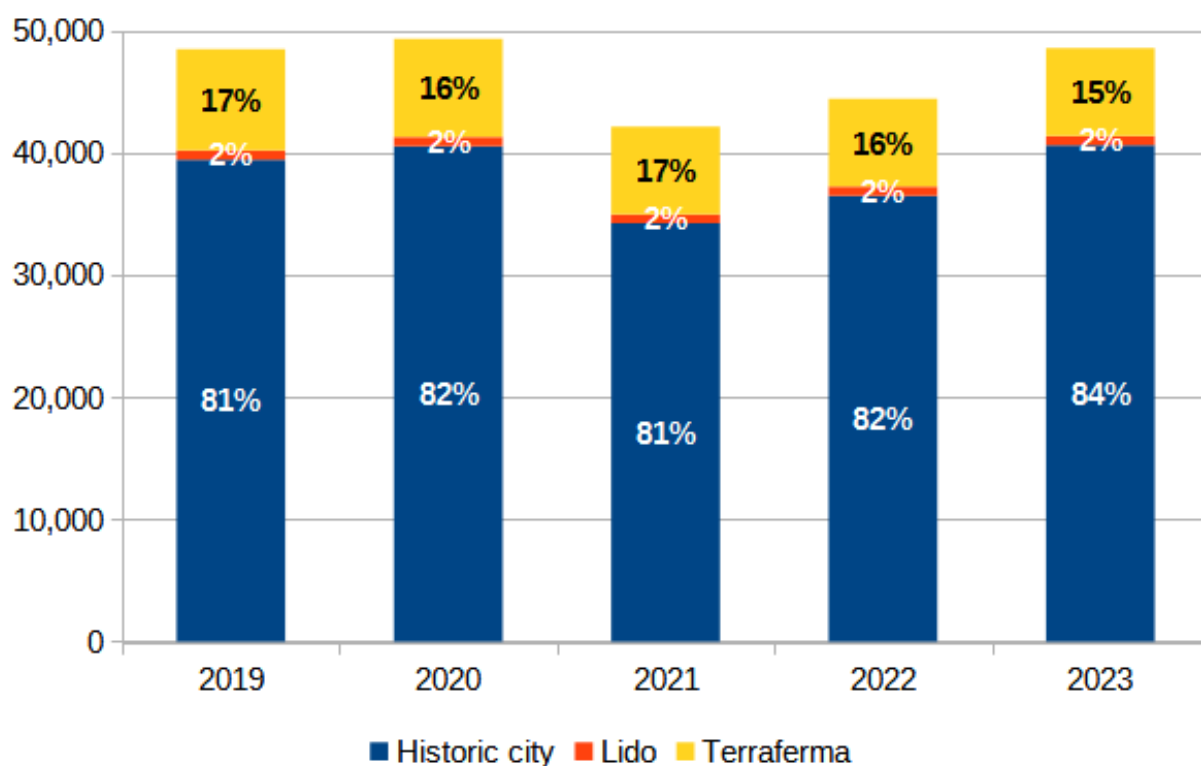


Figure 4.11: Other accommodation facilities: number of bed composition divided by the three areas.

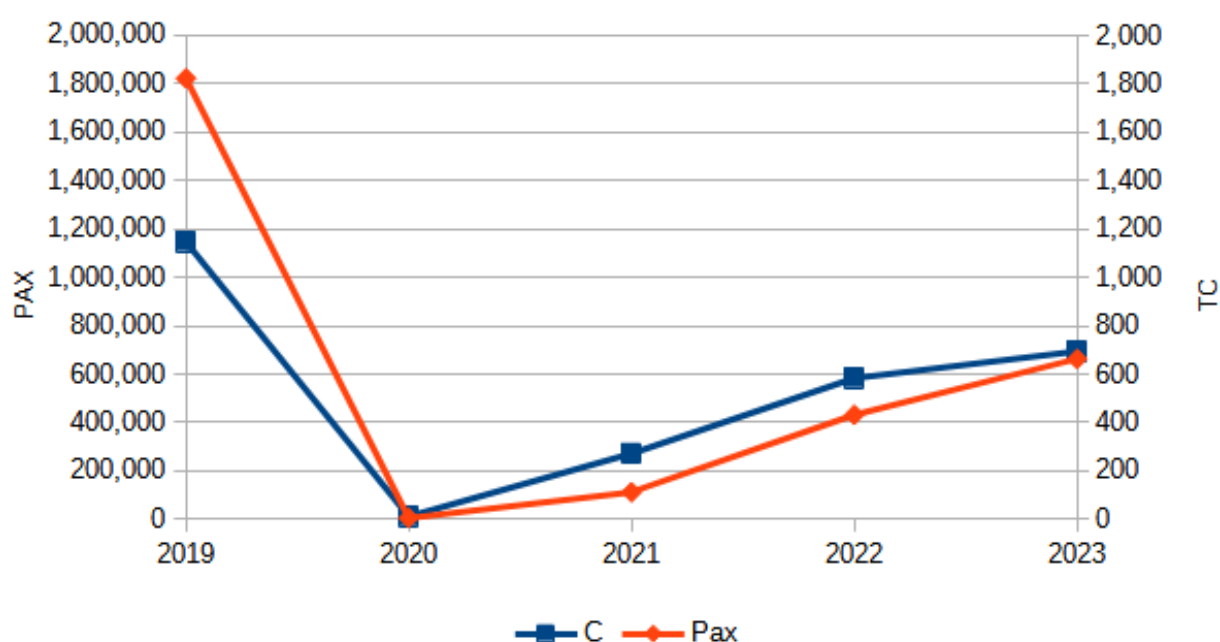


Figure 5.1: Passengers and calls number.

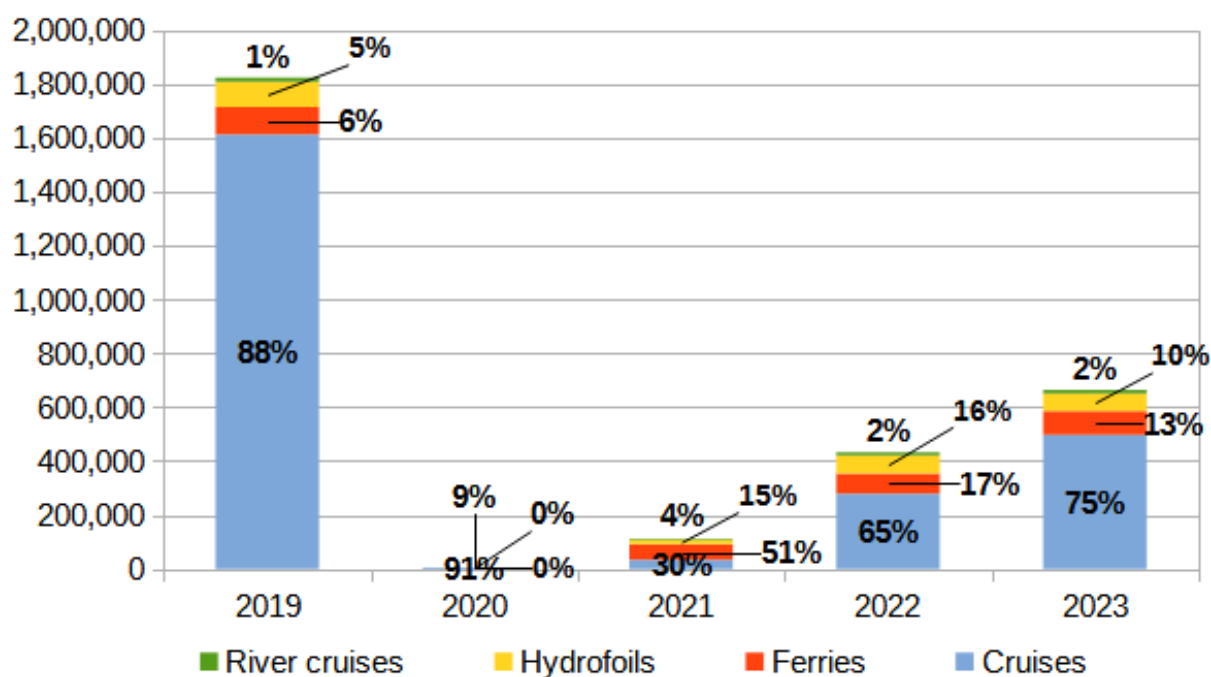


Figure 5.2: Passenger composition by year

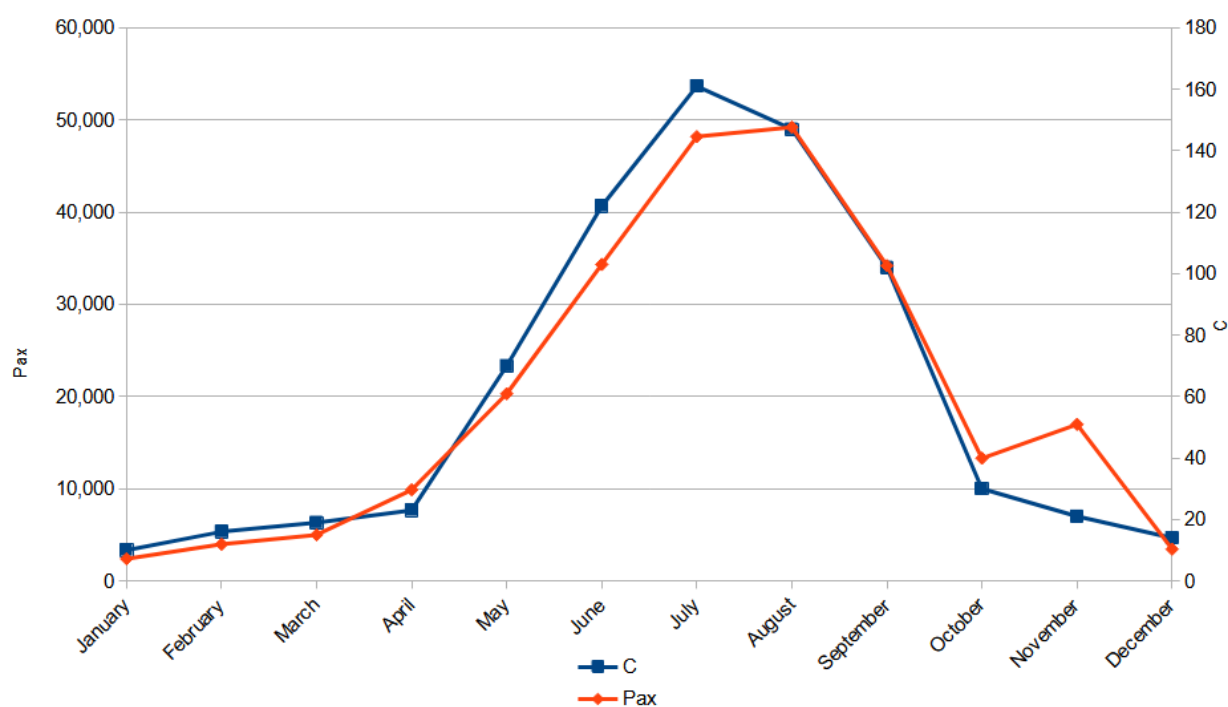


Figure 5.3: Passengers and calls number per month.

Figure 6.1: Passengers by origin.

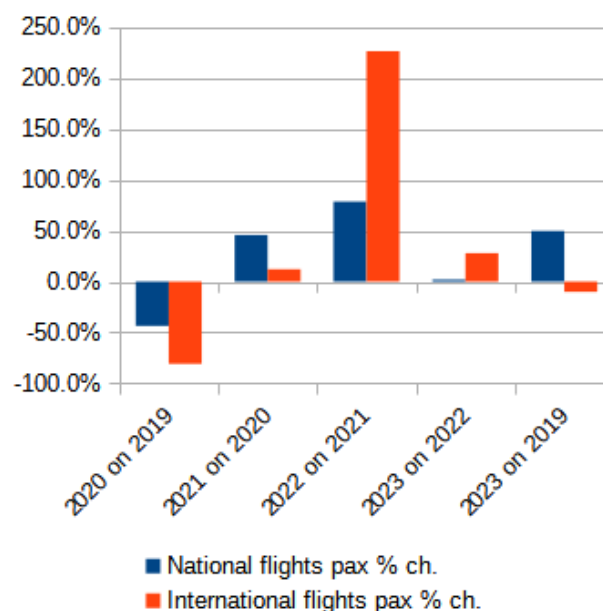


Figure 6.2: Passengers % change.

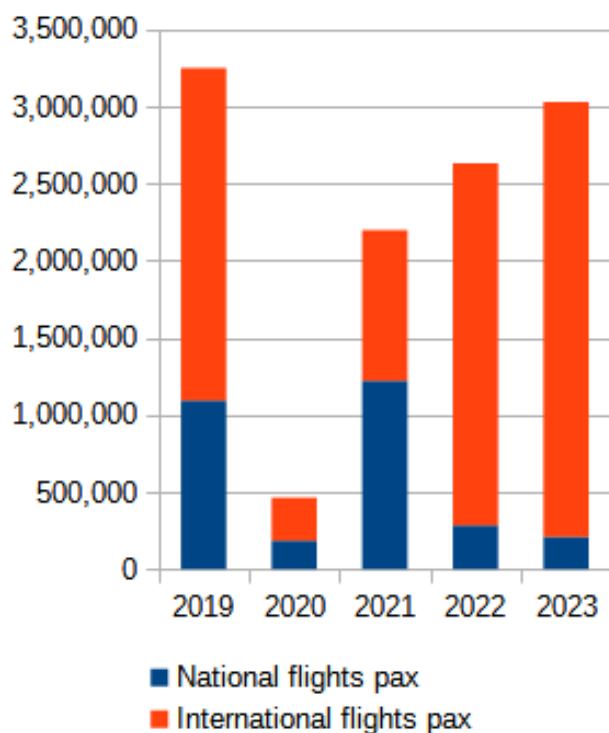


Figure 6.3: Passengers by origin

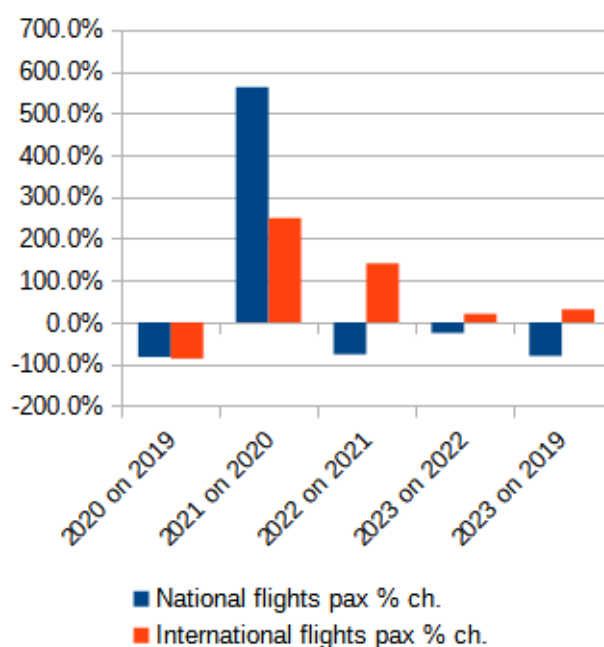


Figure 6.4: Passengers % change

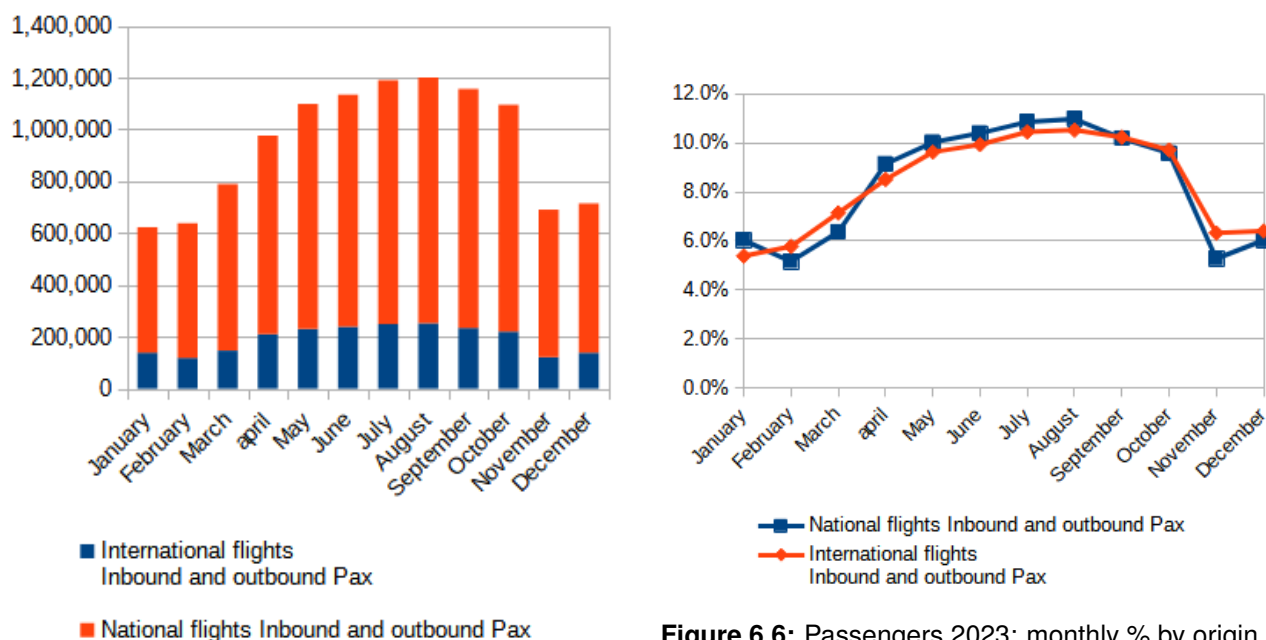


Figure 6.6: Passengers 2023: monthly % by origin.

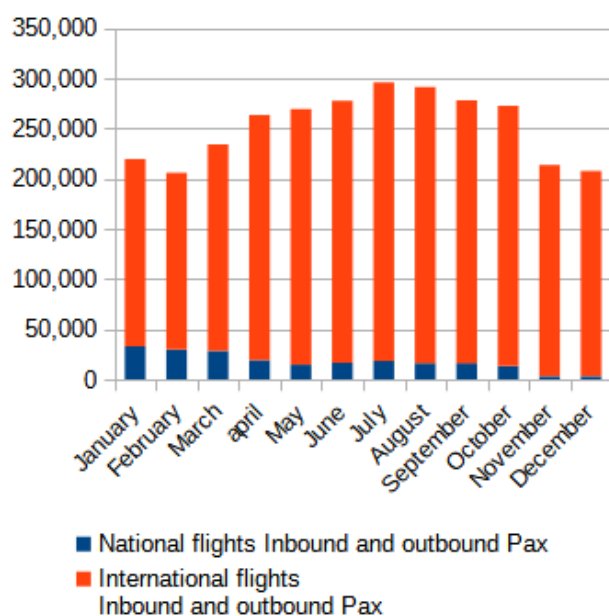


Figure 6.7: Passengers 2023: monthly by origin.

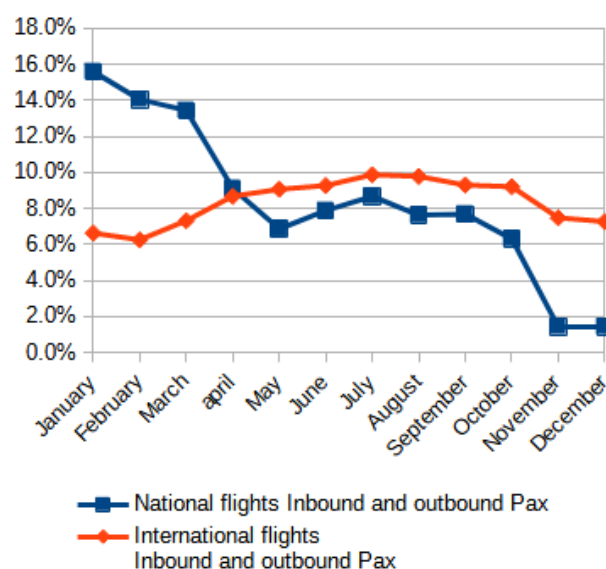


Figure 6.8: Passengers 2023: monthly % by origin.

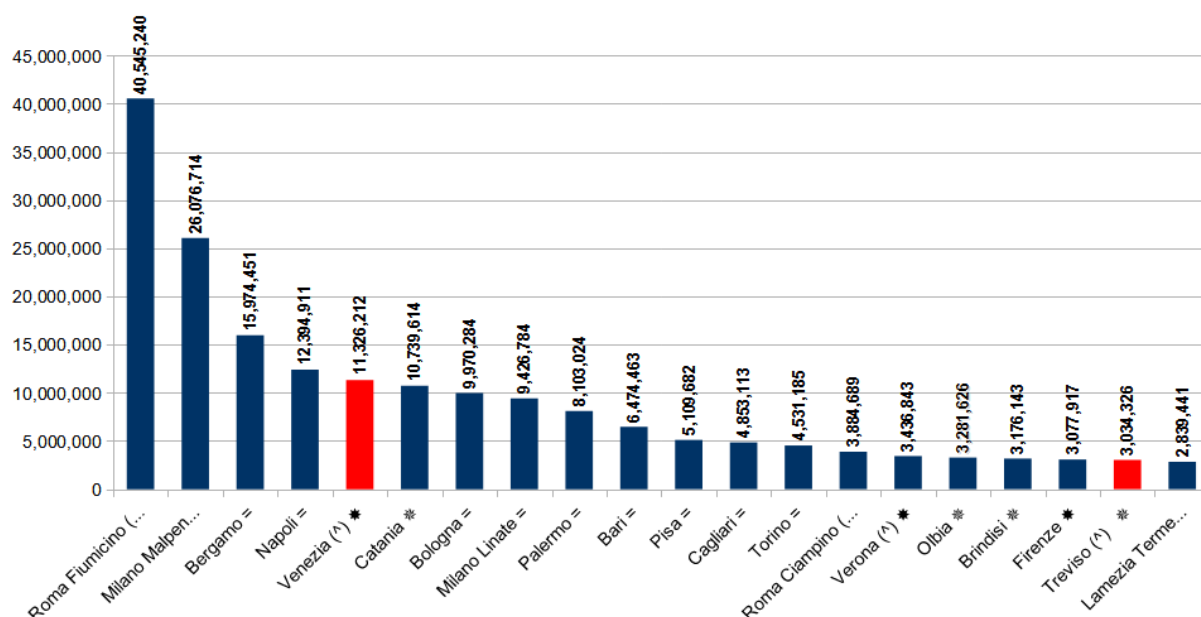


Figure 6.9: Main Italian airports - Total 2023 passengers.

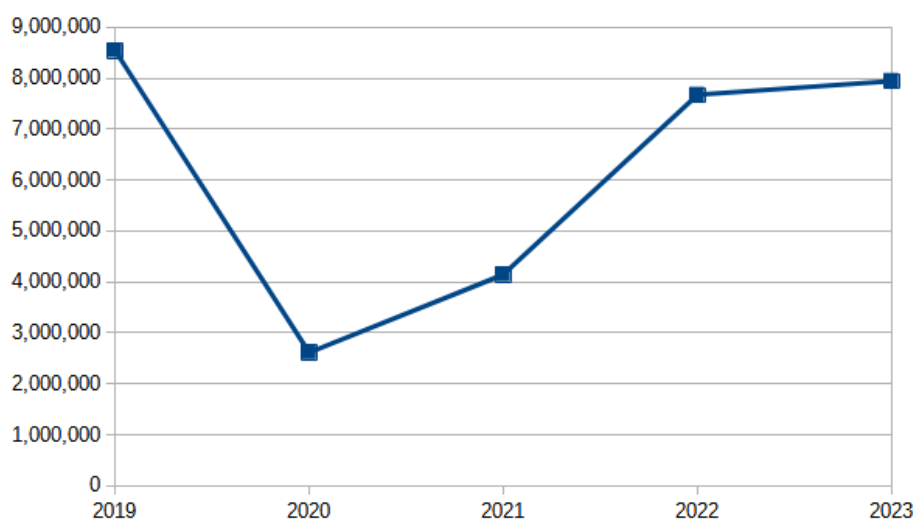


Figure 7.1: AVM/ACTV: Total sales of the main travel documents.

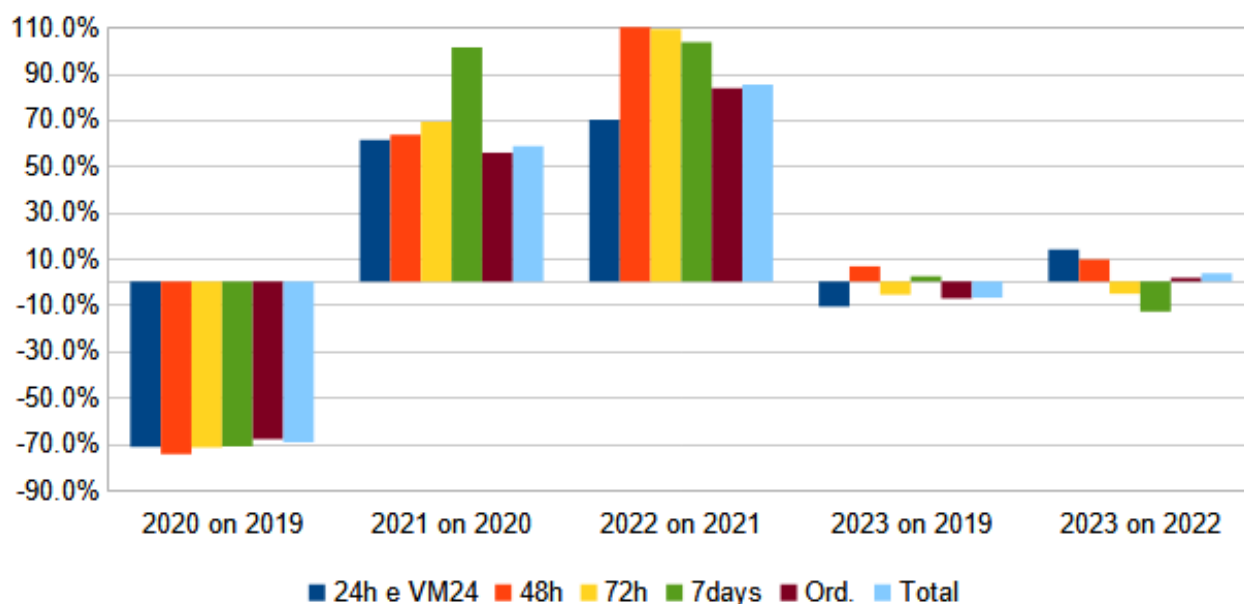


Figure 7.2: AVM/ACTV: % change of sales of the main travel documents.

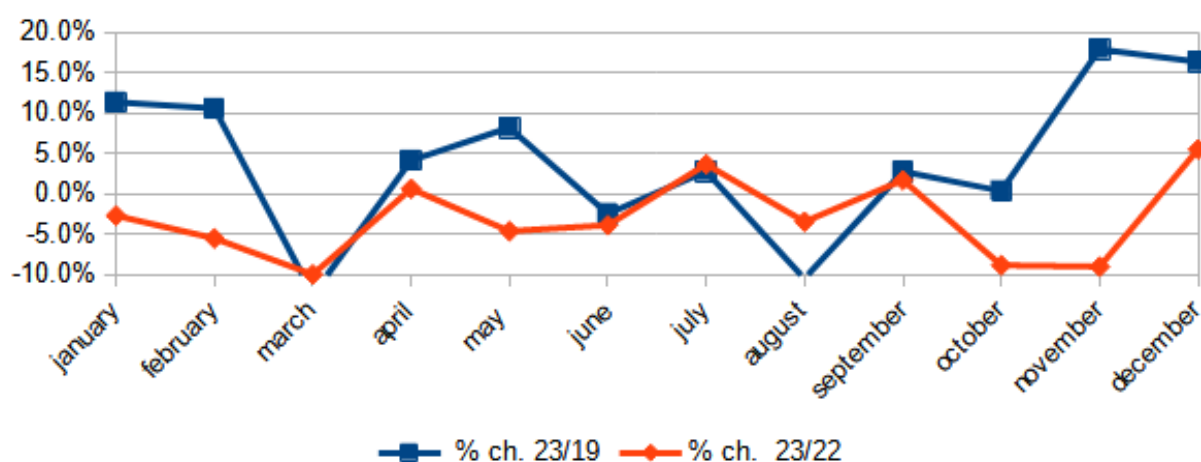


Figure 9.1: Transits monthly variation.

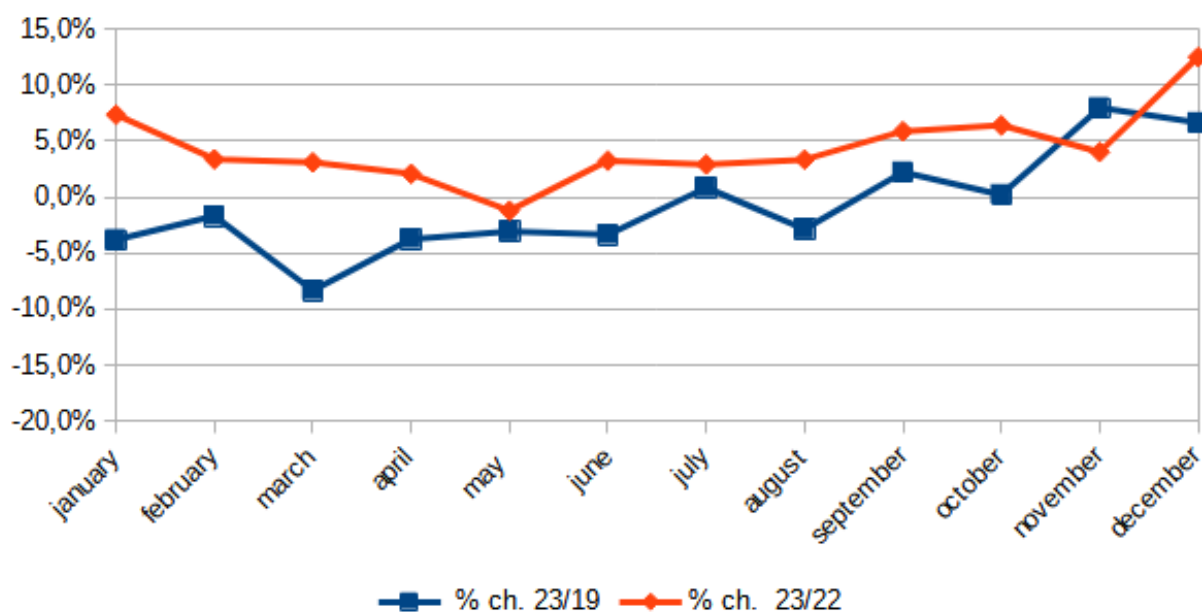


Figure 9.2: Transits monthly variation.

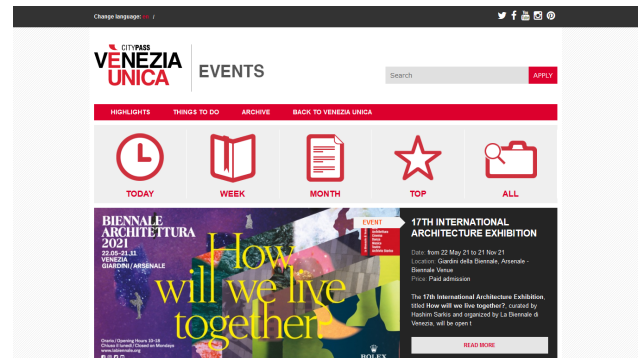


Figure 10.2: Figures of Events Venezia Unica:

1,040,095 page views +3.5% ↑

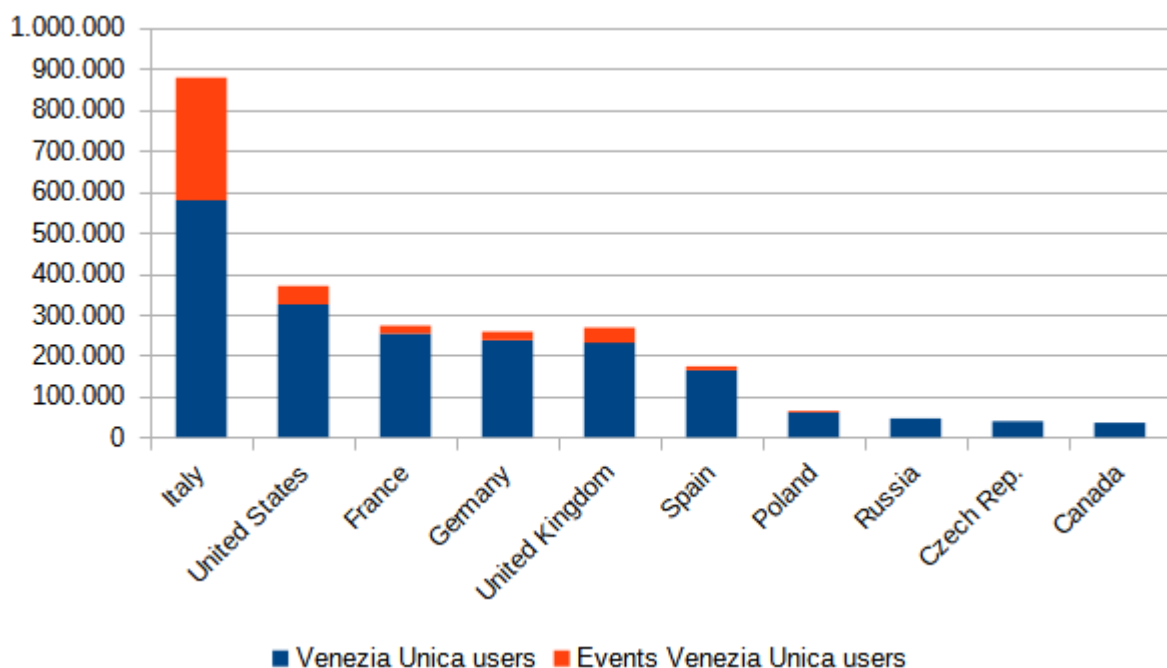


Figure 10.3: Venezia Unica ed Events visitors composition by origin.

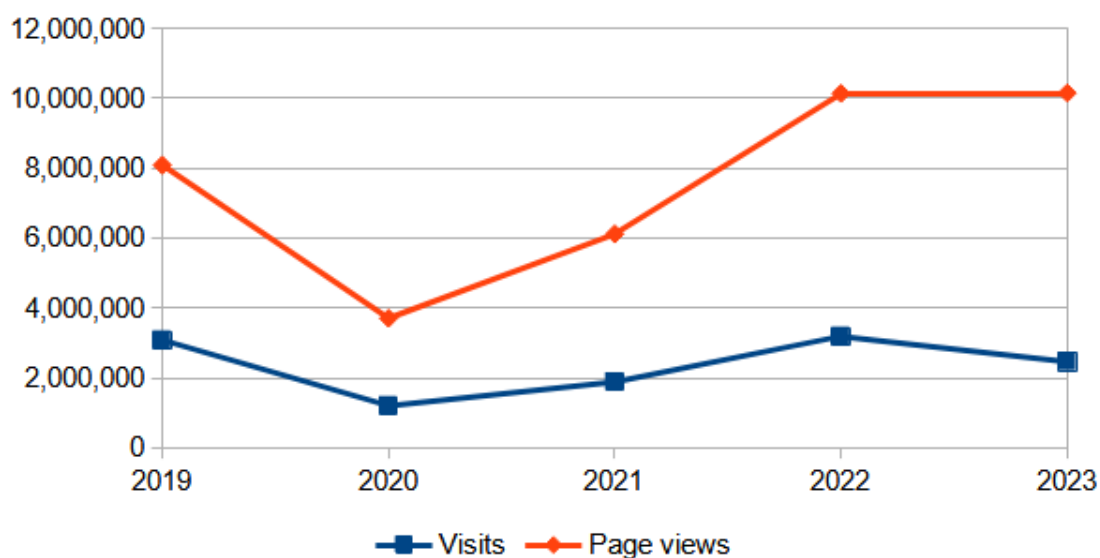


Figure 10.4: Number of visits and of page views.

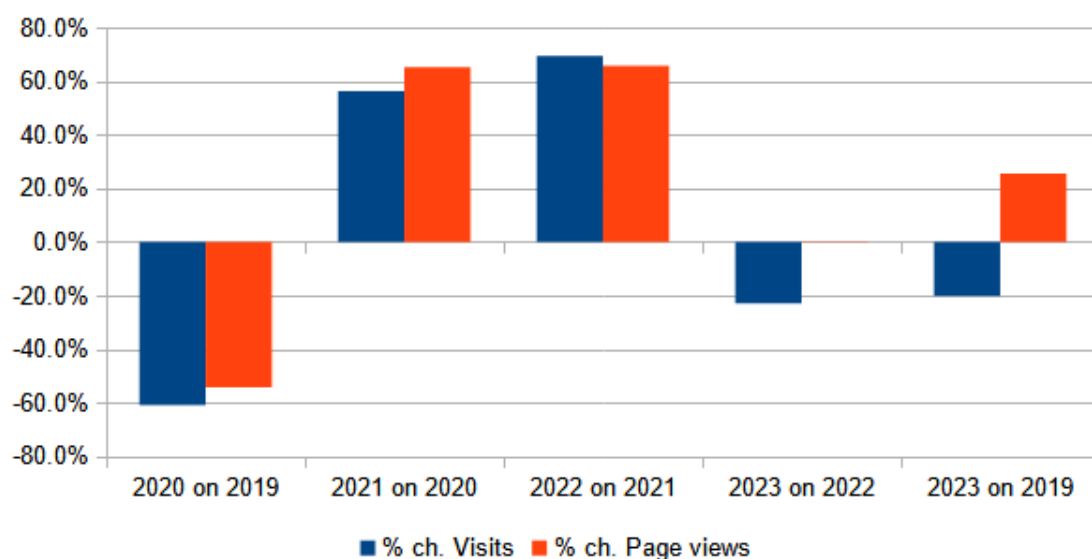


Figure 10.5: Comparison of % variation of visits and page views.

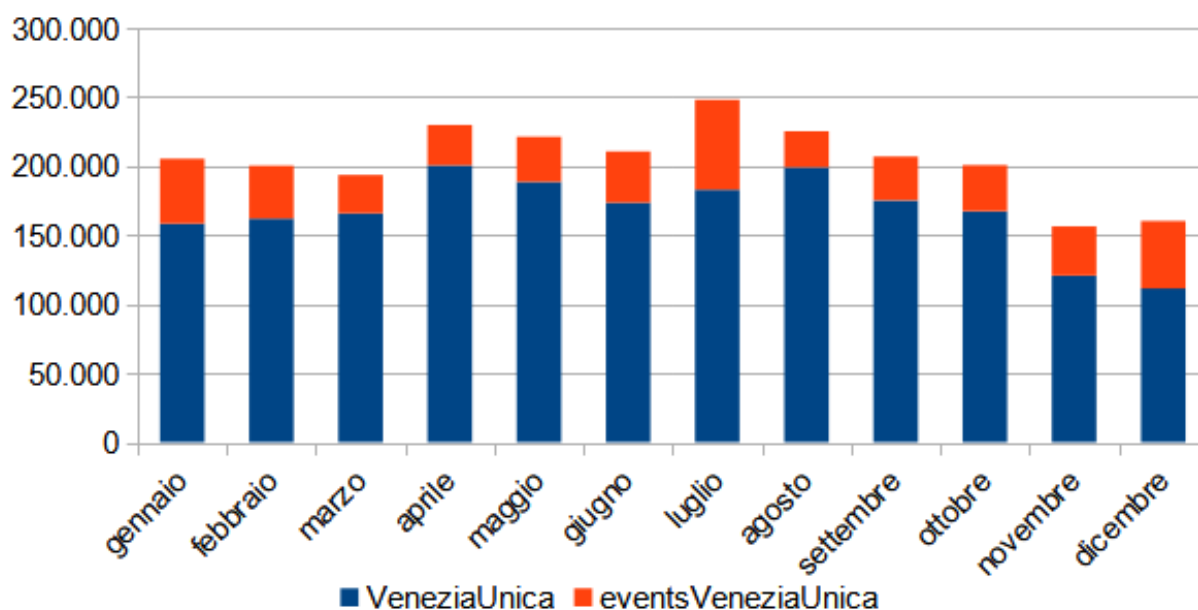


Figure 10.6: Monthly view number.

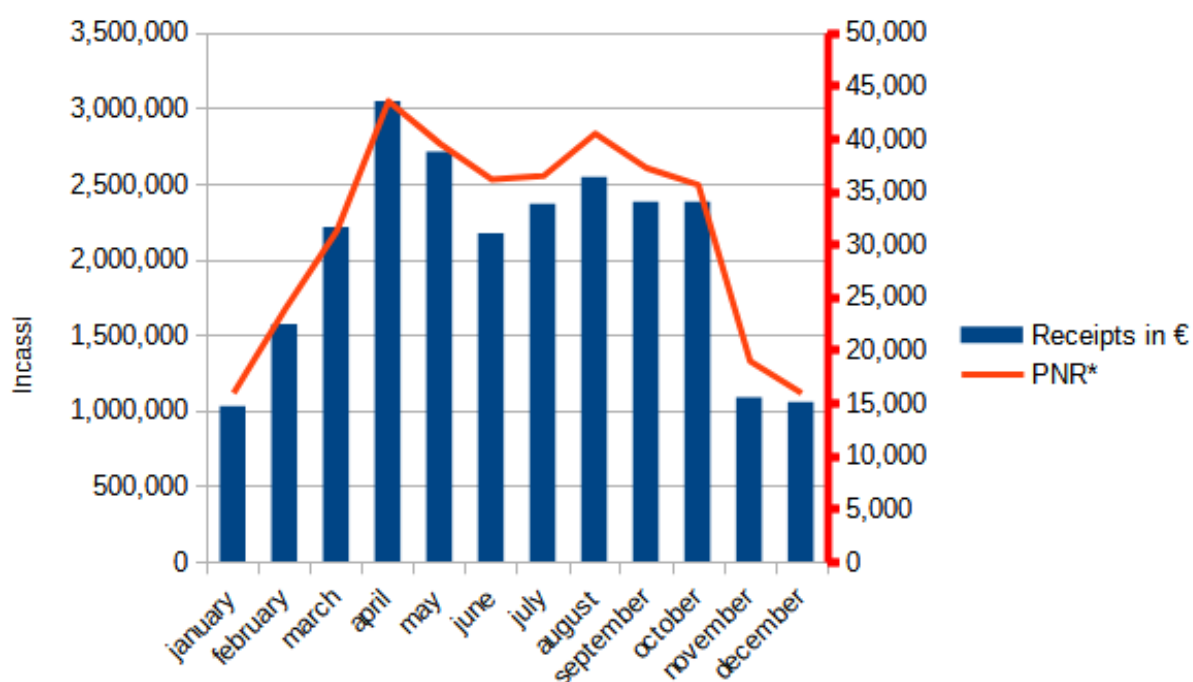


Figure 10.7: Monthly receipts and PNR.

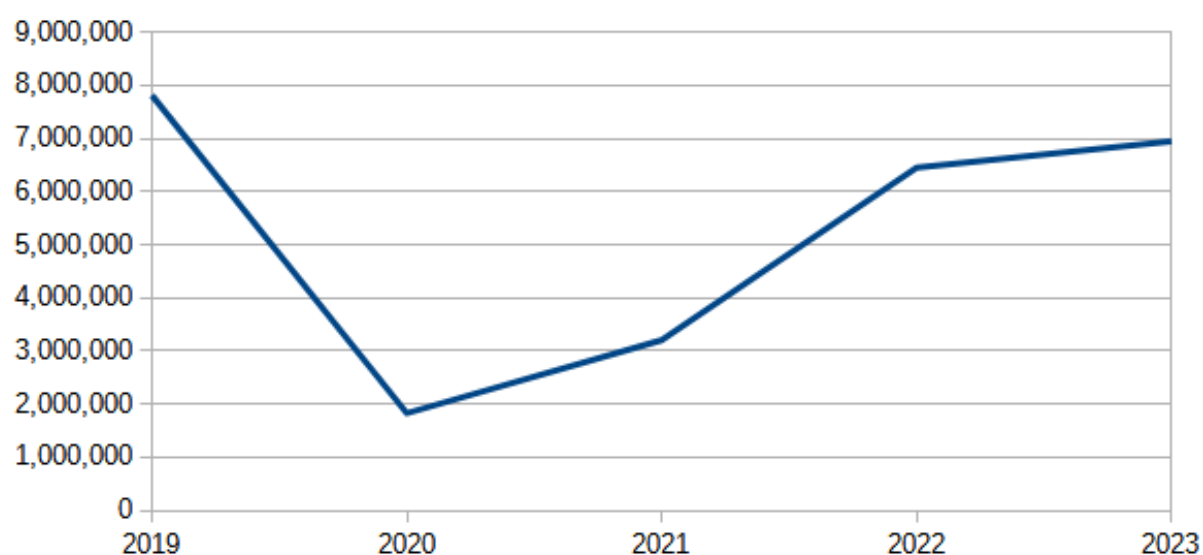


Figure 11.1: Total visitors of Venetian Museums and cultural Institutions.

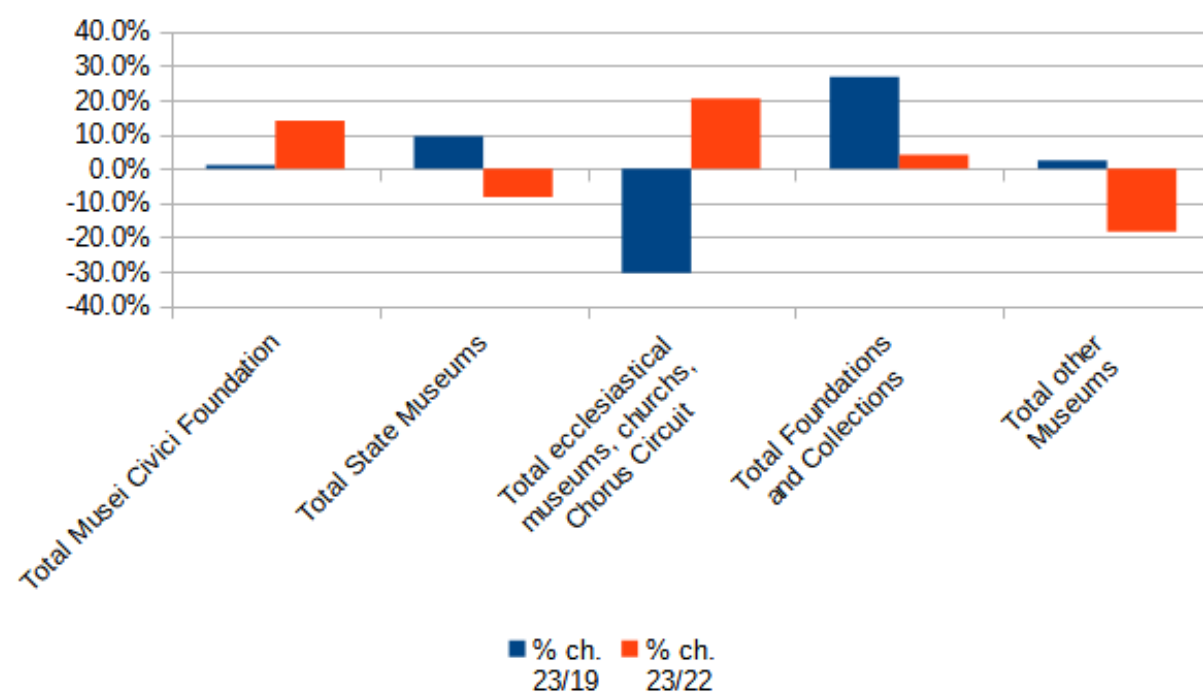


Figure 11.2: Visitors percentage change - see notes on page 129 for more details.

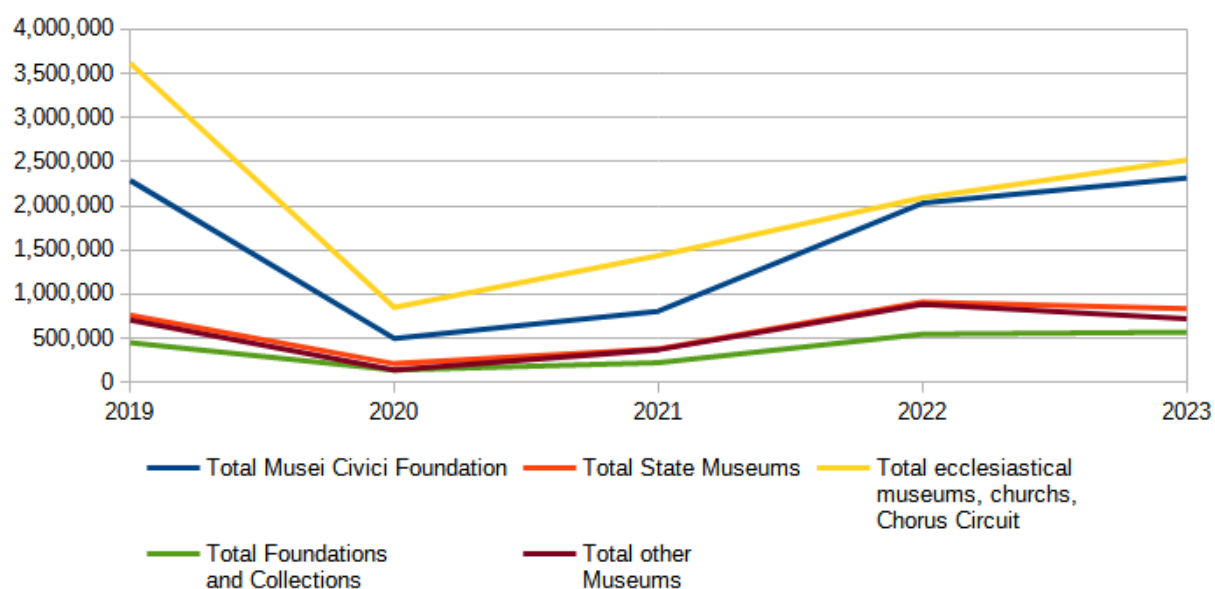


Figure 11.3: Visitors to the Venetian museums and the cultural institutions per year - see notes on page 129 for more details.

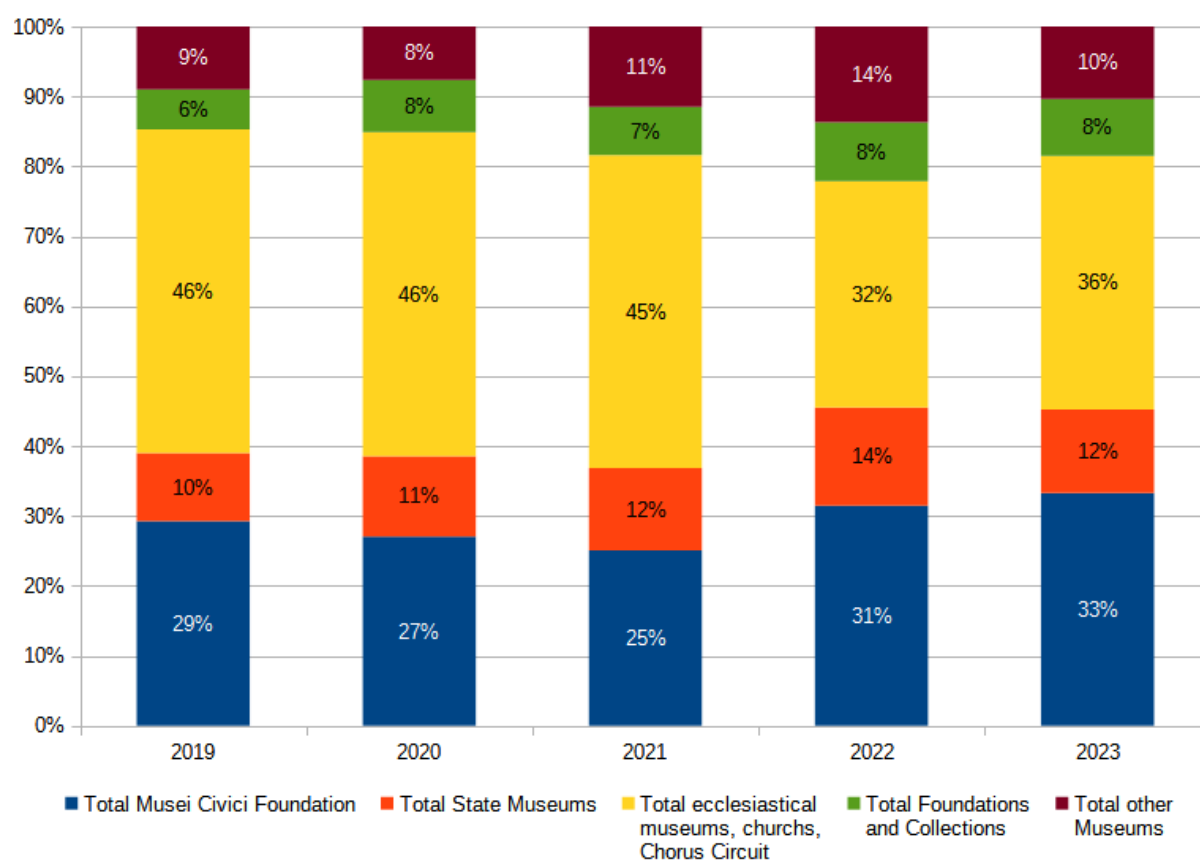


Figure 11.4: Visitors to the Venetian museums and the cultural institutions per year: composition - see notes on page 129 for more details.

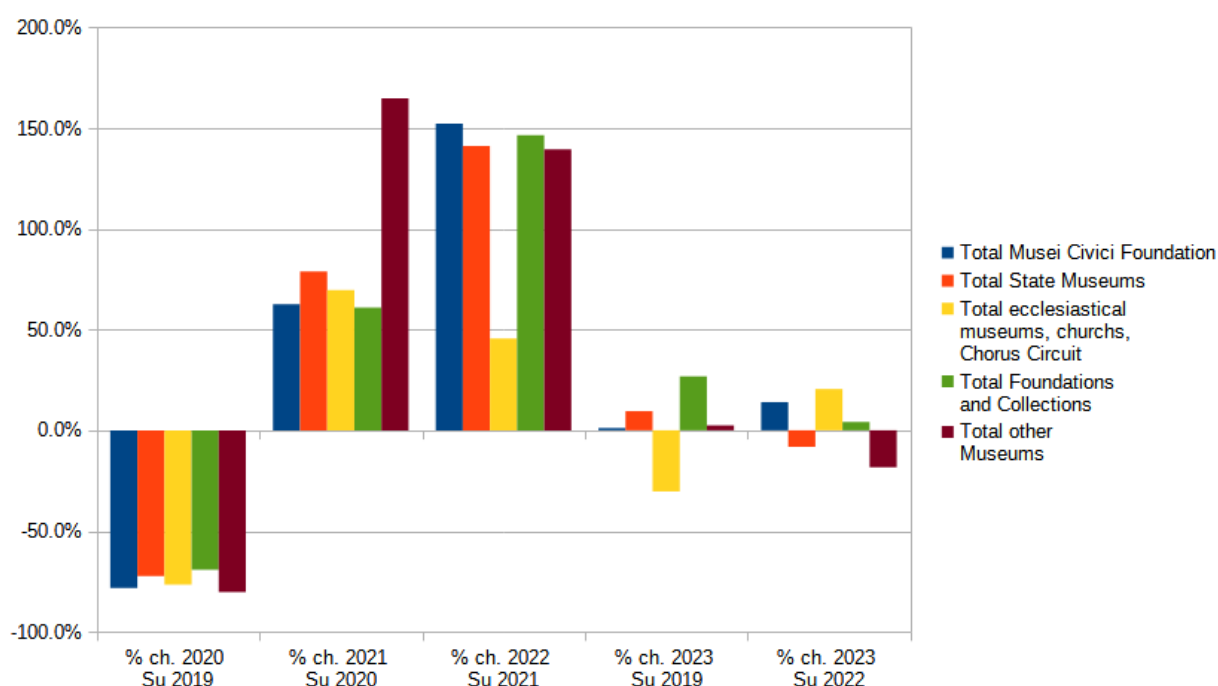


Figure 11.5: Visitors percentage change on previous year.

2019: The exceptional high tide of 11/12/2019 led to the prolonged closure of Palazzo Fortuny and Ca' Pesaro, which also continued in 2020.

2020: The Prime Minister's Decree ordered an extraordinary closure from February 24th to March 1st 2020 and from March 8th to June 13th 2020 in order to prevent Coronavirus 2019-nCoV spreading. From June 22nd to November 4th 2020 it was possible to book entrances to the closed museums (Doge's Palace, Glass Museum, Ca' Rezzonico, Goldoni's house, Mocenigo Palace and Natural History Museum) with tourist guides only. Furthermore, all the museums were closed under the Prime Minister's Decree of November 04th 2020.

2021: due to Prime Minister's Decrees of November 3rd 2020 and January 15th 2021, all the seats of Fondazione Musei Civici were closed for extended periods. Doge's Palace and Correr Museum were occasionally open during Carnival and on two days in March. From April 26th a new opening calendar was arranged.

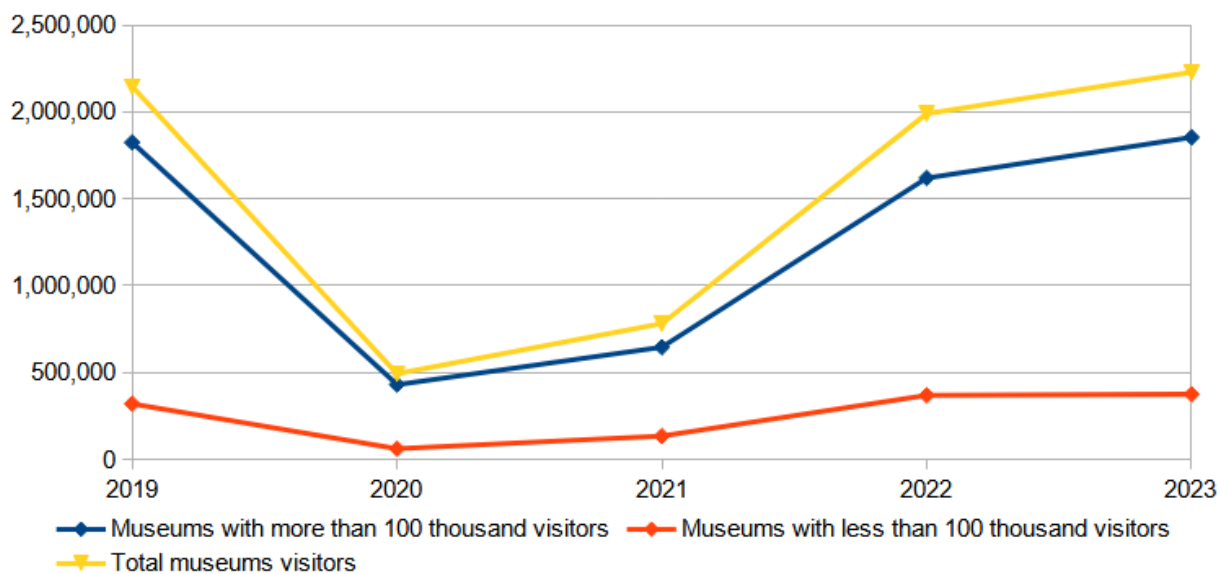


Figure 11.6: Total visitors to the museums of Fondazione Musei Civici

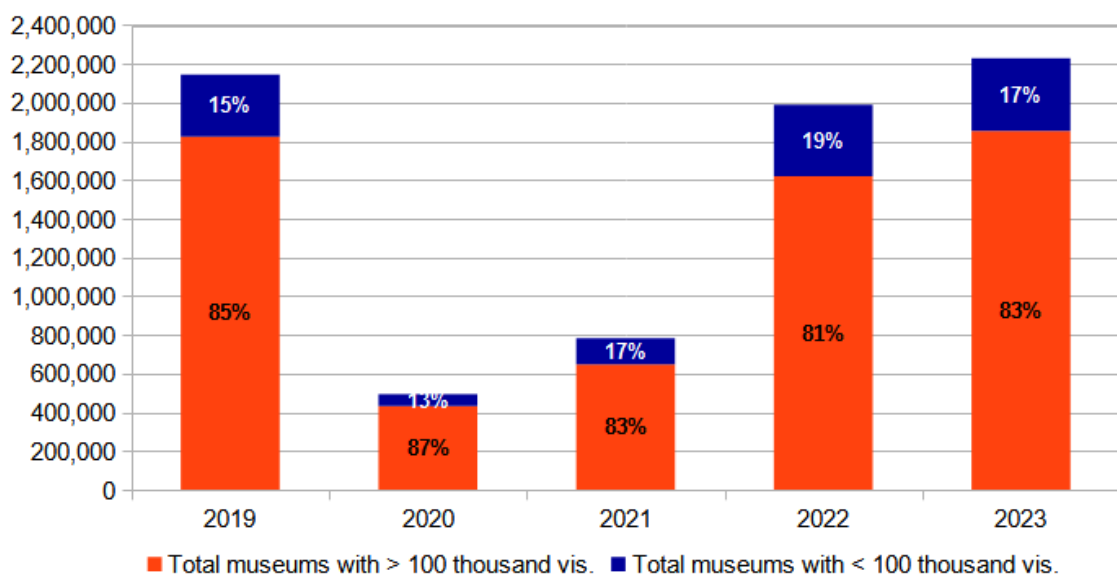


Figure 11.7: Total visitors to the museums of Fondazione Musei Civici: composition.

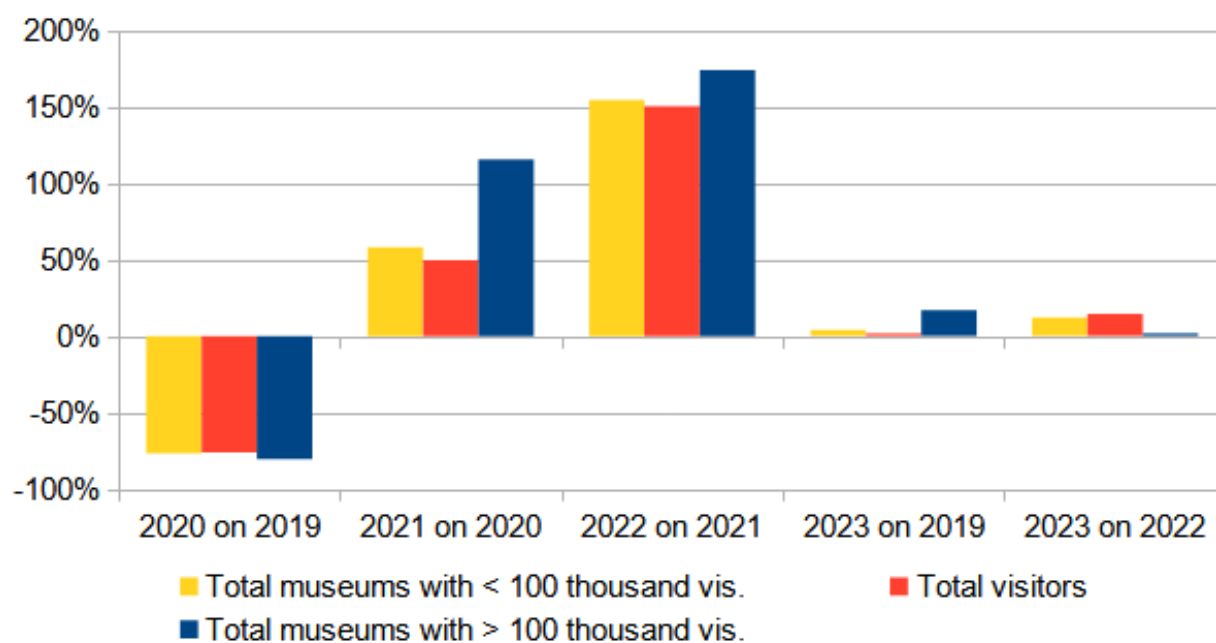


Figure 11.8: Visitors percentage change on previous year (excluding exhibitions).

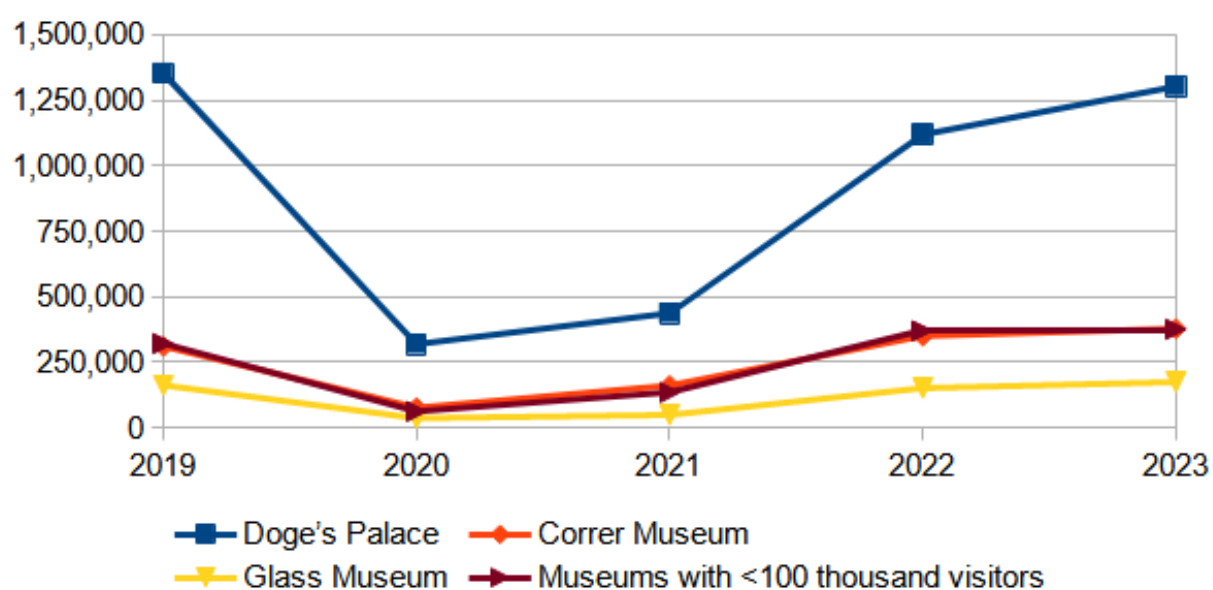


Figure 11.9: Visitors: total per year. Museums with more than 100 thousand visitors.

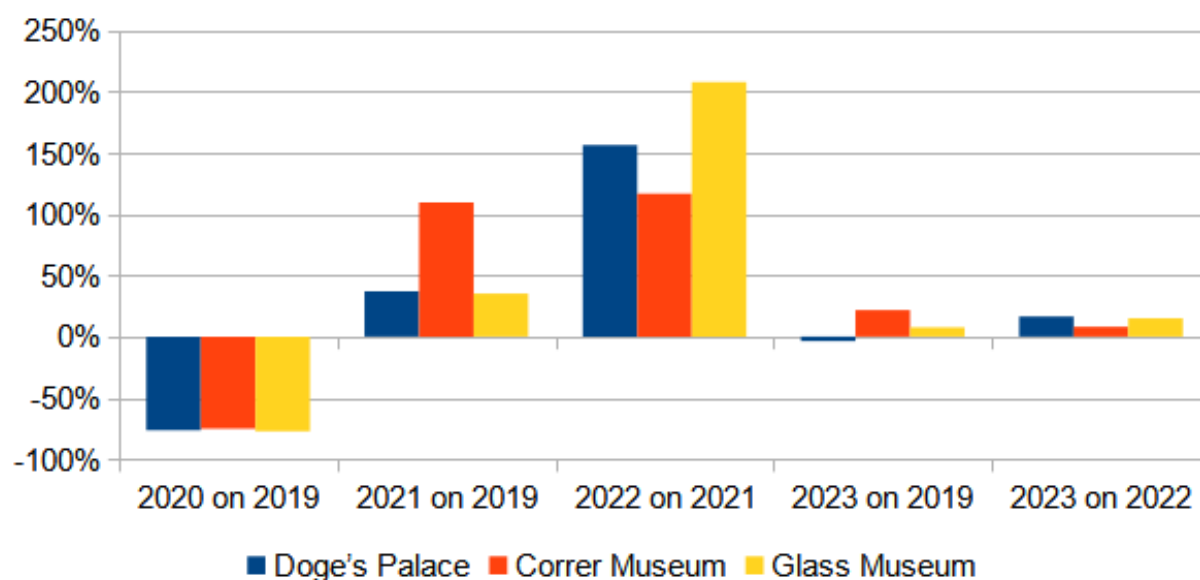


Figure 11.10: Visitors percentage change on previous year (excluding exhibitions).

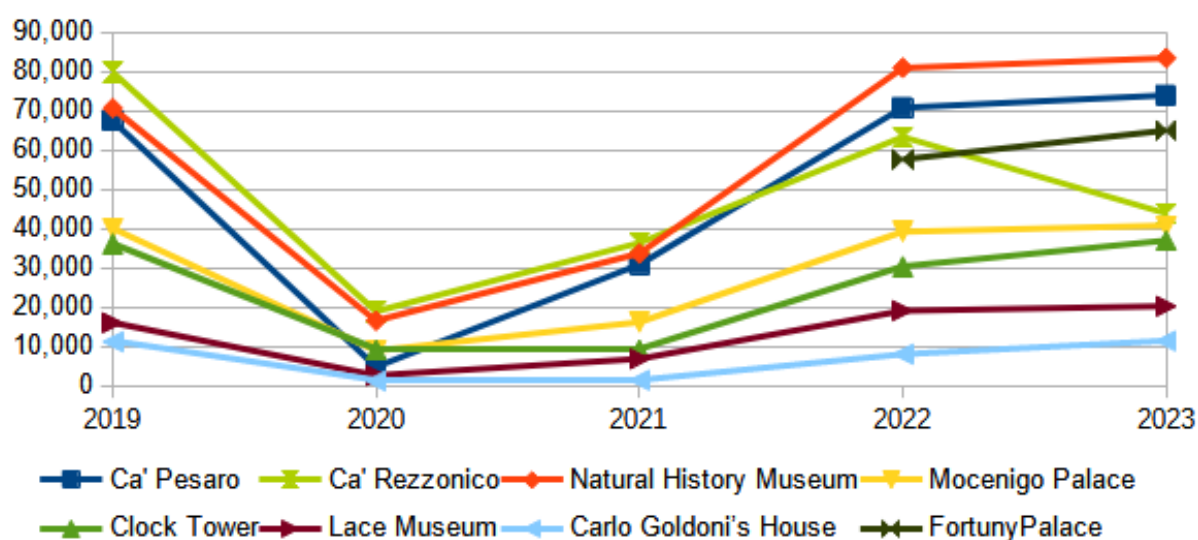


Figure 11.11: Visitors: total per year. Museums with less than 100 thousand visitors.

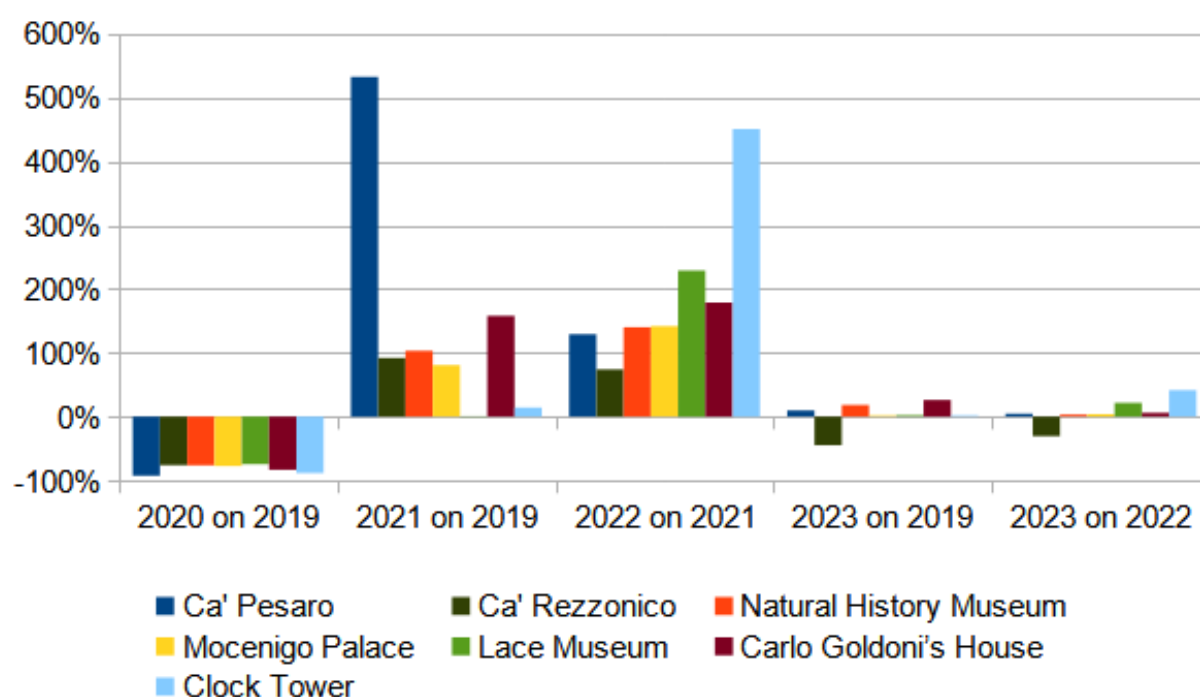


Figure 11.12: Visitors percentage change on previous year (excluding exhibitions).

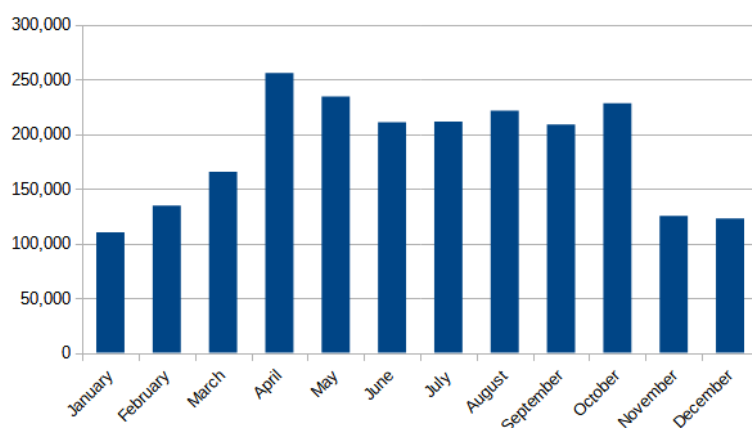


Figure 11.13: 2023: Monthly visitors number

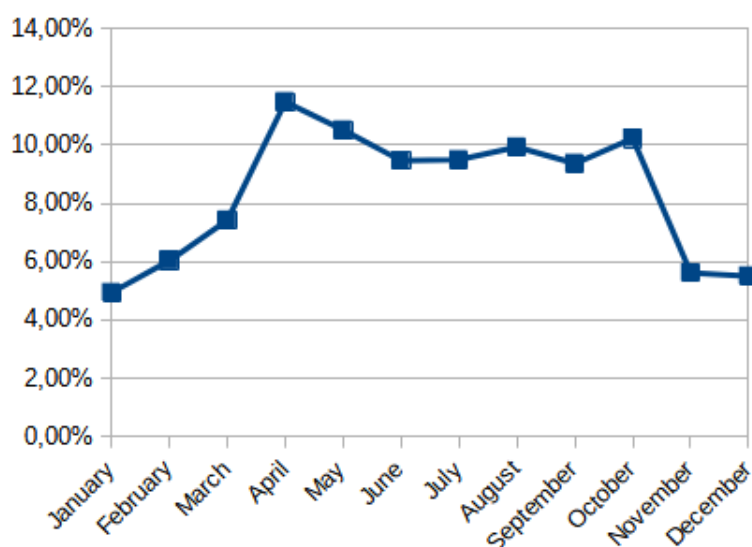


Figure 11.14: Total visitors (monthly % of the total annual).

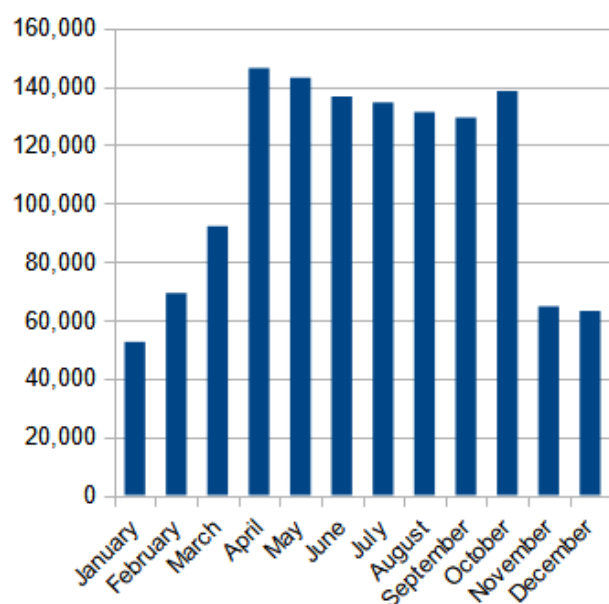


Figure 11.15: 2023 total visitors.

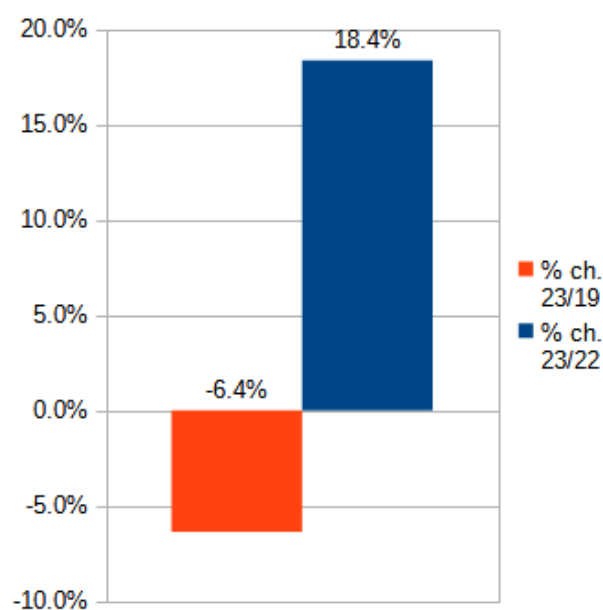


Figure 11.16: Visitors % change 2023/2019 and 2023/2022.

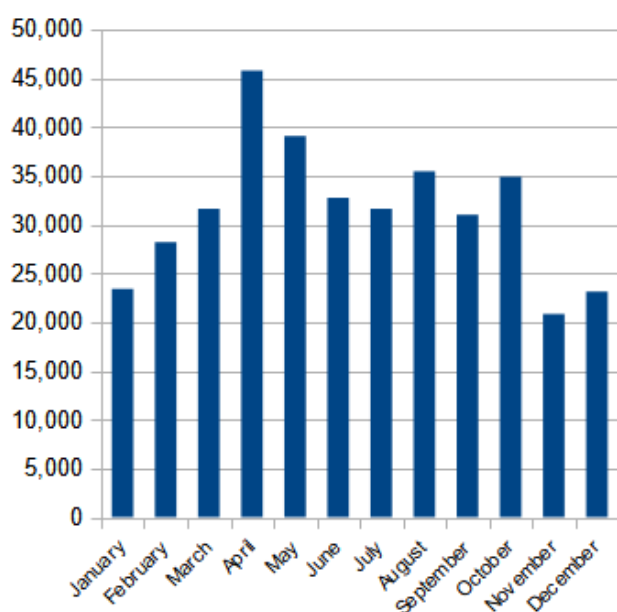


Figure 11.17: 2023 total visitors.

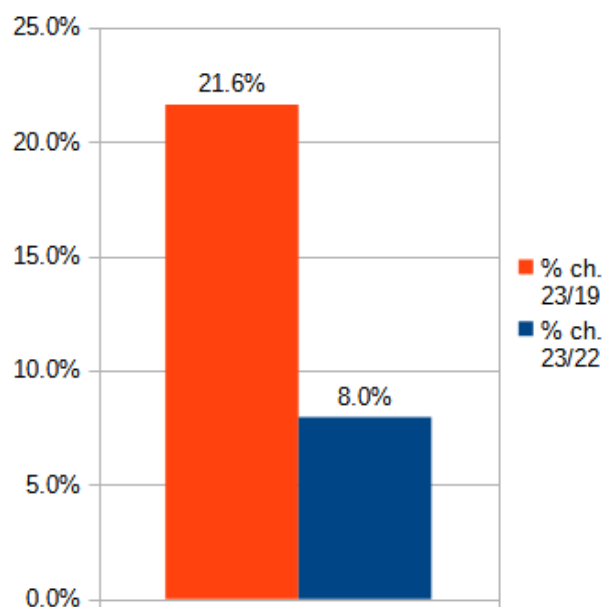


Figure 11.18: Visitors % change 2023/2019 and 2023/2022.

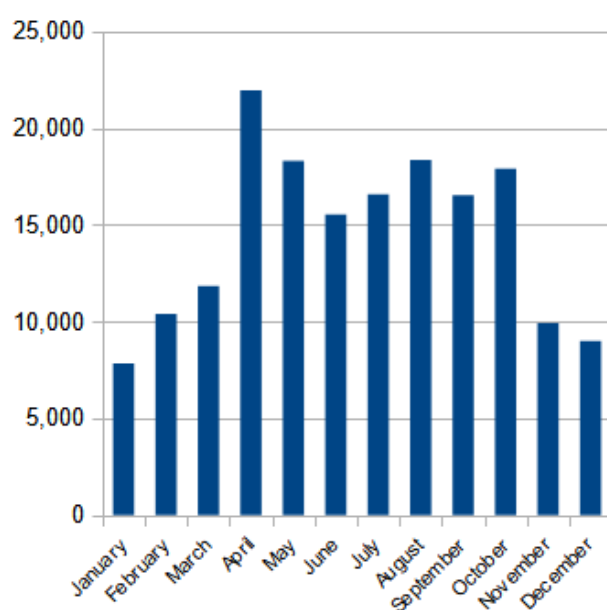


Figure 11.19: 2023 total visitors.

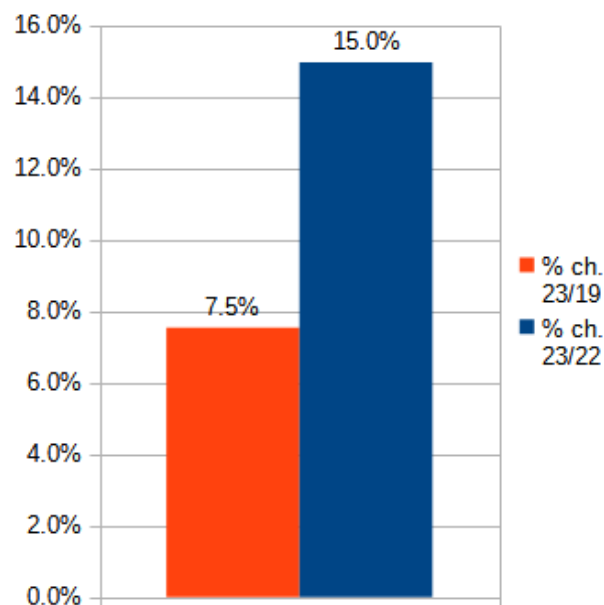


Figure 11.20: Visitors % change 2023/2019 and 2023/2022.

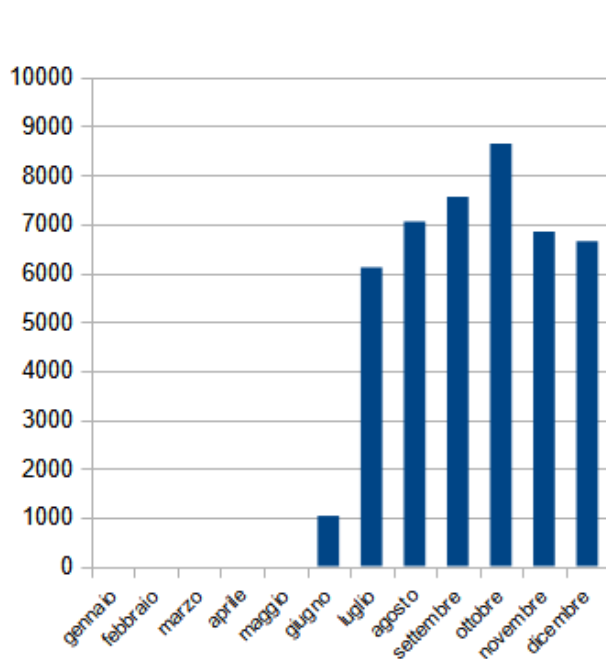
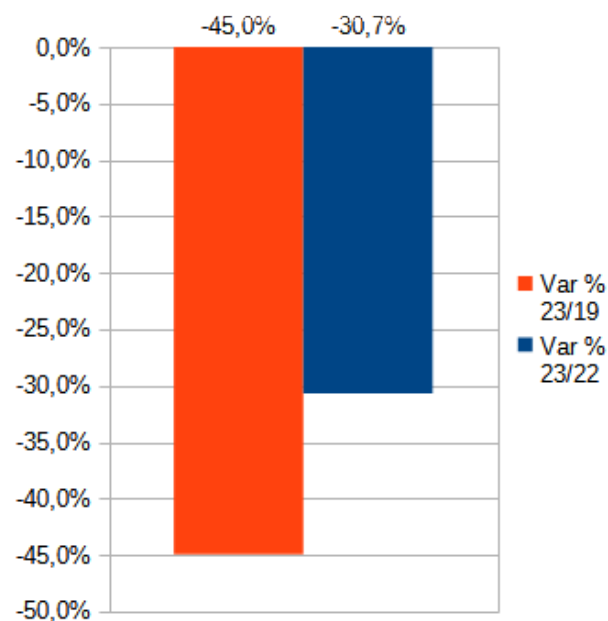


Figure 11.21: 2023 total visitors.

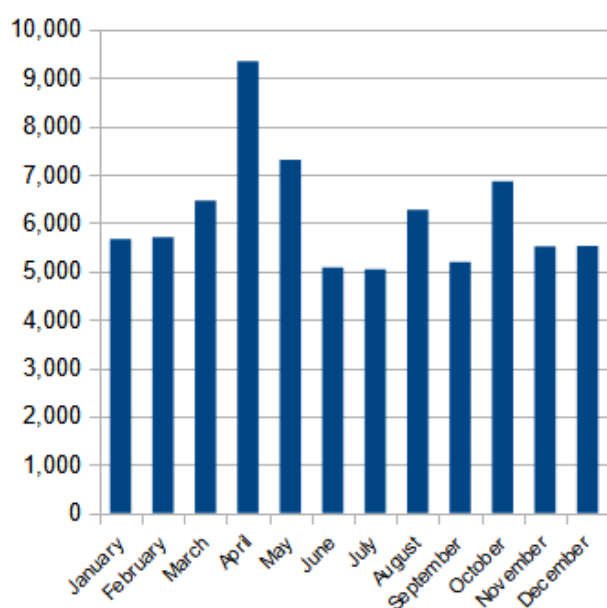


Figure 11.23: 2023 total visitors.

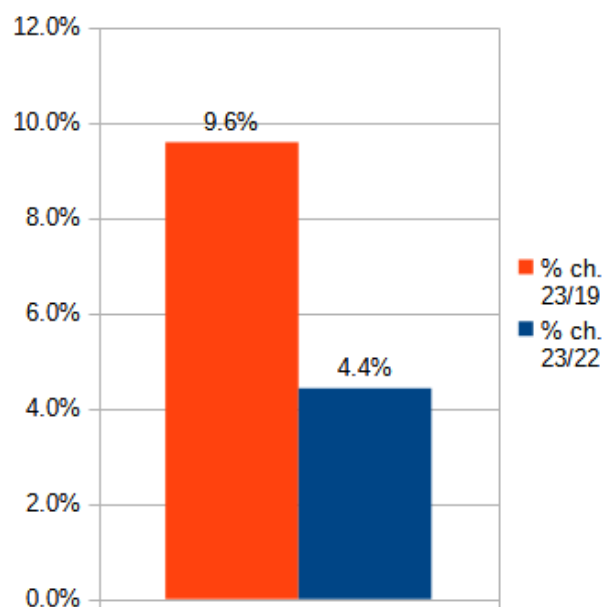


Figure 11.24: Visitors % change 2023/2019 and 2023/2022.

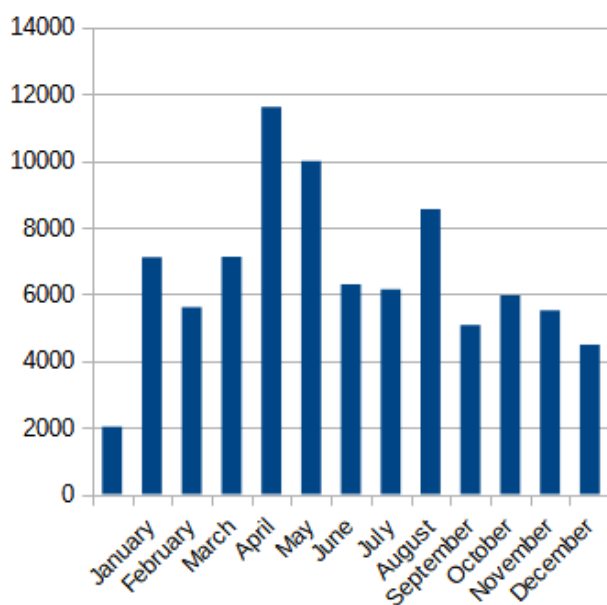


Figure 11.25: 2023 total visitors.

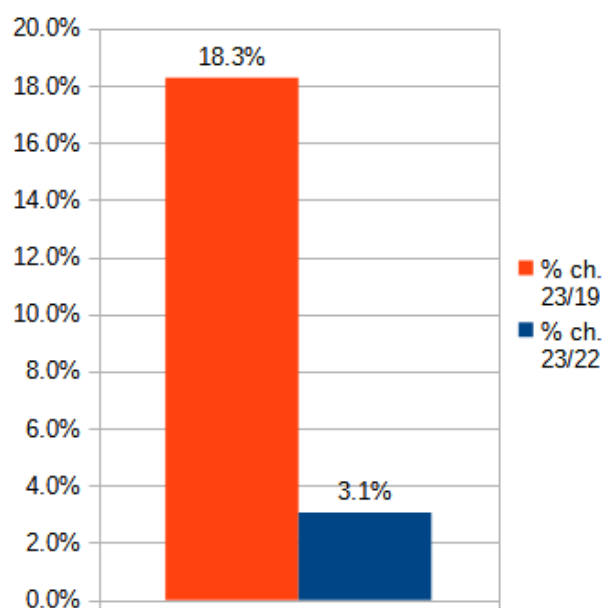


Figure 11.26: Visitors % change 2023/2019 and 2023/2022.

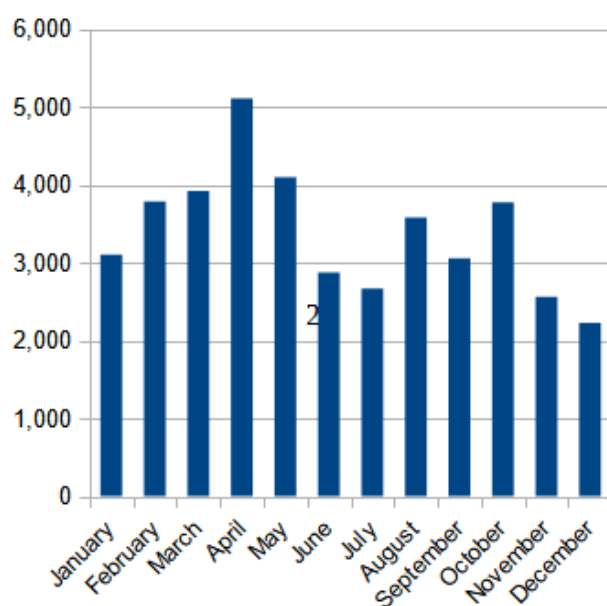


Figure 11.27: 2023 total visitors.

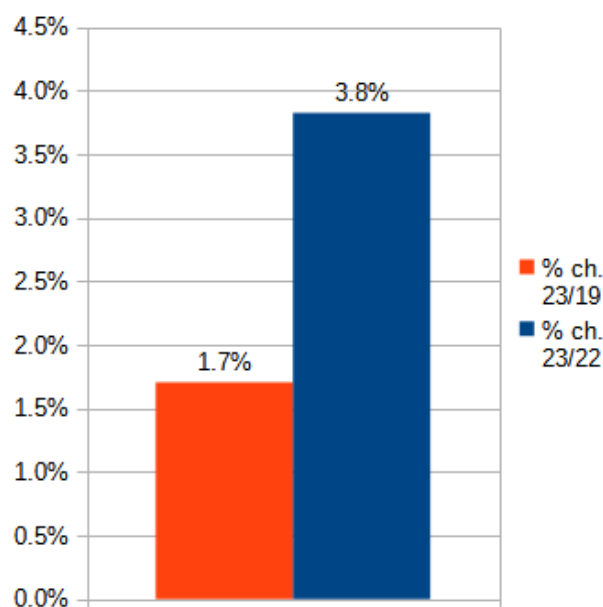


Figure 11.28: Visitors % change 2023/2019 and 2023/2022.

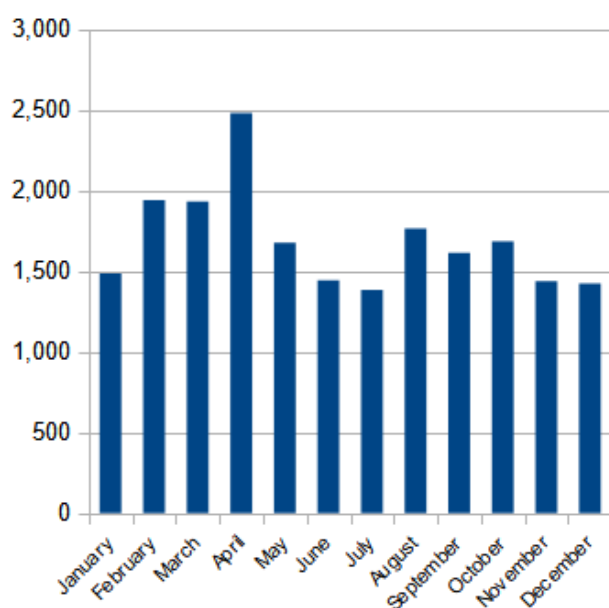


Figure 11.29: 2023 total visitors.

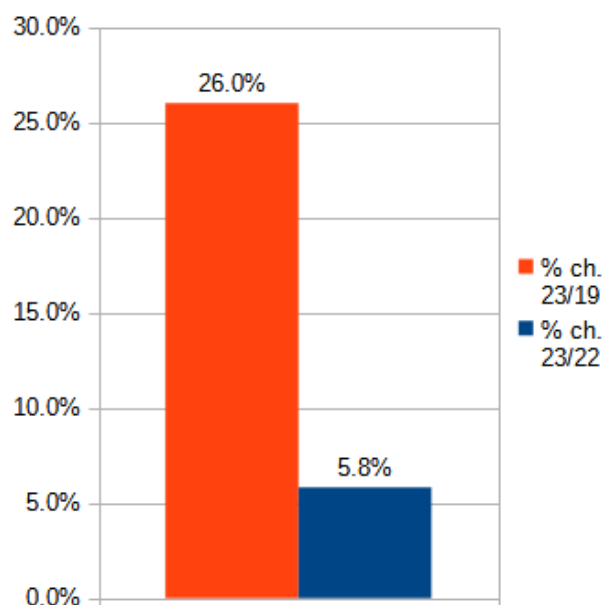


Figure 11.30: Visitors % change 2023/2019 and 2023/2022.

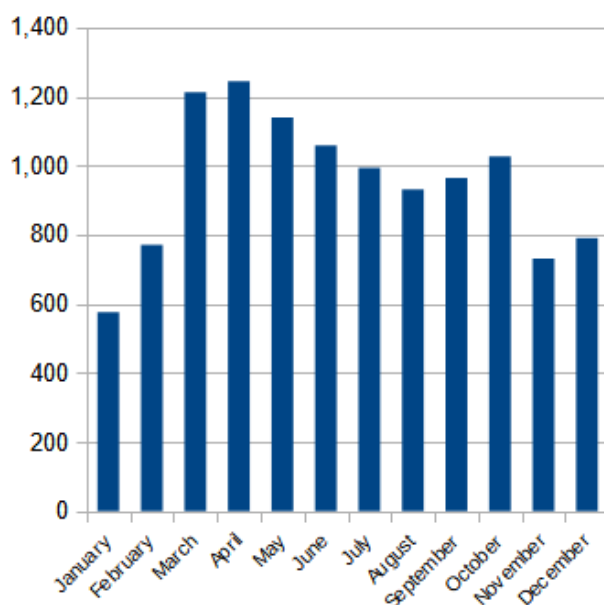


Figure 11.31: 2023 total visitors.

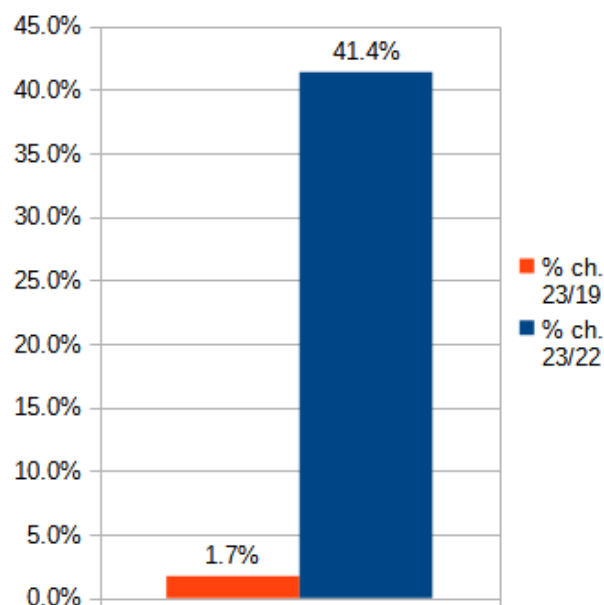


Figure 11.32: Visitors % change 2023/2019 and 2023/2022.

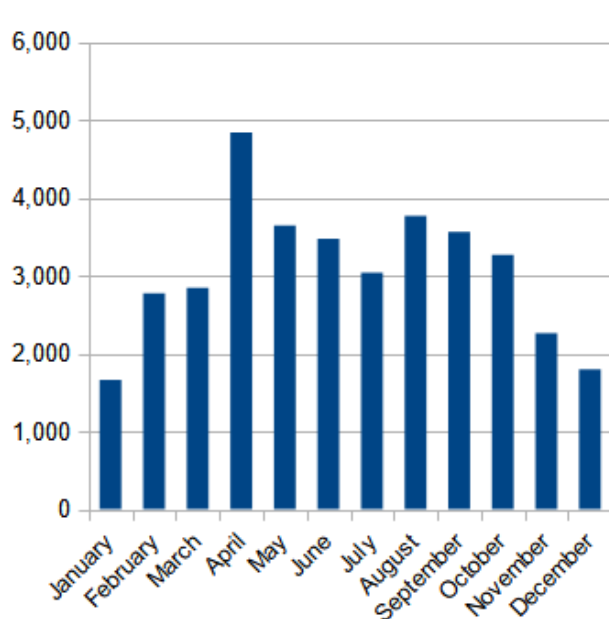


Figure 11.33: 2023 total visitors.

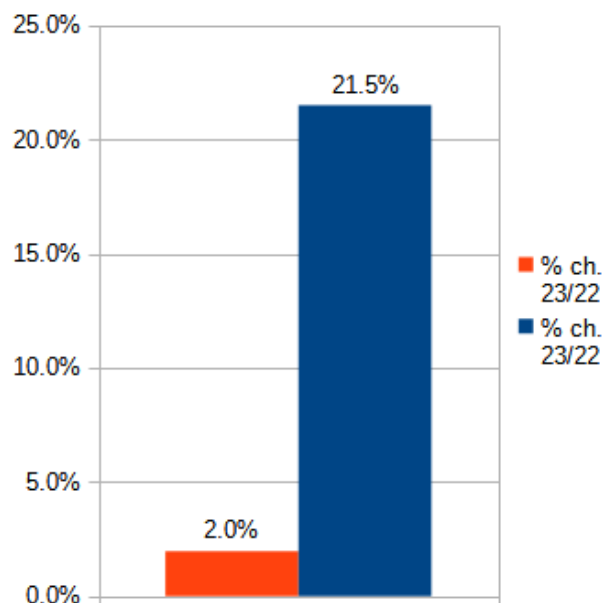


Figure 11.34: Visitors % change 2023/2019 and 2023/2022.

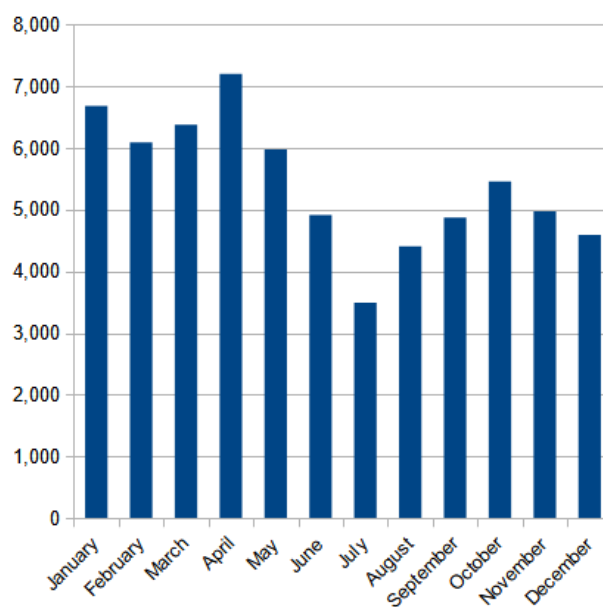


Figure 11.35: Year 2023.

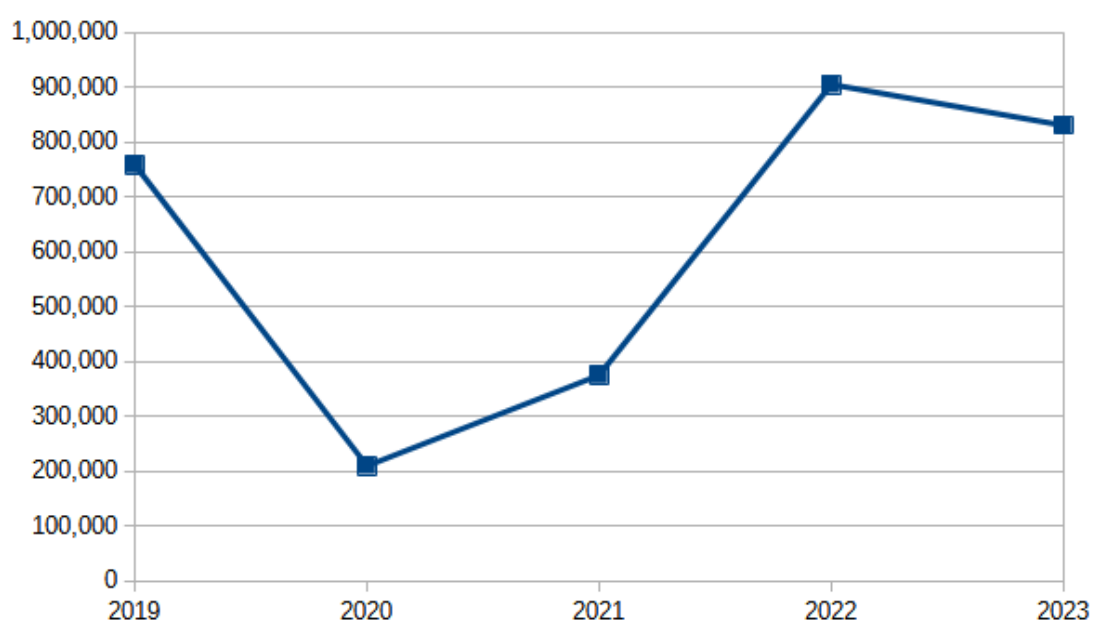


Figure 11.36: Visitors: total per year.

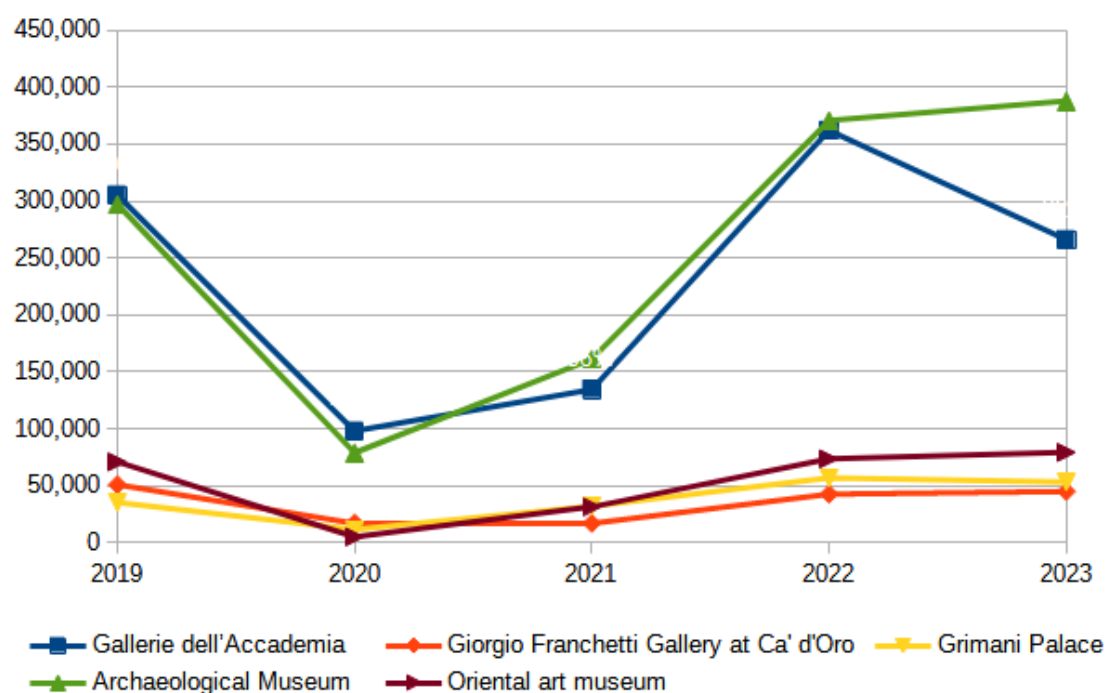


Figure 11.37: Visitors: total per museum.

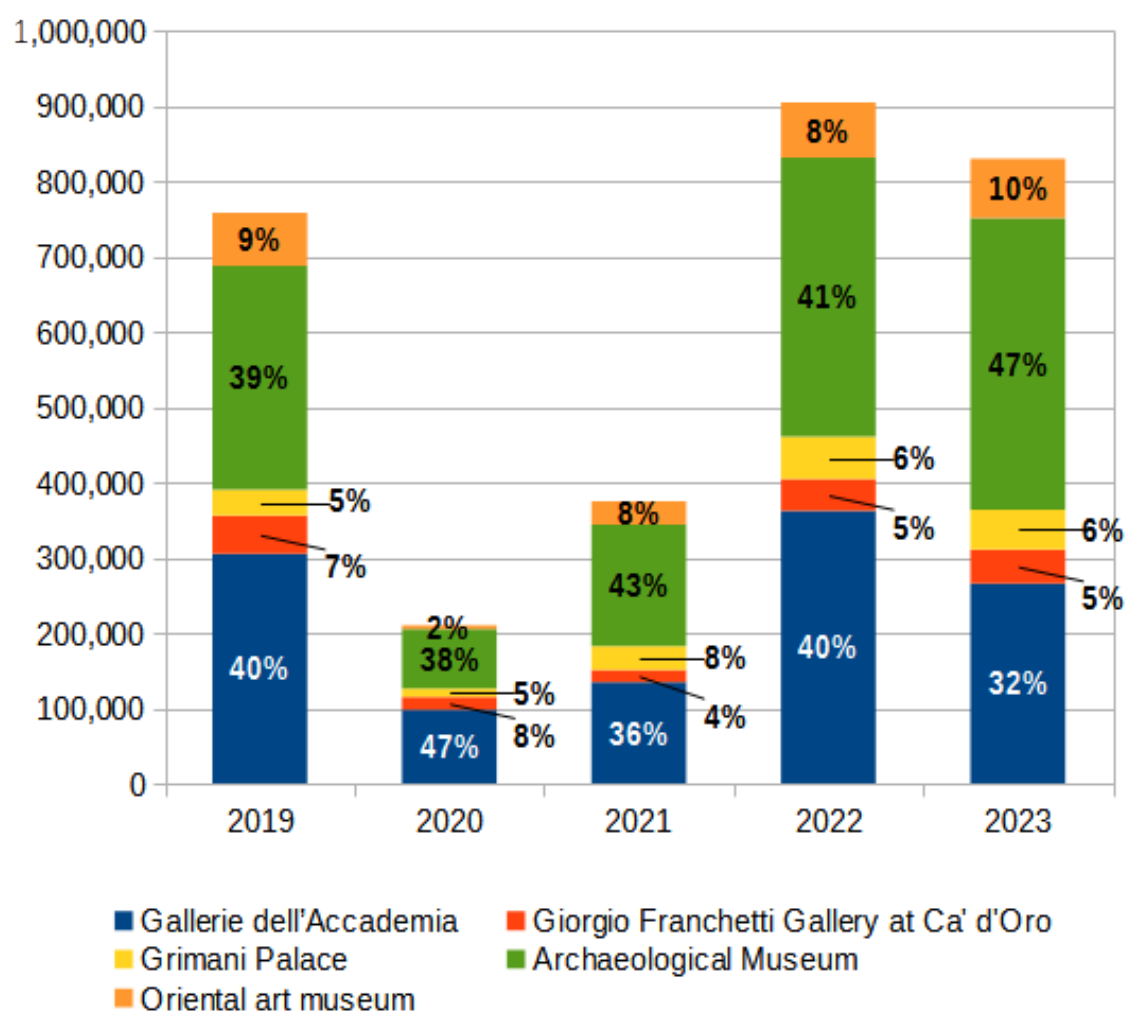


Figure 11.38: Visitors: % composition per year.

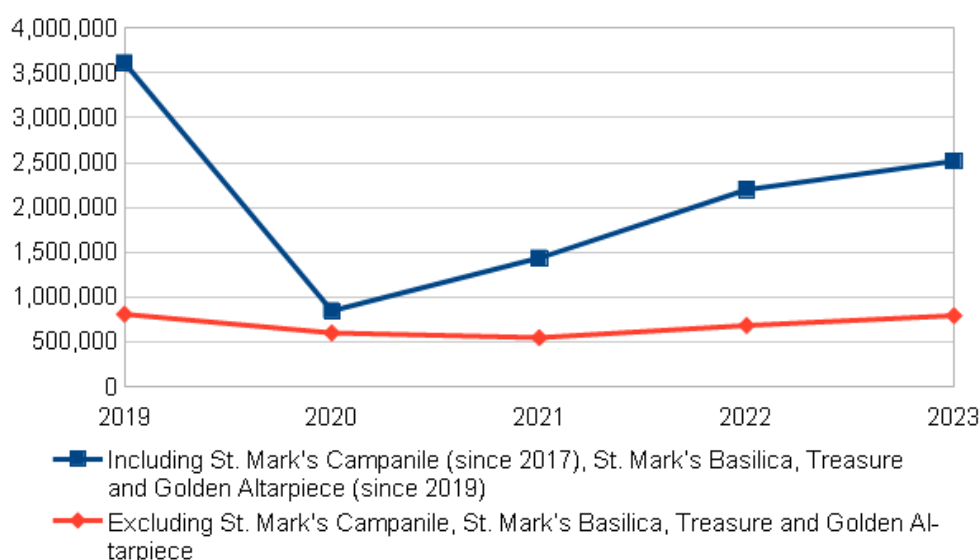


Figure 11.39: Total ecclesiastical museums and churches visitors per year.

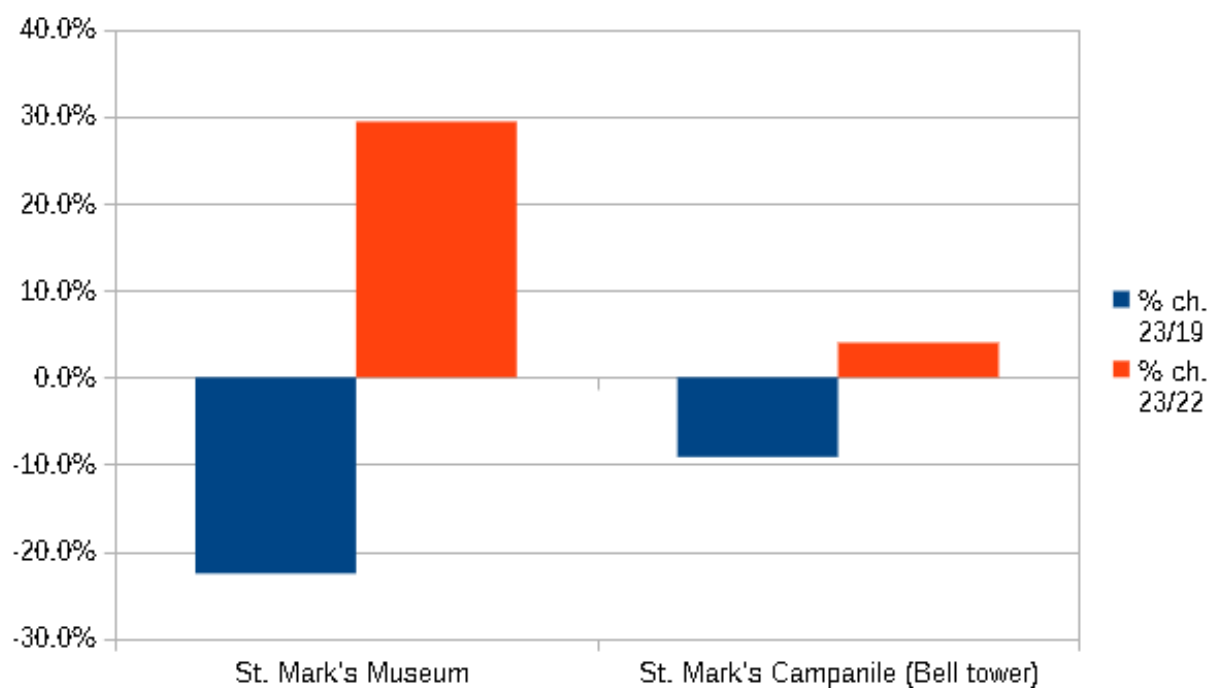


Figure 11.40: St. Mark's Museum and Campanile:visitors % change.

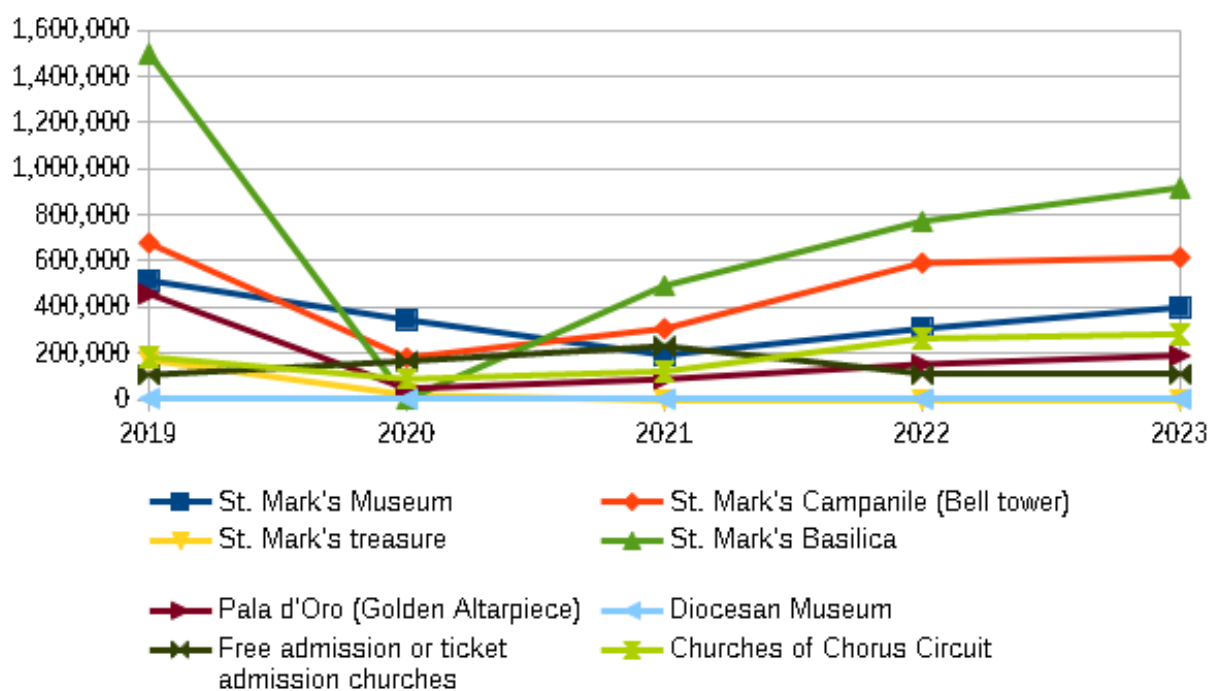


Figure 11.41: Total visitors per location per year.

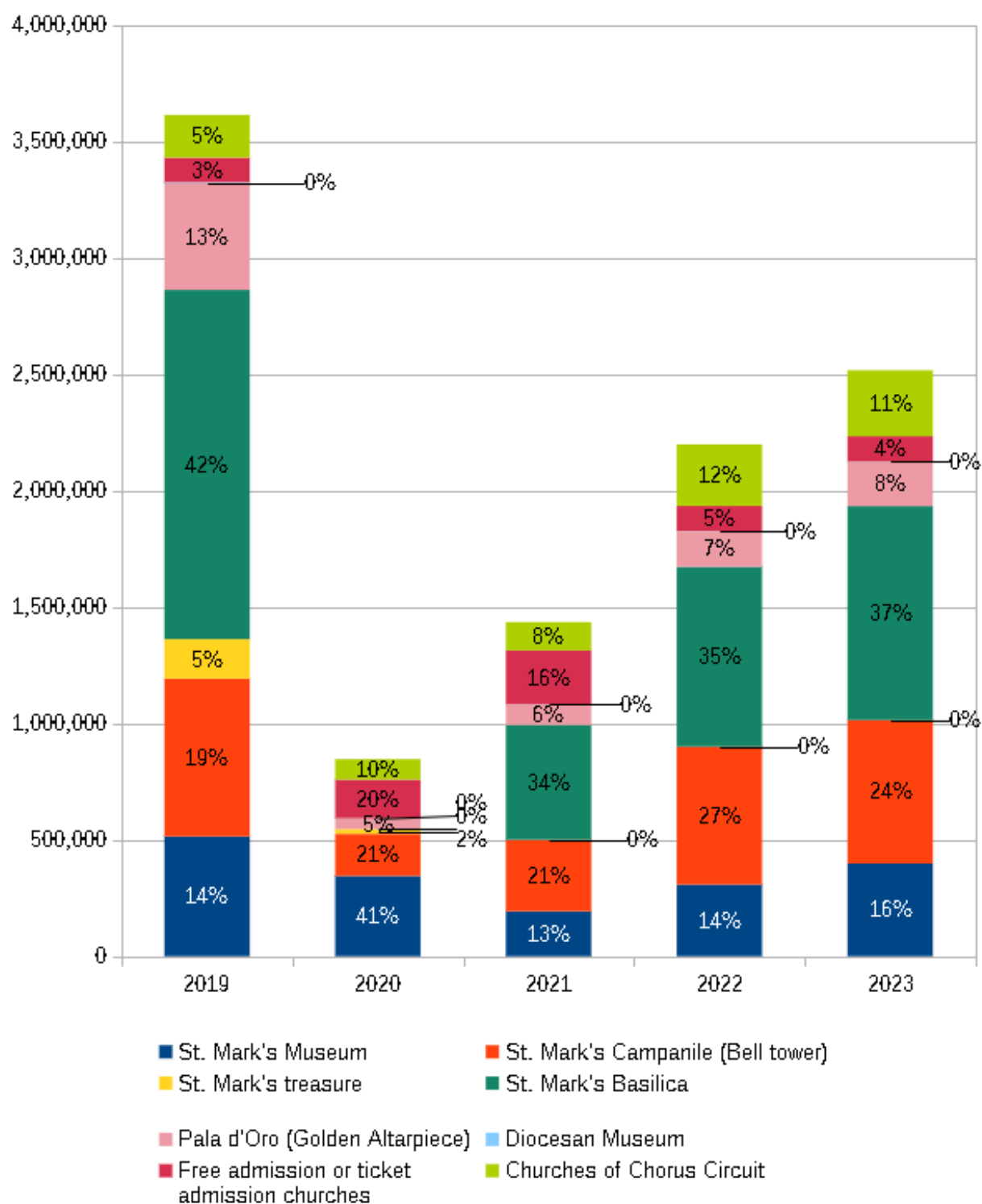


Figure 11.42: Visitors: % composition.

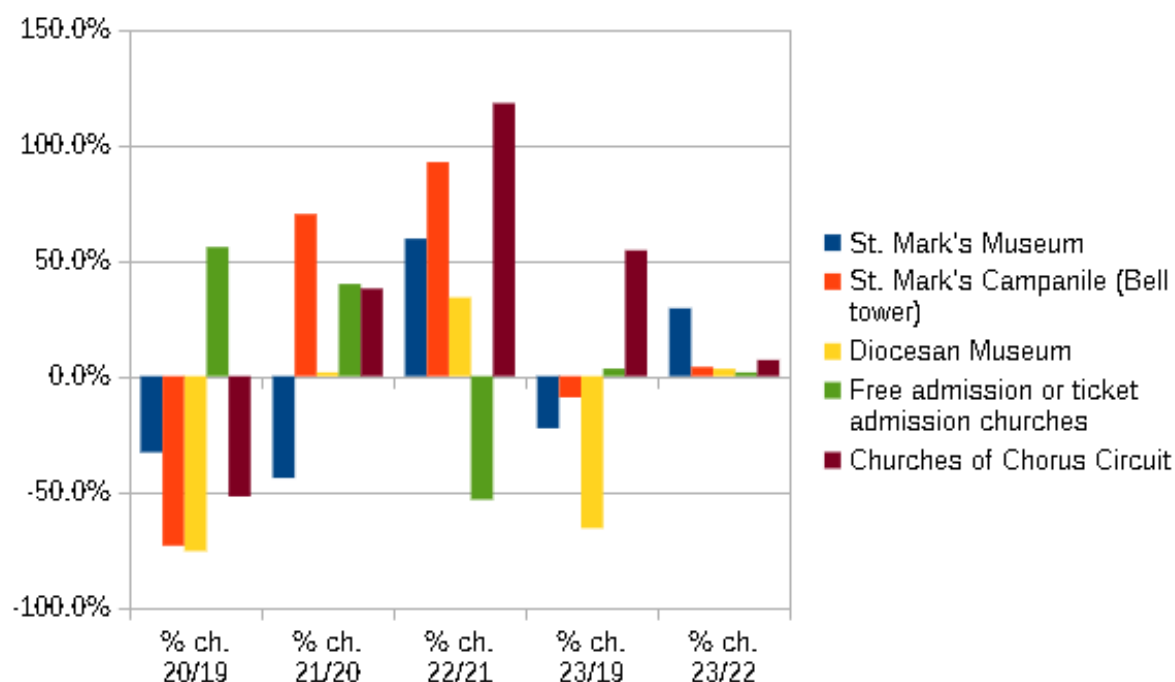


Figure 11.43: Visitors: % change on previous year.

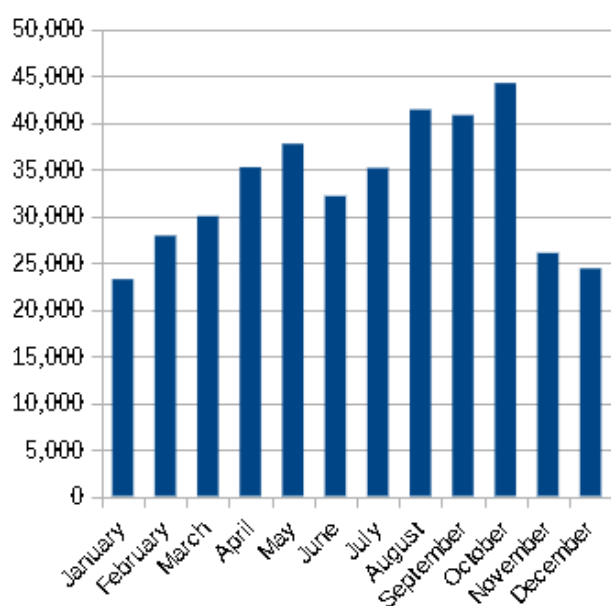


Figure 11.44: 2023 visitors.

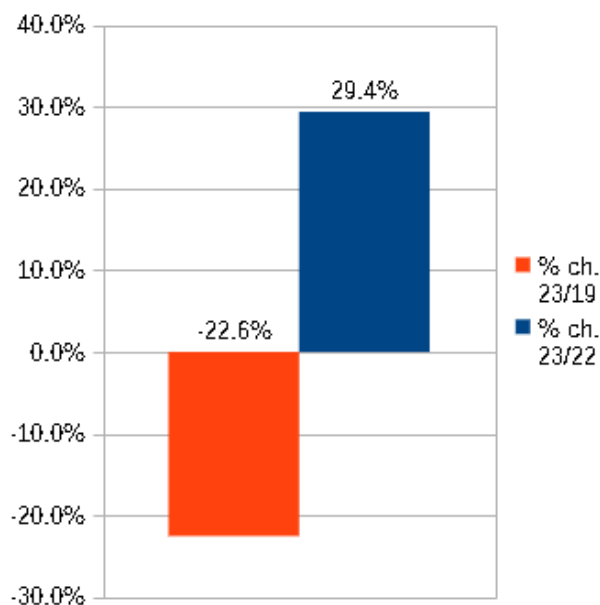


Figure 11.45: Visitors % change 2023/2019 and 2023/2022.

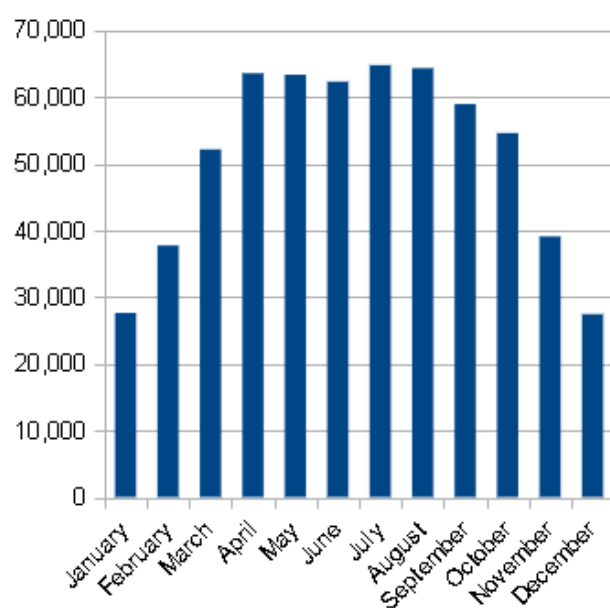


Figure 11.46: 2023 Visitors.

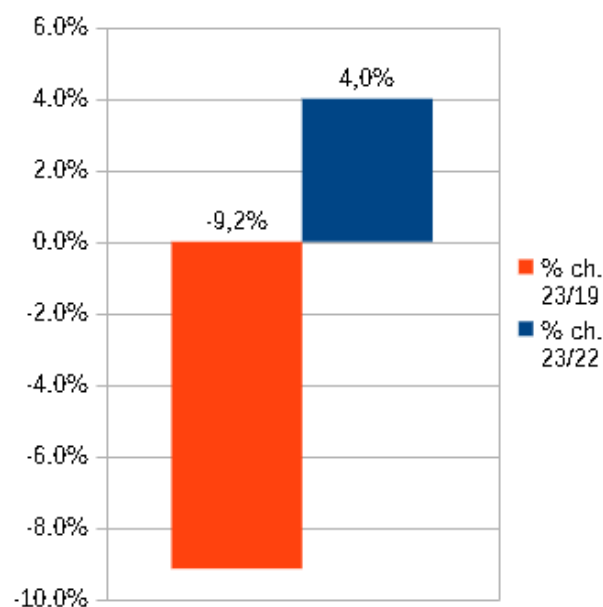


Figure 11.47: Visitors % change 2023/2019 and 2023/2022.

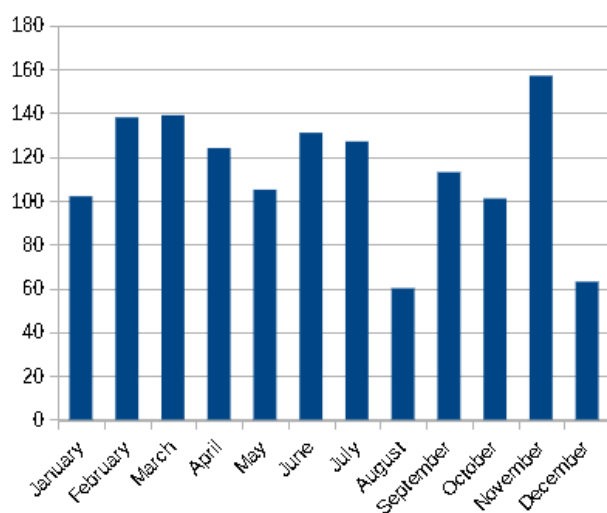


Figure 11.48: 2023 visitors.

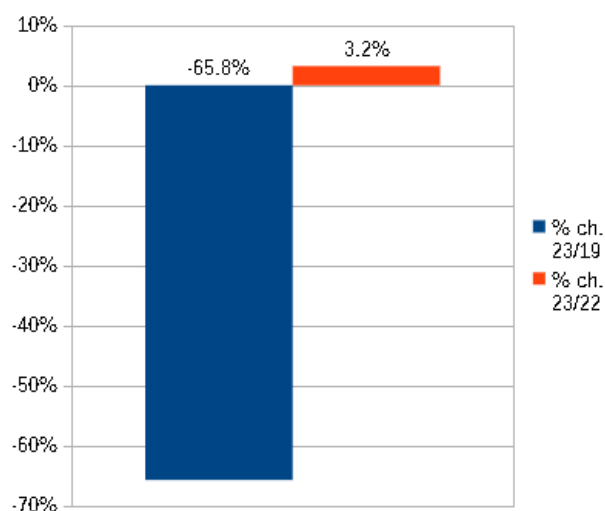


Figure 11.49: Visitors %change 2023/2019 and 2023/2022.

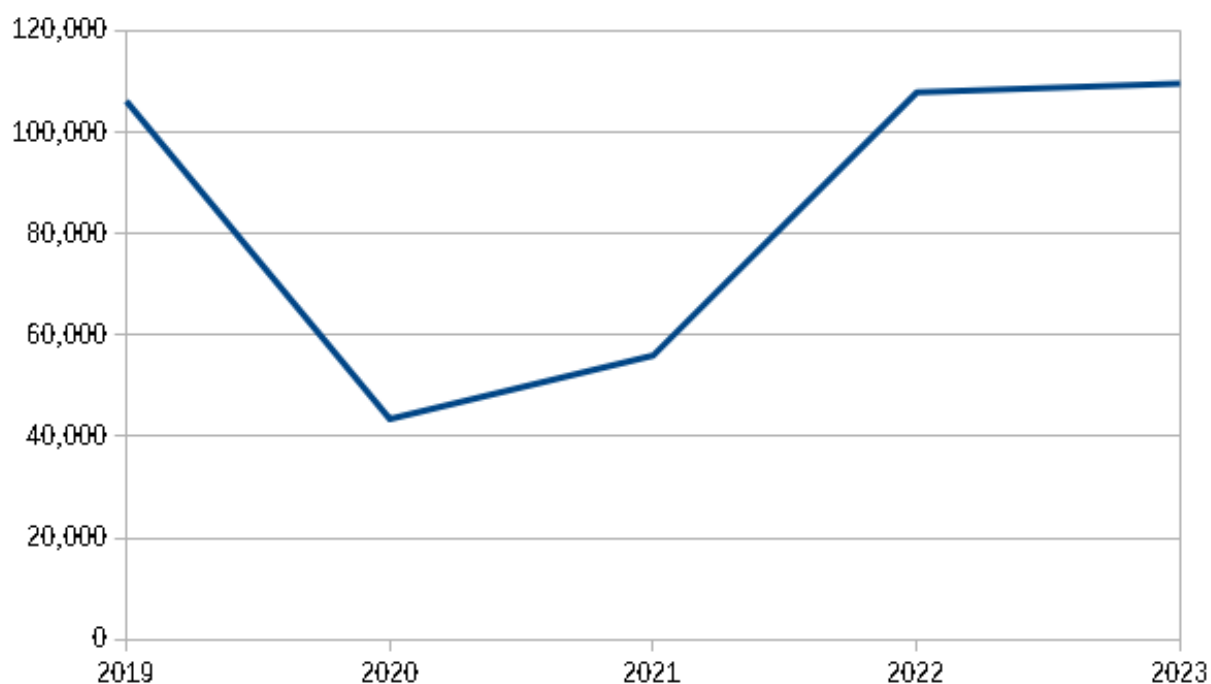


Figure 11.50: Visitors in the five-year period.

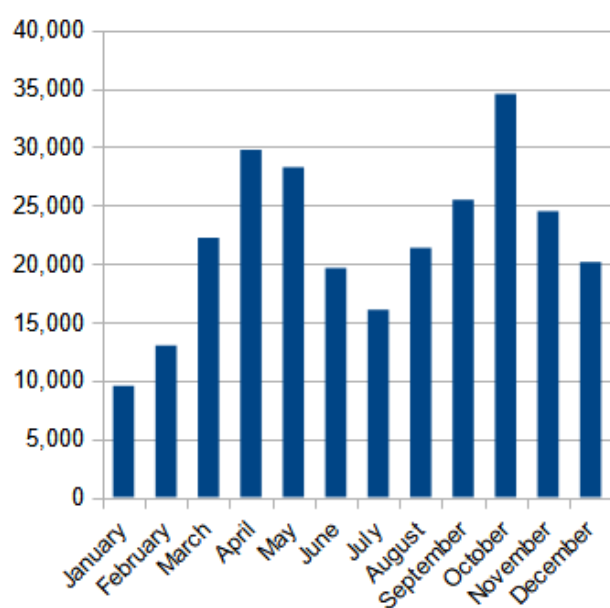


Figure 11.51: 2023: total visitors with Chorus circuit ticket.

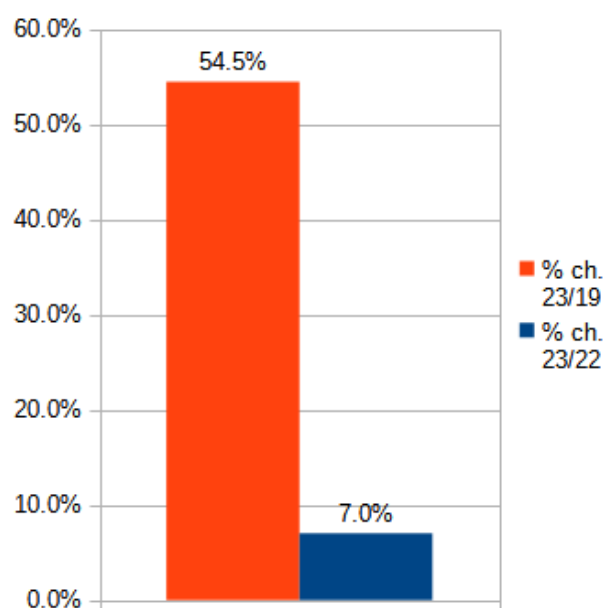


Figure 11.52: Visitors % change 2023/2019 and 2023/2022.

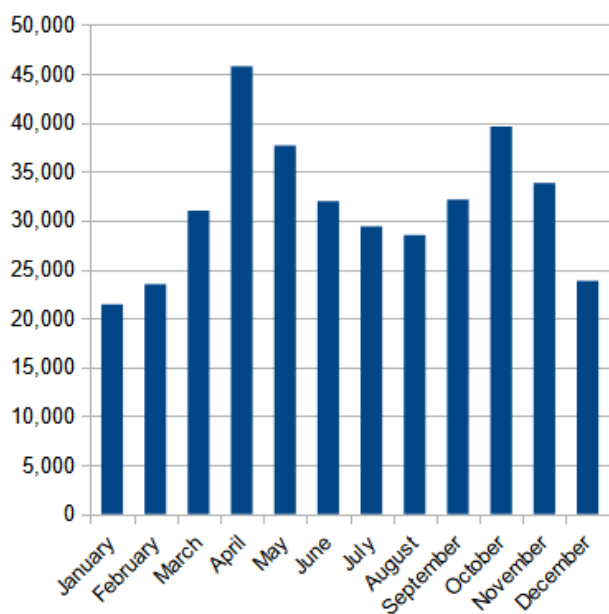


Figure 11.53: 2023 total visitors.

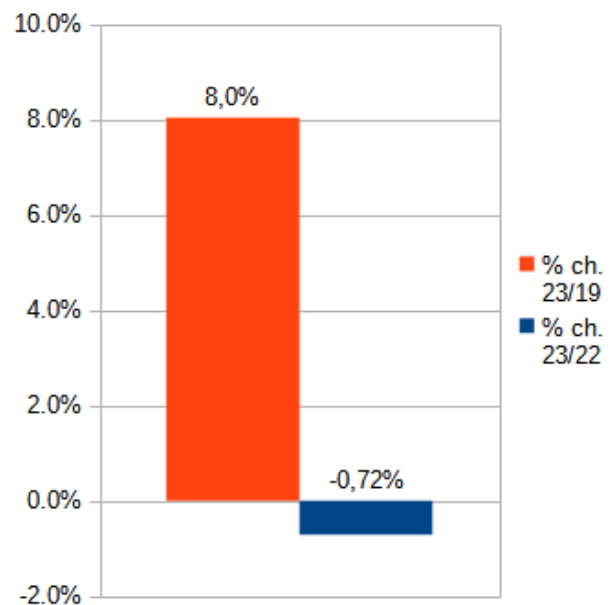


Figure 11.54: Visitors % change 2023/2019 and 2023/2022.

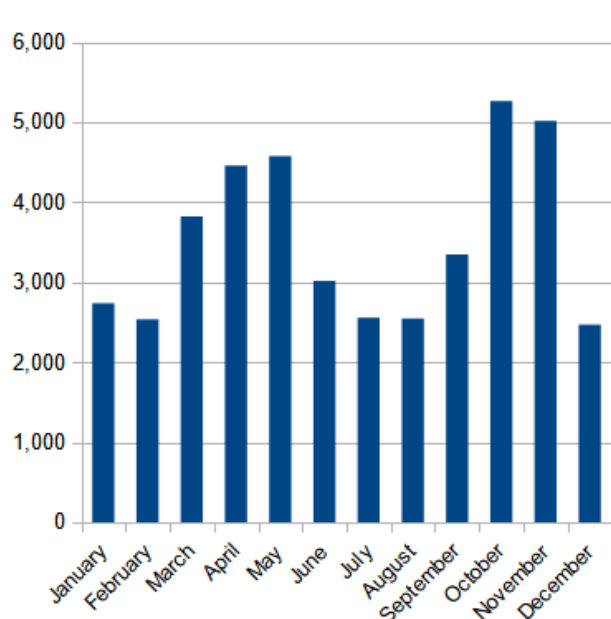


Figure 11.55: 2023 total visitors.

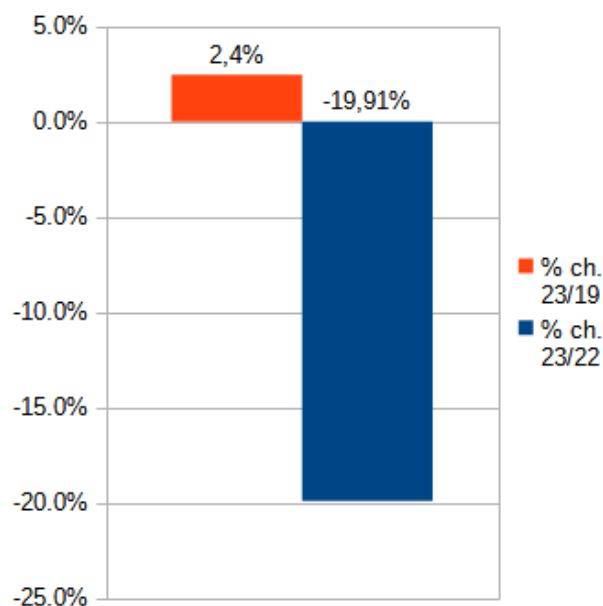


Figure 11.56: Visitors % change 2023/2019 and 2023/2022.

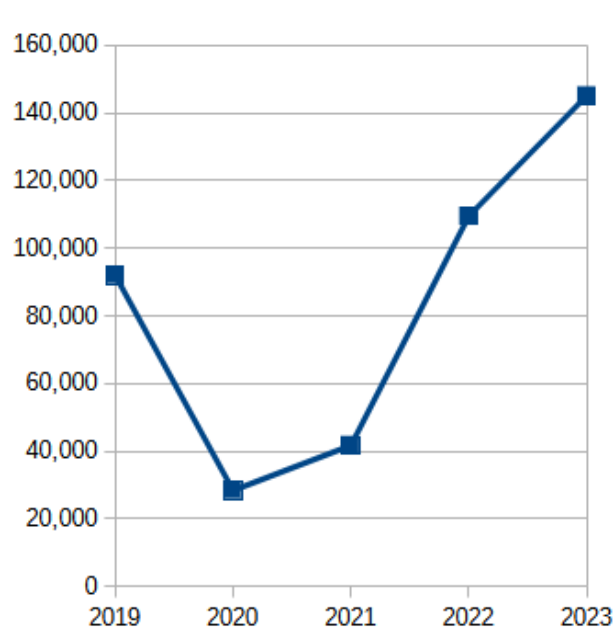


Figure 11.57: 2019-2023 total visitors.

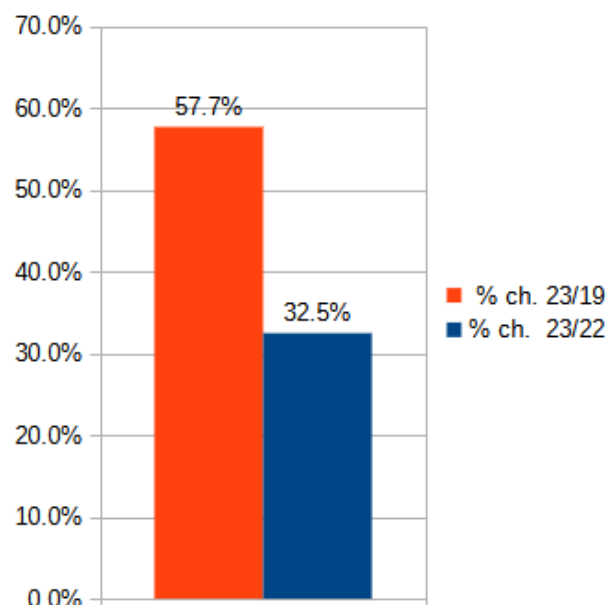


Figure 11.58: Visitors % change 2023/2019 and 2023/2022.

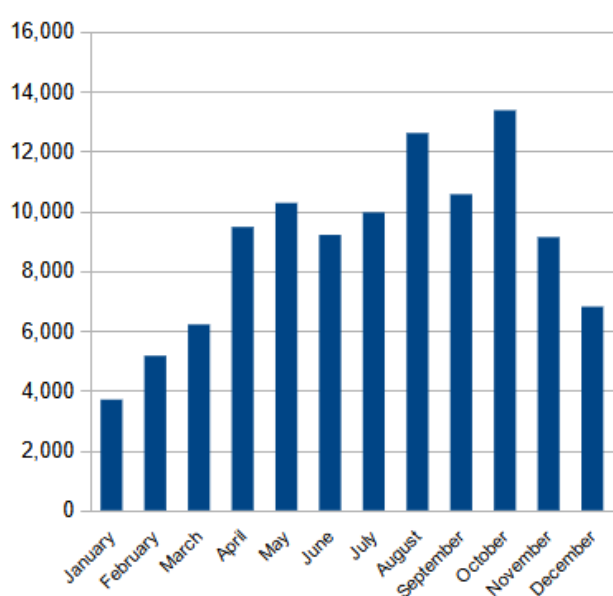


Figure 11.59: 2023 total visitors.

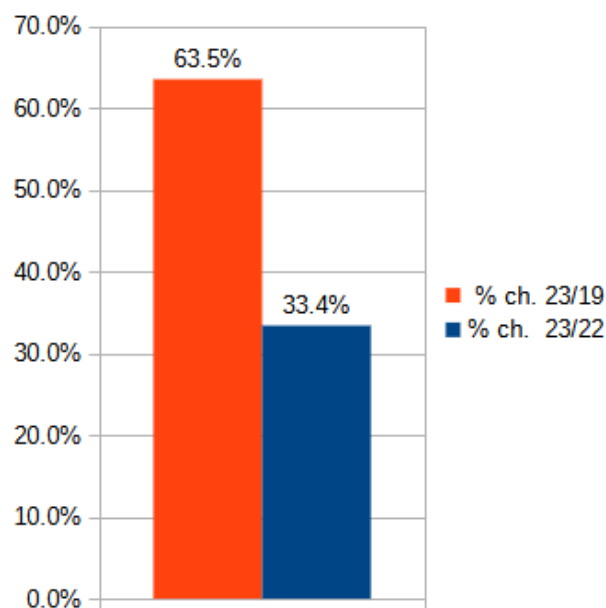


Figure 11.60: Visitors % change 2023/2019 and 2023/2022.

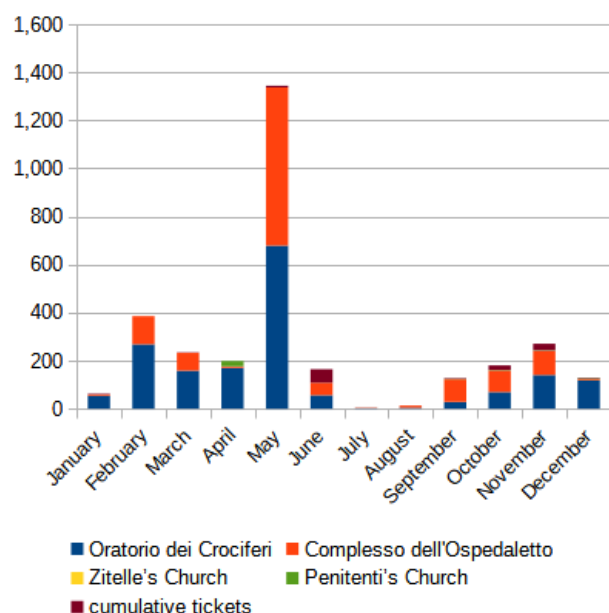


Figure 11.61: 2023 total visitors.

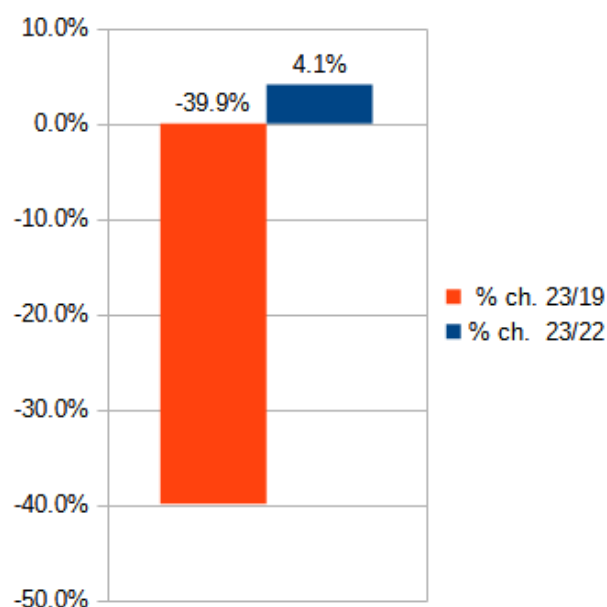


Figure 11.62: Visitors % change 2023/2019 and 2023/2022.

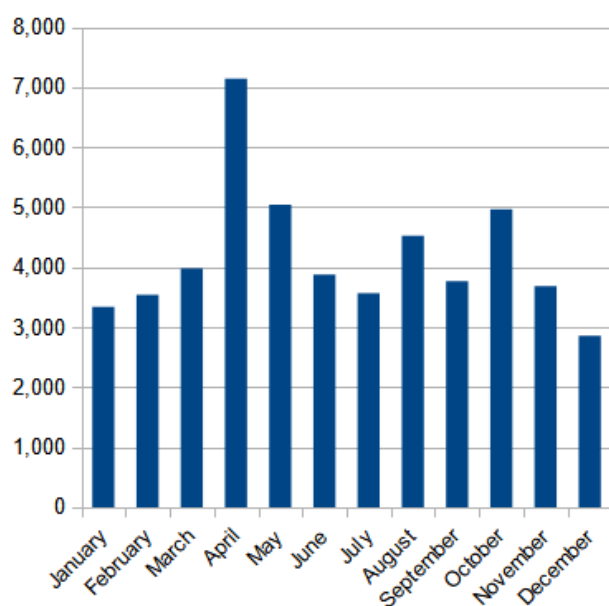


Figure 11.63: 2023 total visitors.

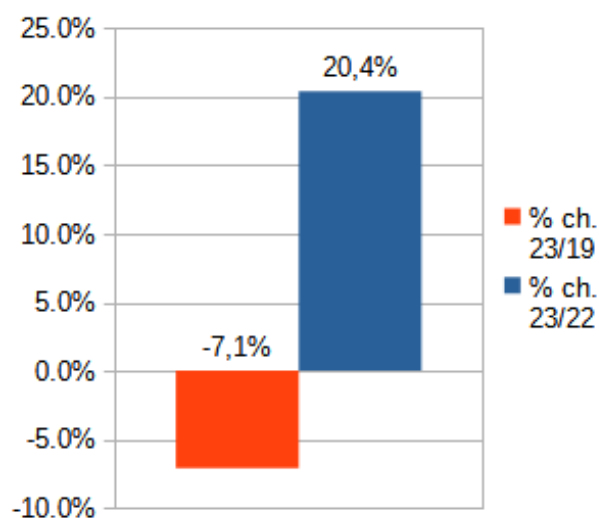


Figure 11.64: Visitors % change 2023/2019 and 2023/2022.

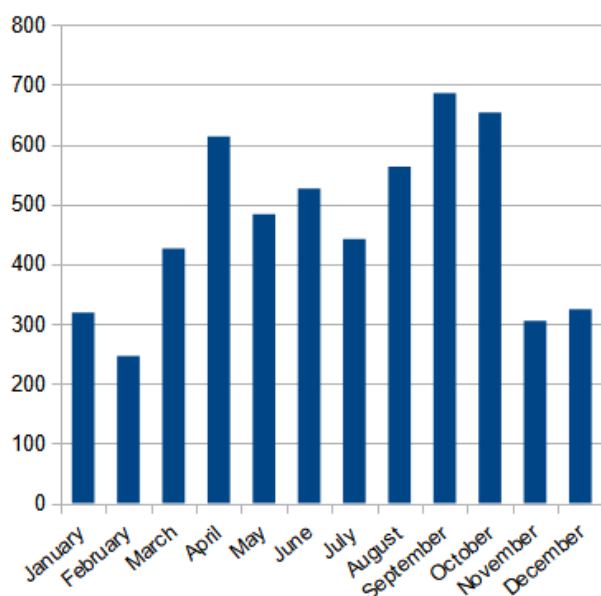


Figure 11.65: 2023 total visitors.

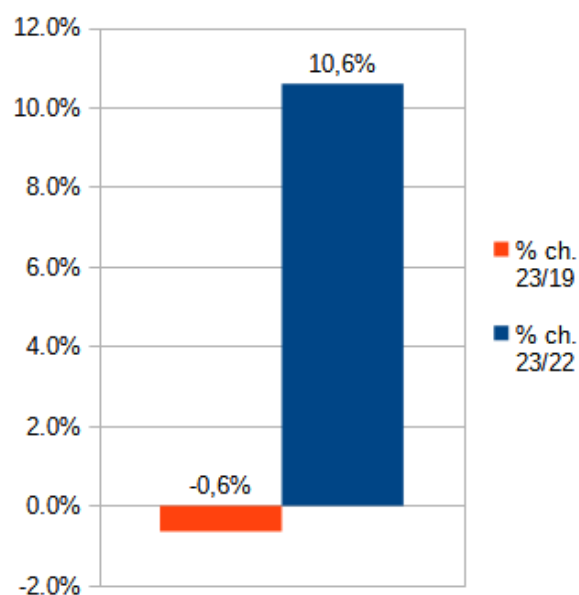


Figure 11.66: Visitors % change 2023/2019 and 2023/2022.

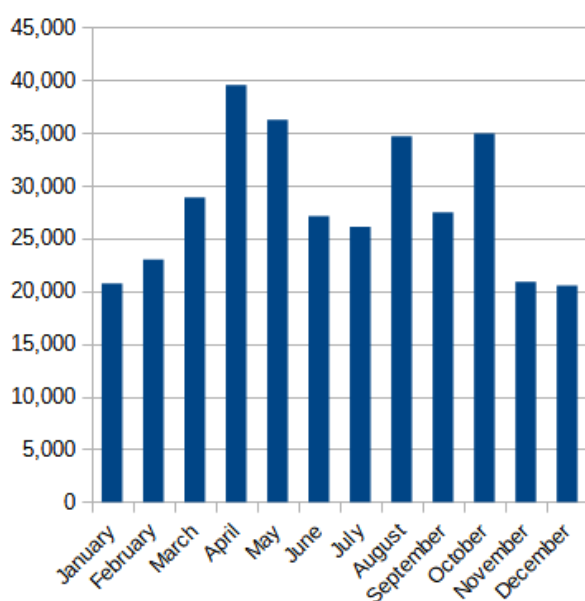


Figure 11.67: 2023 total visitors.

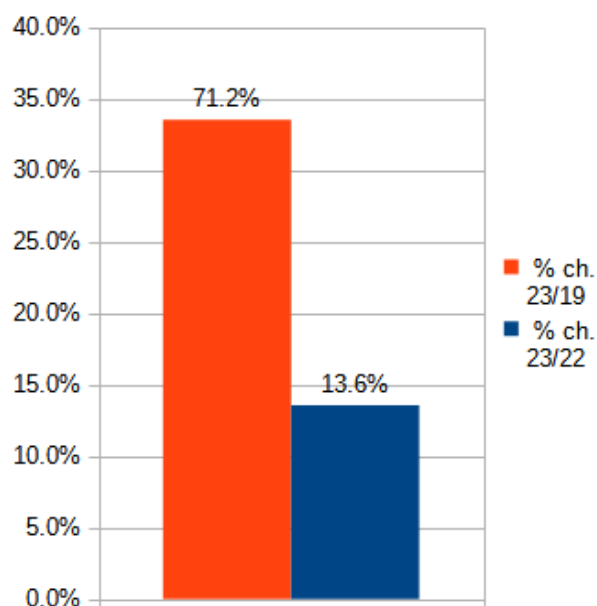


Figure 11.68: Visitors % change on 2019 and on 2022.

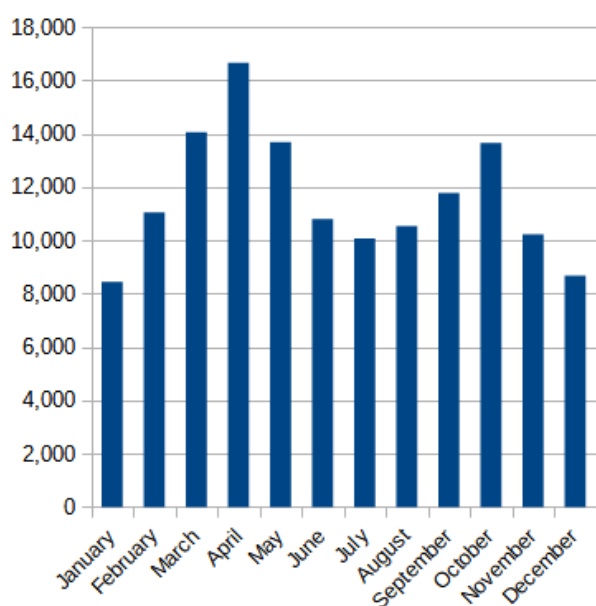


Figure 11.69: 2023 total visitors.

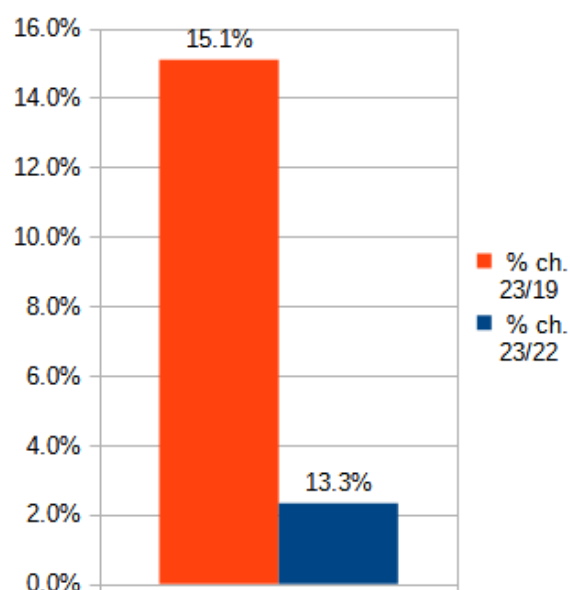


Figure 11.70: Visitors % change 2023/2019 and 2023/2022.

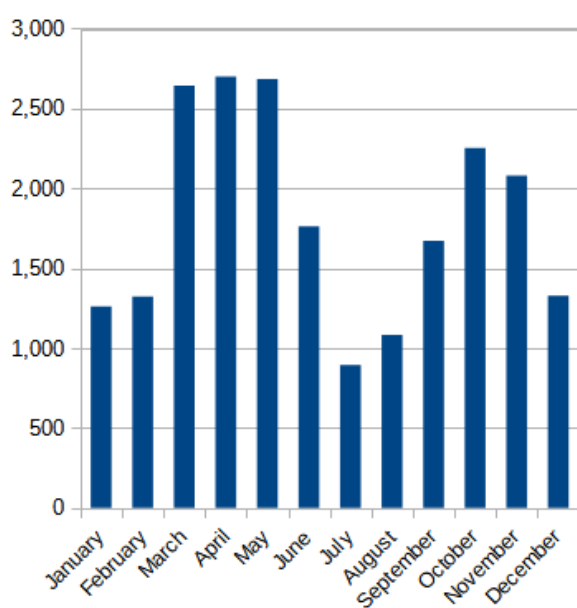


Figure 11.71: 2023 total visitors.

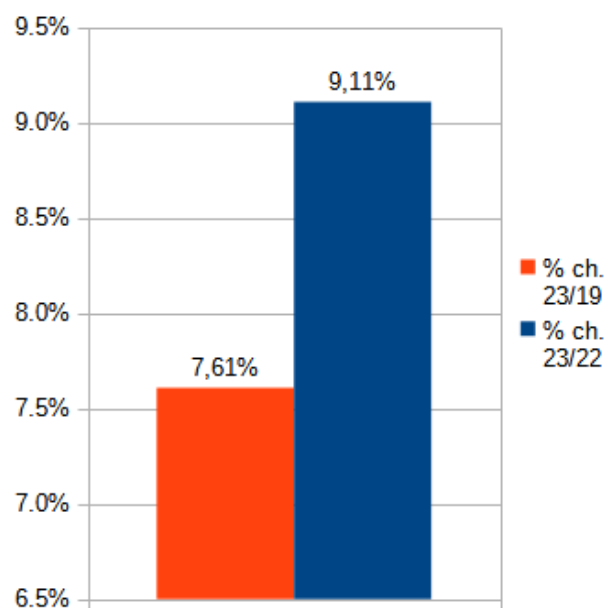


Figure 11.72: Visitors % change 2023/2019 and 2023/2022.

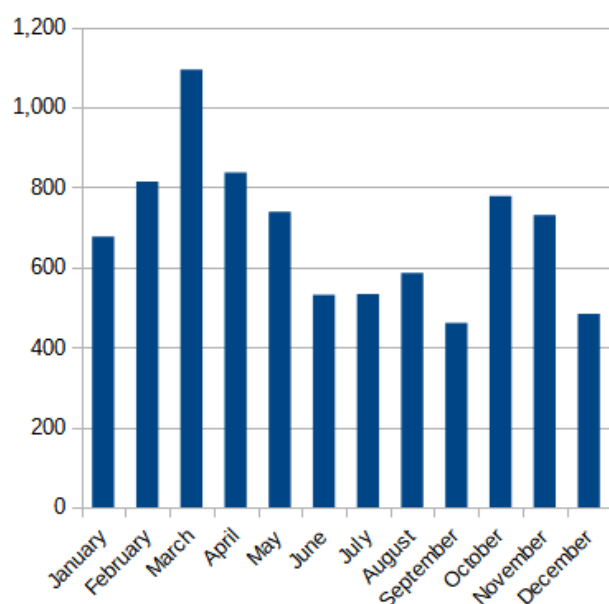


Figure 11.73: 2023 total visitors.

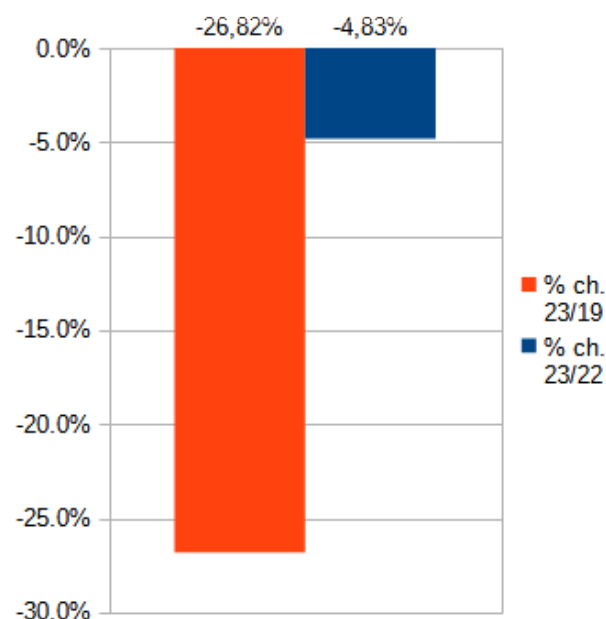


Figure 11.74: Visitors % change 2023/2019 and 2023/2022.

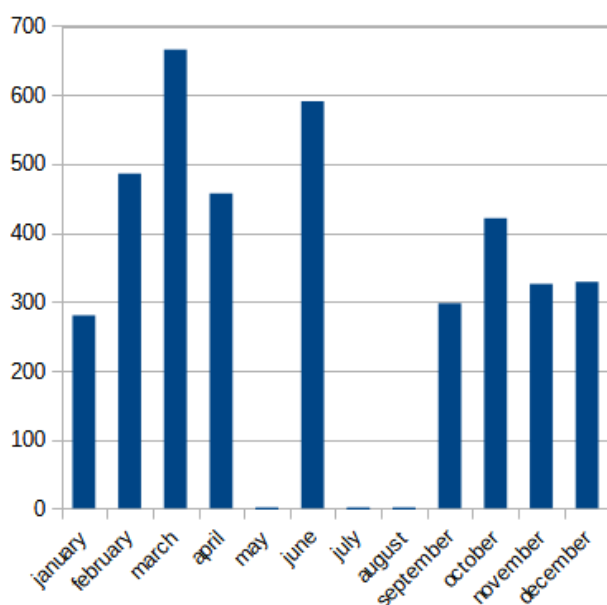


Figure 11.75: 2023 total visitors.

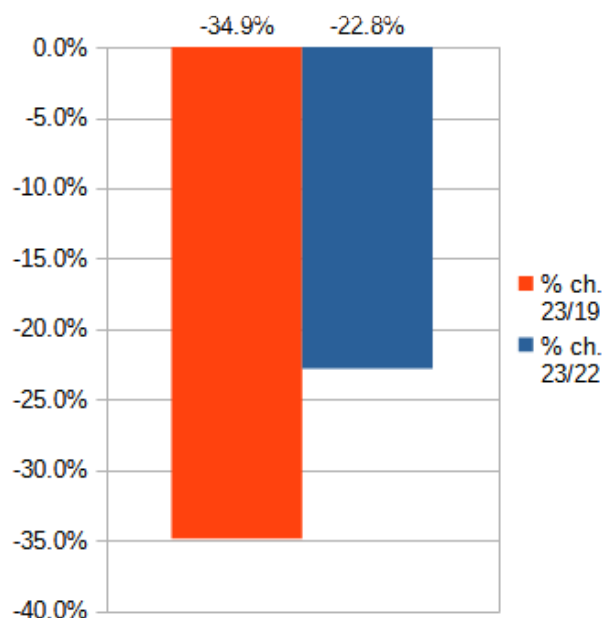


Figure 11.76: Visitors % change on 2019.

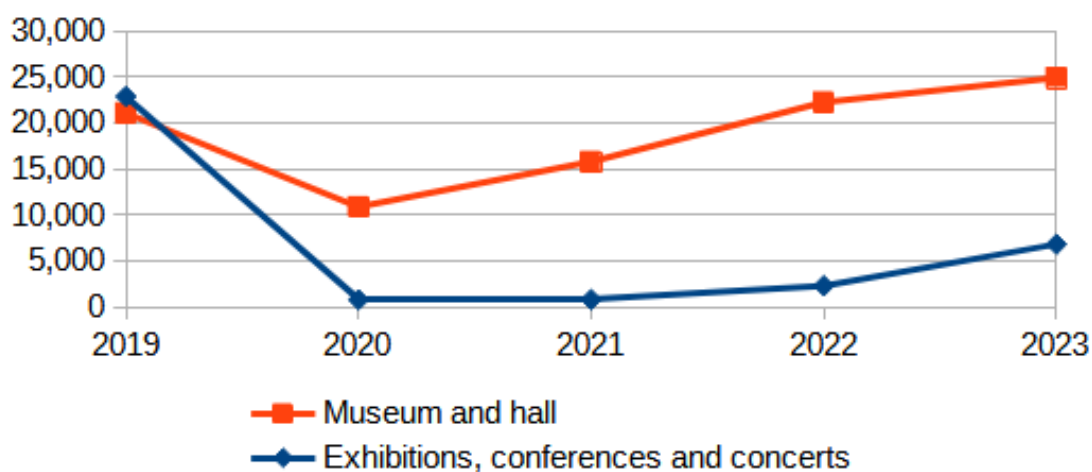


Figure 11.77: Total visitors 2018-2023.

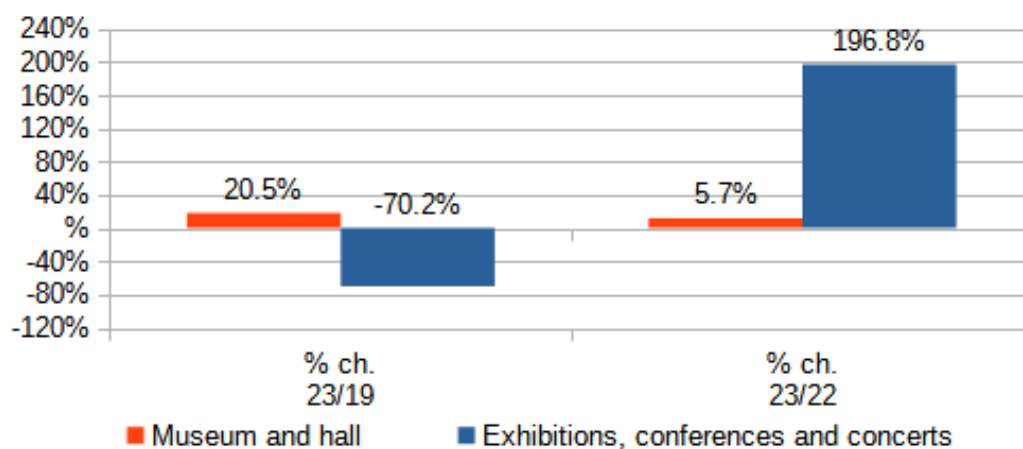


Figure 11.78: Visitors % change.

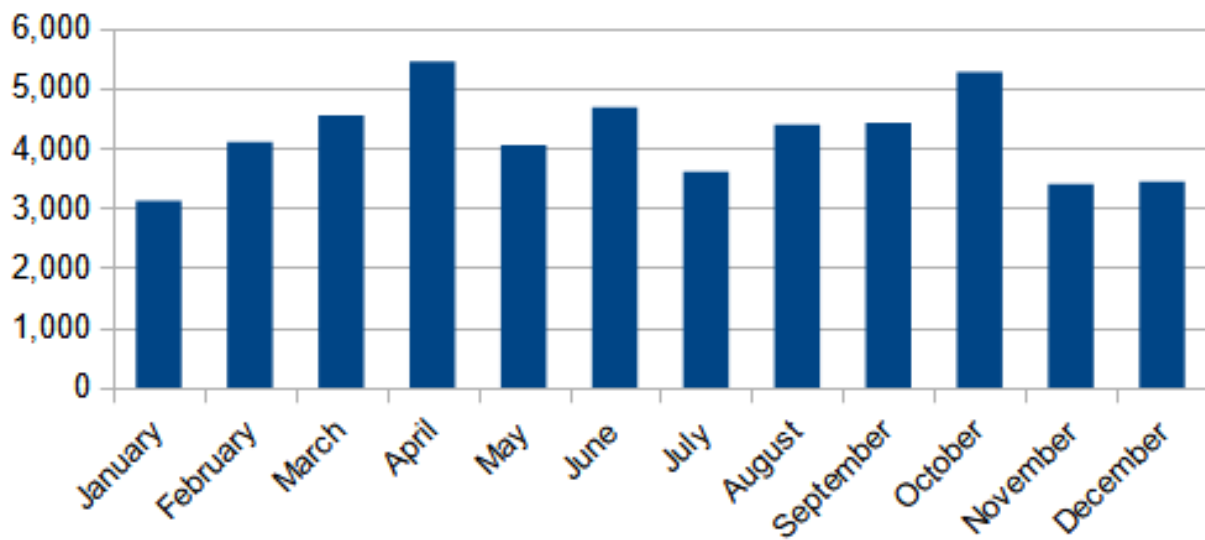


Figure 11.79: 2023 visitors.
