  - Presence of lifeguards or lifesaving equipment;
  - Easy access and facilities for disabled people;
  - Blue Flag Program Information posted at the beach;
  - Good equilibrium between beach activities and nature protection.

### NATURAL SITES



San Nicolò (Northern Lido), Alberoni (Southern Lido) and Caroman (Pellestrina island) are natural areas protected by European Union (Natura 2000 network). These are coastal areas of high naturalistic interest and habitat of different species of plants and animals. They are identified as Special Area of Conservation (SAC) and Special Protected Areas (SPA) according to the Habitat and Bird EU Directives, and indicated by Veneto Region's Hunting Plan.

### KENTISH PLOVER'S PROTECTION



Kentish plover (*Charadrius alexandrinus*) is a little protected wading bird nesting along the coast of Venice Lido from March to July. Kentish plover is protected by the EU Bird Directive and his population is decreasing due to the intense tourism impact along the beach. Blue Flag Program rewards municipalities involved in nesting protection.

### SEA TURTLE FIRST AID CENTER



A rescue center for sea turtles is located in the "Centro di Soggiorno Morosini" at Alberoni (Lido). It hosts sea turtles that are often found injured or stranded.
